A high amplitude ridge just offshore of Central California during the day of the 1st led to a north-to-south diving shortwave on the east side of the ridge bringing an increase in wind to the west side of the Central and Southern San Joaquin Valley. Wind speeds to 40 MPH from the northwest were observed on the San Joaquin Valley floor with some areas of decreased visibility in blowing dust. In the Kern Mountains and Kern County portion of the Mojave Desert peak wind gusts were observed up to 50 MPH from the upper elevation southwest-to-west wind.
