Web cameras showed portions of Highway 288 South going under water. Two lanes on I-10 at the 610 Loop were flooded on the west side of Houston. Reports of high water and impassable roadways around NRG Stadium. An underpass at Washington Avenue and Katy Freeway was impassable due to flood waters with significant flooding reported at Highway 290 and Hollister Street. There was several inches of water in a church near Melrose Park, and there was water in three homes in Spring.

Clusters of rain and thunderstorms formed upon smaller scale boundaries over the greater Houston metropolitan area. These slow-moving cells produced upwards of 8 inches of rain over a few hours from downtown into the Medical Center area. This caused major roadway flooding with some water entering structures in the Spring area.
