



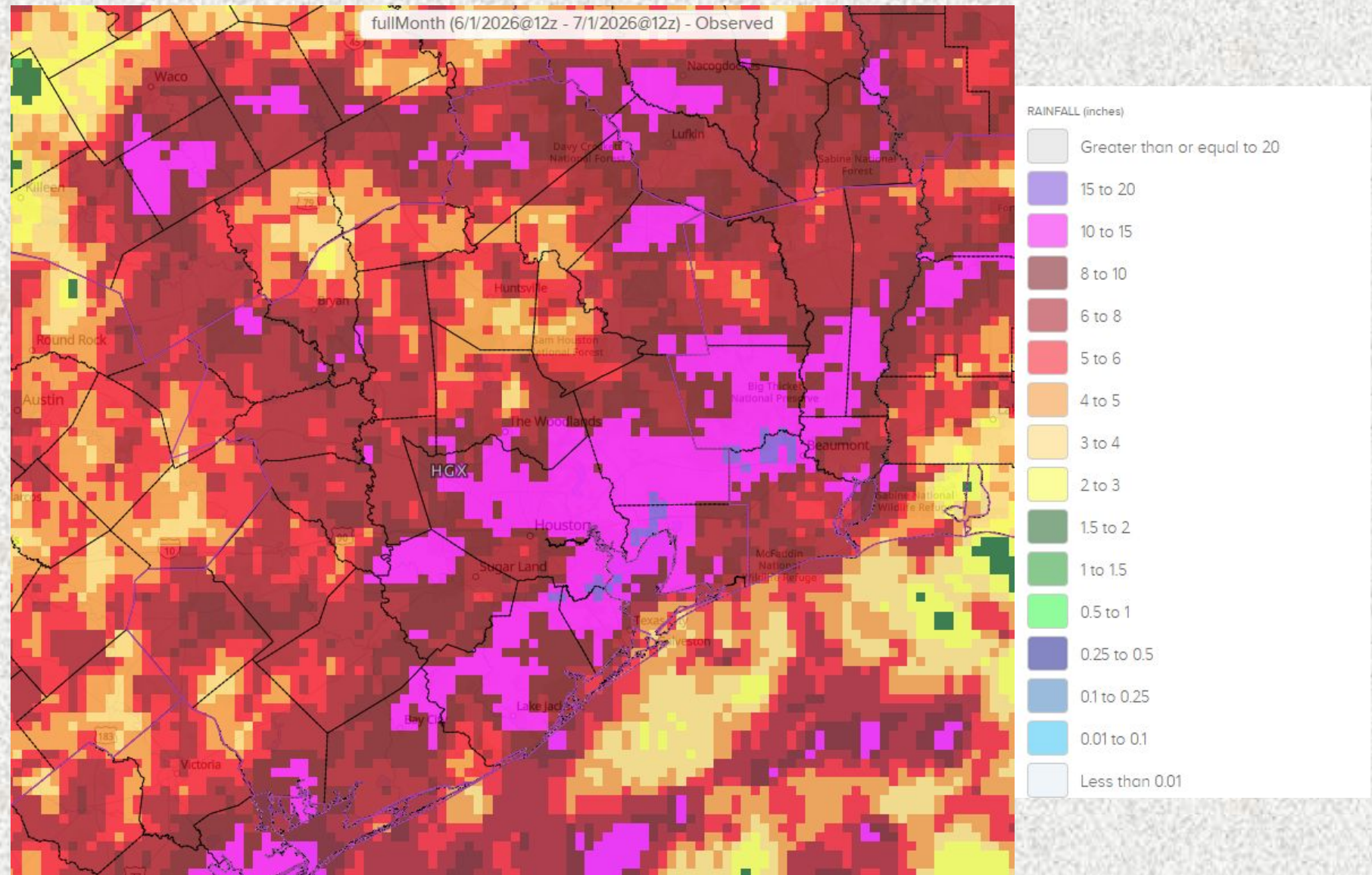
NWS Houston/Galveston Monthly Hydrologic Report June 2026

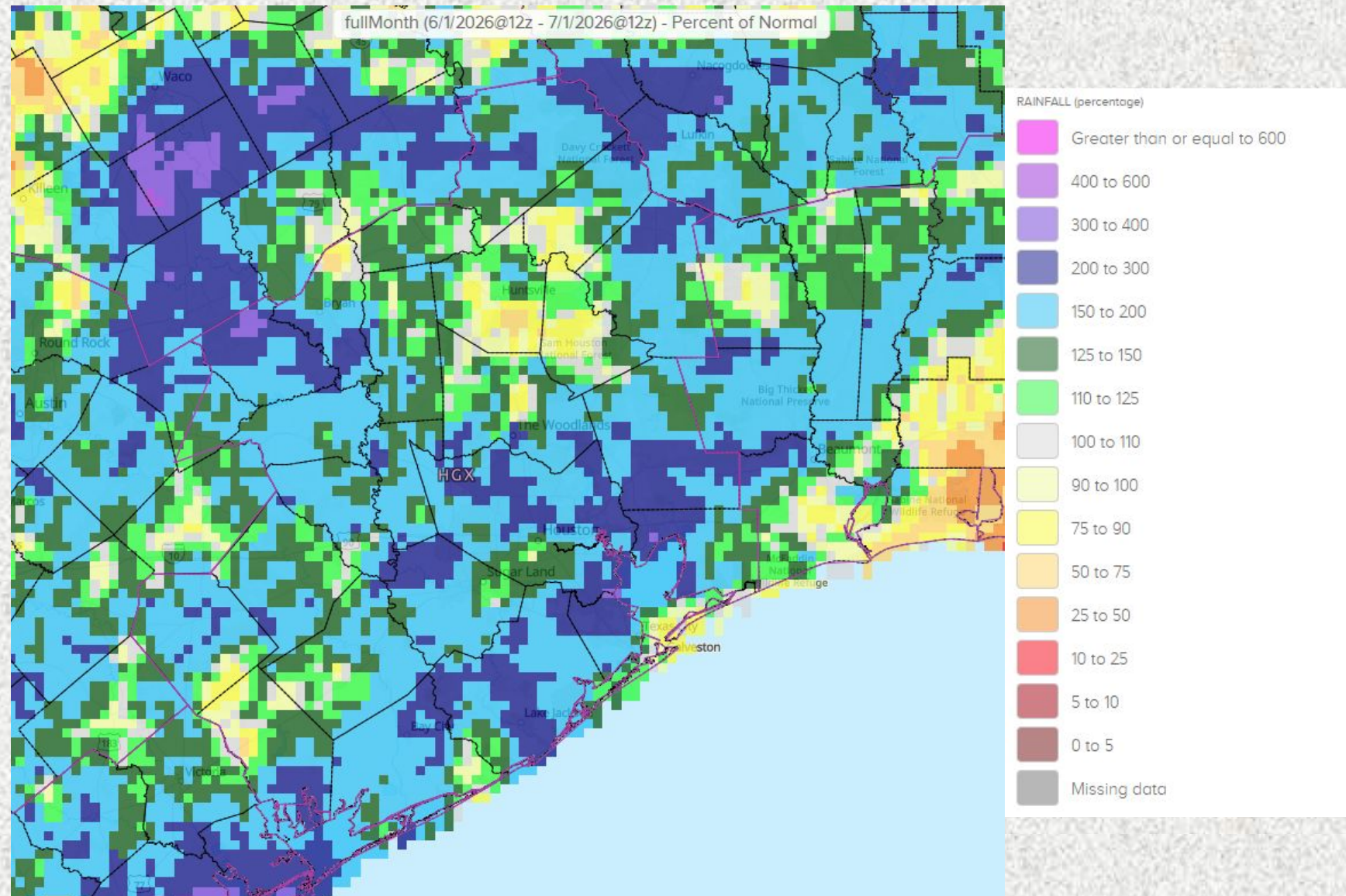

June featured multiple rounds of heavy rainfall resulting in widespread totals of 8-12+”. Areas near and south of I-10 received the highest rainfall totals near and exceeding 15”. The mid June rainfall occurred due to Tropical Storm Arthur and resulted in multiple rivers, creeks, and bayous reaching flood stage along with numerous reports of flash flooding across Southeast Texas. As a result, the drought is essentially over for most of the region with just a few areas lingering in abnormally dry territory.

