2016 Tornado Fatalities

Tornadoes claimed 18 lives in 2016, half the 2015 total of 36. The deadliest location to be when a tornado struck in 2016 was in a mobile home or trailer, where 14 (78%) victims were killed. There were twice as many male victims, 12 (67%) in 2016 as female, 6 (33%). The states with most tornado victims in 2016 were Alabama and Virginia, which each had 4 tornado deaths. The largest number of victims were in the 50-59 age range, 5 (28%), followed by 20-29 and 70-79 year ranges, which each numbered 4 deaths.
