Our History

As part of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), the National Weather Service (NWS) in Huntsville is one of 122 Weather Forecast Offices. NWS Huntsville began its current tenure at the University of Alabama Huntsville's campus in January of 2003, and is one of the most recent office additions in the agency.

Our Mission

Our mission within the National Weather Service is the following: ***Provide weather, water and climate data, forecasts, warnings, and impact-based decision support services for the protection of life and property.***

Our mission is accomplished by issuing timely weather forecasts, including Watches and Warnings, and effectively communicating hazardous weather in advance throughout the Tennessee Valley.

NOAA Weather Radio

The NWS utilizes NOAA Weather Radio as your 24-hour a day, 7-day week source for weather information, including severe weather warnings. While routine programming offers the latest forecast and current observations, the broadcast cycle is automatically updated whenever a Watch, Warning, or other Weather Statement is issued by the NWS in Huntsville.