Monthly Precipitation

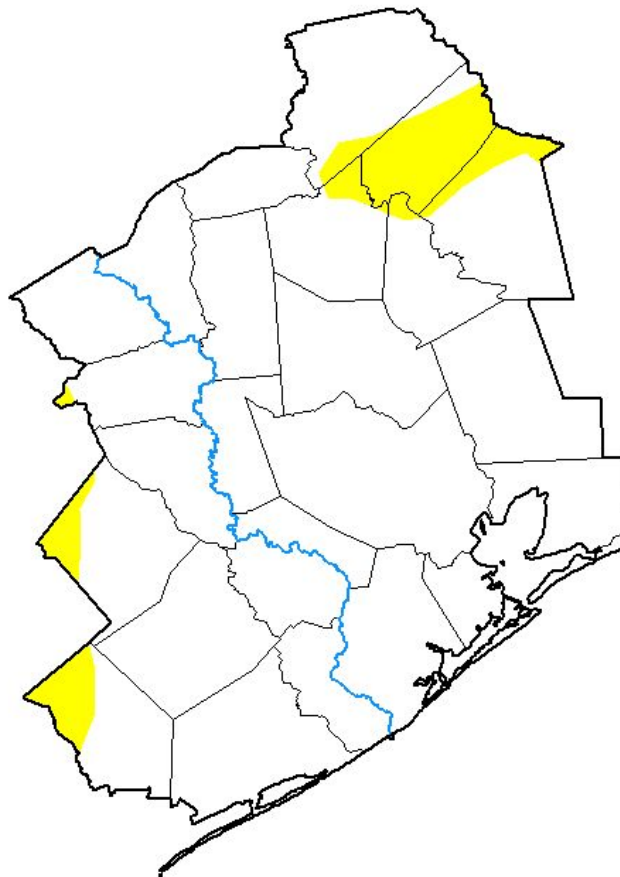


