The Tehipite Fire occurred in Sequoia National Park. The ignition date was July 19 at 1315 PDT. The cause was lightning. The location was 20 miles northeast of Dunlap in Fresno County. The size of the wildfire was 1,331 acres. Estimated date of containment was October 15. There were no fatalities or lost structures. The cost to containment was \$500,000.
