Snow fell as low as the Sierra Nevada foothills, with up to 6 inches of snow falling in Mariposa County tapering off sharply to the south, with less than 2 inches being reported in Tulare County. The largest amount over the higher elevations was 22 inches at Lodgepole (6735 feet msl). Snow also fell across the Kern County mountains, closing State Highway 58 through the Tehachapi Pass. Strong winds developed in the wake of the system across the Kern County desert into the evening of the 23rd.

In Ridgecrest (Kern County), shingles were blown off homes and an empty furniture delivery van was rolled over and totaled.