Monthly Percent of Normal Precipitation

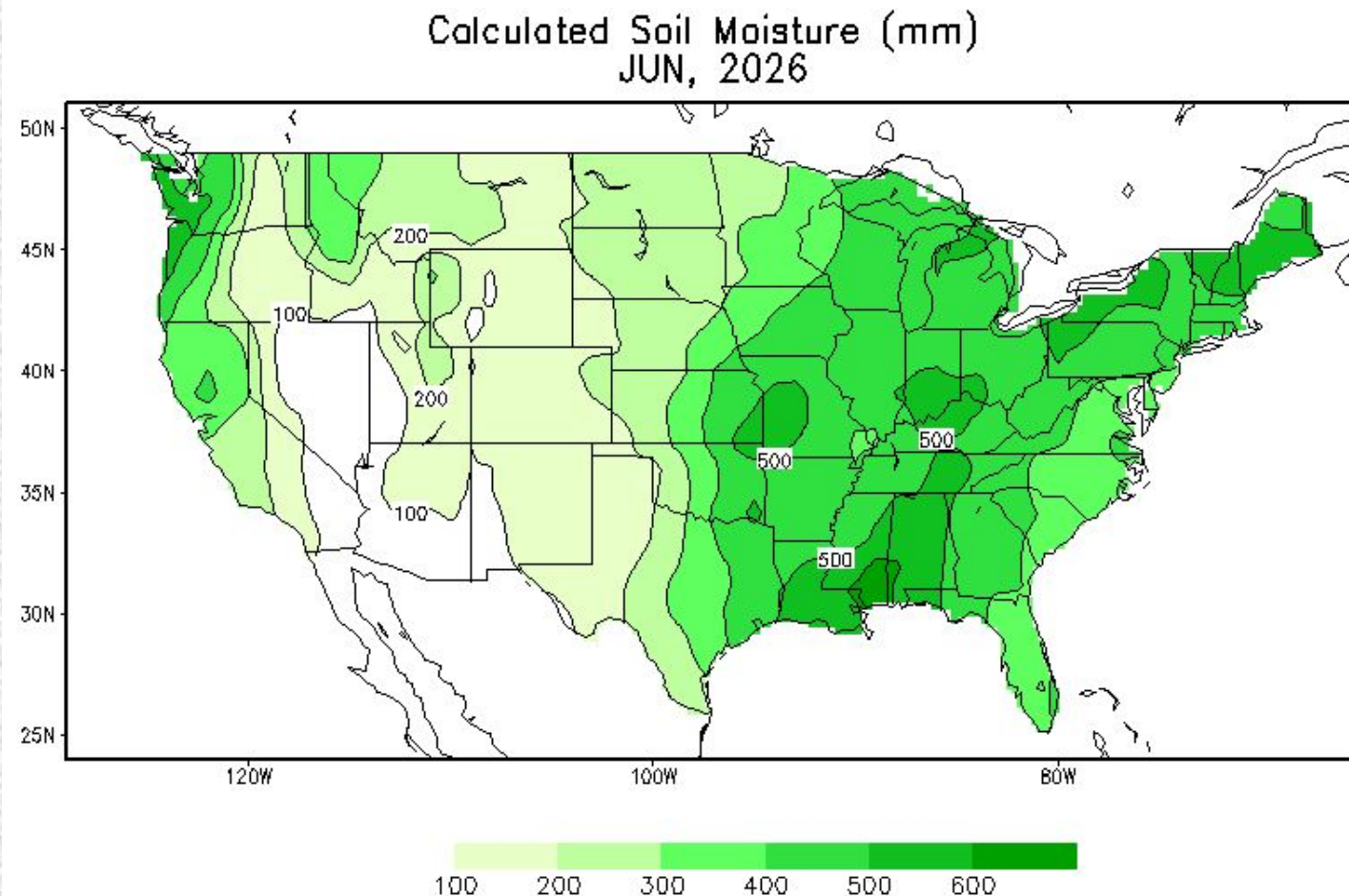

