Further north, rainfall amounts were lower, but many new daily rainfall records were set for August 20. Numerous reports of flash flooding and road closures were observed in Kern County during the afternoon of August 20 through the early morning of August 21. The rains dissipated during the morning of August 21, but an offshore trough provided for enough instability for thunderstorms to break out over the area during the afternoon of August 21 which produced locally heavy rainfall. The trough lifted northeast on August 22 resulting in the moisture being pushed out of our area and drier conditions prevailed for the remainder of the

week.
