


# NWS Houston/Galveston Monthly Hydrologic Report July 2024



The month of July will be mainly remembered for Hurricane Bery, which made landfall as a strong category 1 hurricane near the city of Matagorda, TX earlier this month and dropped widespread heavy rainfall leading to flooding along numerous rivers/creeks/bayous. At the end of July, a multiday heavy rainfall event lead to another round of flooding as grounds became more and more saturated with additional rainfall occurring.

#### **Monthly Precipitation**




#### **Monthly Percent of Normal Precipitation**






# **Monthly Average Streamflow**



# **Previous Monthly Average Streamflow**




# **Soil Moisture**