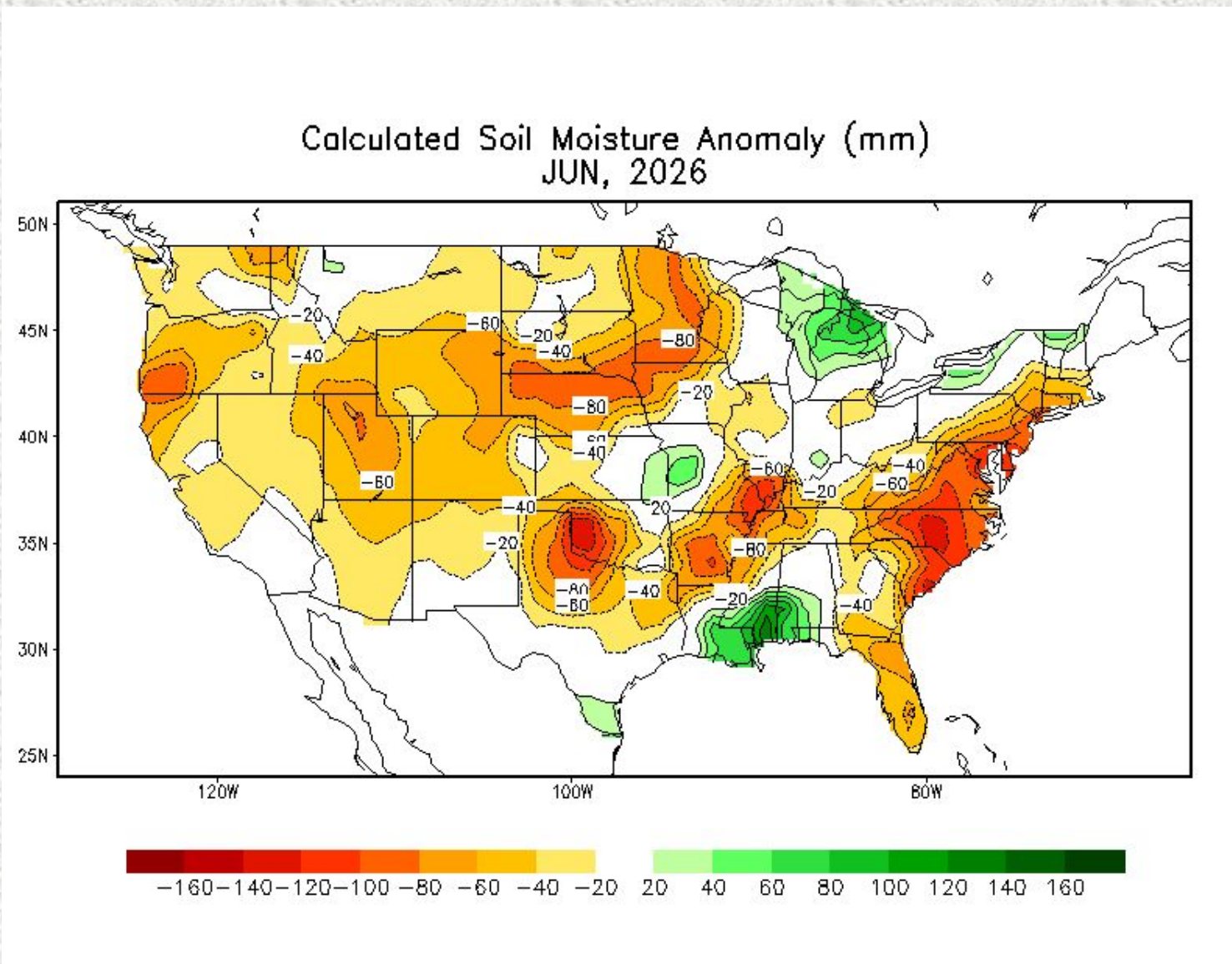

