




# NWS Houston/Galveston Monthly Hydrologic Report April 2025



April became very active towards the end of the month with multiple rounds of heavy rain leading to minor instances of flooding especially in portions of the Piney Woods and locations east of I-45. As a result of the bulk of the rainfall being over the eastern half of Southeast Texas, the western half remained in moderate to severe drought.






# **Monthly Average Streamflow**




# **Previous Monthly Average Streamflow**




## **Soil Moisture**



# **Soil Moisture Anomaly**