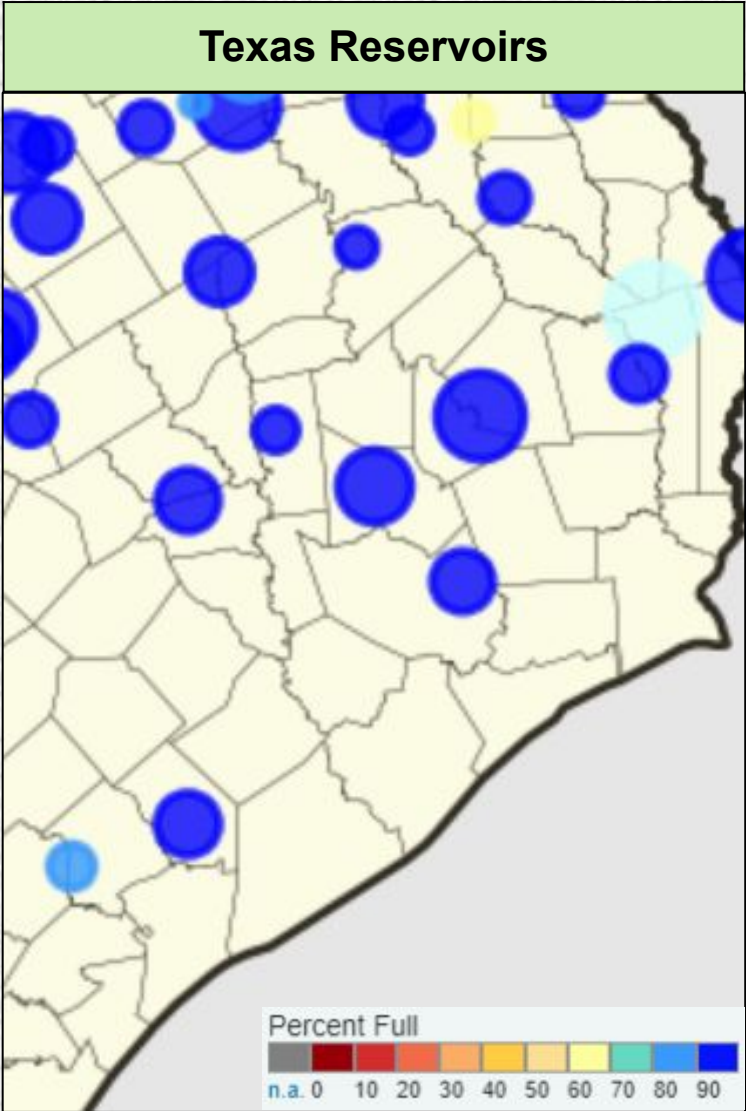

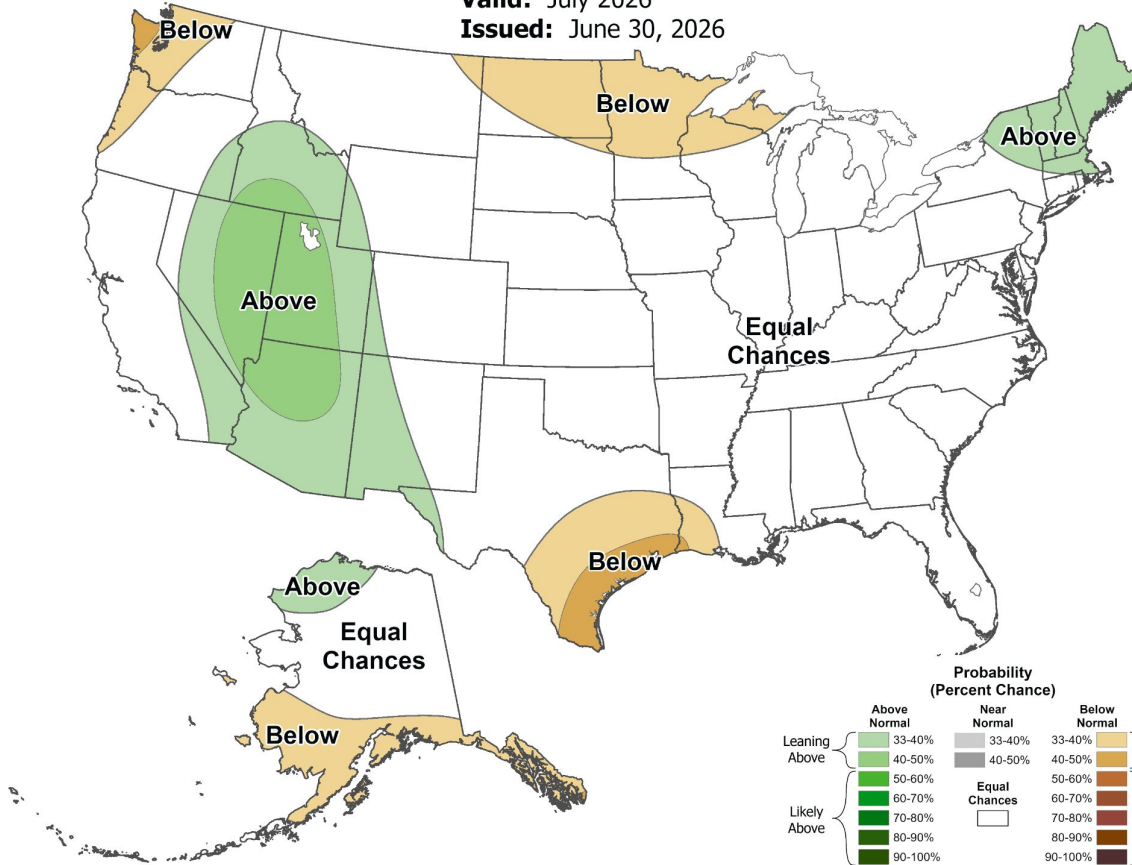

Precipitation Outlooks



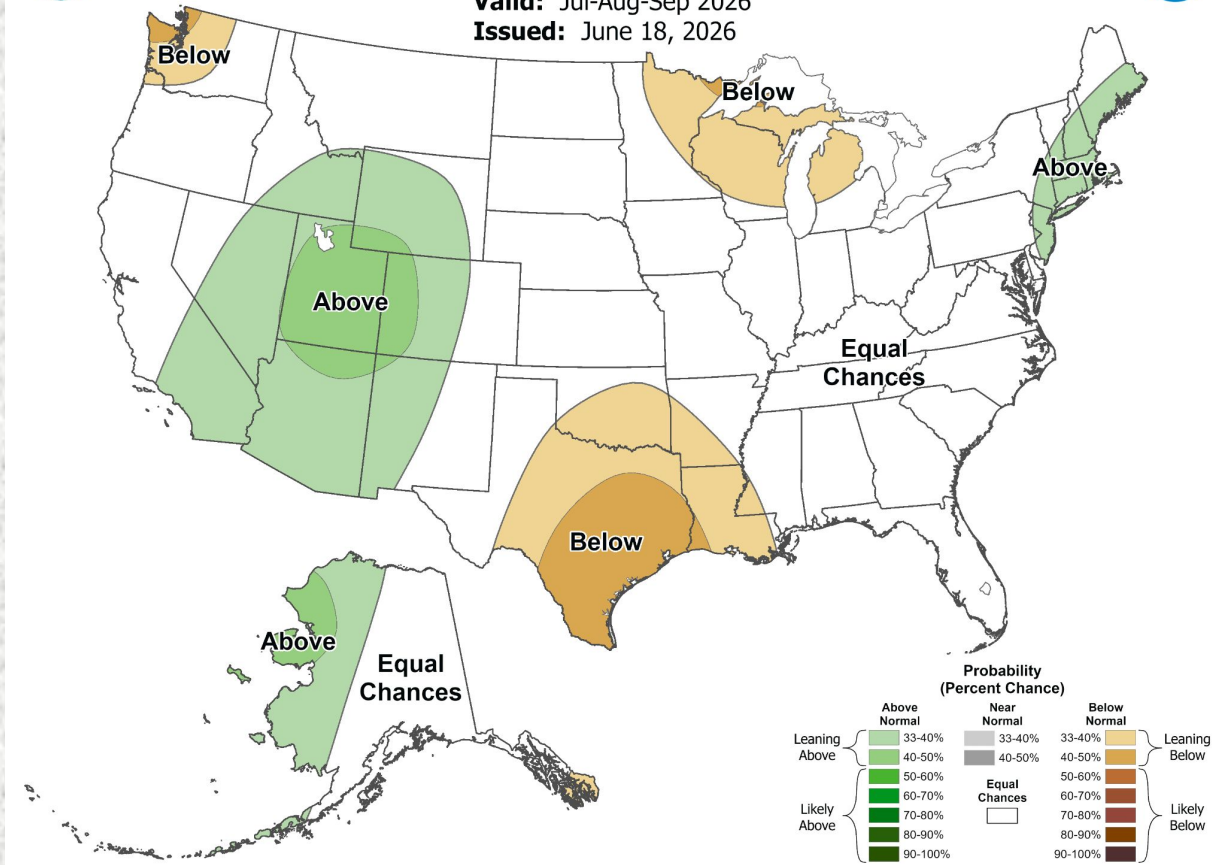
