- \* AT 152 PM EDT...NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE DOPPLER RADAR WAS TRACKING  
A TORNADO 6 MILES EAST OF BARNESVILLE...OR 15 MILES SOUTH OF  
LUMBERTON...MOVING NORTH AT 20 MPH.
  
- \* THE TORNADO IS EXPECTED TO BE NEAR...  
  
LUMBERTON BY 230 PM...  
BARKER TEN MILE BY 240 PM...  
BUIE BY 255 PM...  
RENNERT BY 300 PM...

THE SAFEST PLACE TO BE DURING A TORNADO IS IN A BASEMENT. GET UNDER A  
WORKBENCH OR OTHER PIECE OF STURDY FURNITURE. IF NO BASEMENT IS  
AVAILABLE...SEEK SHELTER ON THE LOWEST FLOOR OF THE BUILDING IN AN  
INTERIOR HALLWAY OR ROOM SUCH AS A CLOSET. USE BLANKETS OR PILLOWS TO  
COVER YOUR BODY AND ALWAYS STAY AWAY FROM WINDOWS.

IF IN MOBILE HOMES OR VEHICLES...EVACUATE THEM AND GET INSIDE A  
SUBSTANTIAL SHELTER. IF NO SHELTER IS AVAILABLE...LIE FLAT IN THE  
NEAREST DITCH OR OTHER LOW SPOT AND COVER YOUR HEAD WITH YOUR HANDS.

IF YOU OBSERVED SEVERE WEATHER OR WEATHER RELATED DAMAGE...REPORT IT  
TO THE NEAREST LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AND ASK THEM TO RELAY THE  
REPORT TO THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE FORECAST OFFICE IN WILMINGTON  
NC.

A TORNADO WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 700 PM EDT TUESDAY EVENING  
FOR SOUTHEAST NORTH CAROLINA AND NORTHEAST SOUTH CAROLINA. A TORNADO  
WATCH ALSO REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 200 PM EDT TUESDAY AFTERNOON FOR  
NORTHEAST SOUTH CAROLINA. A TORNADO WATCH ALSO REMAINS IN EFFECT  
UNTIL 700 PM EDT TUESDAY EVENING FOR NORTHEAST SOUTH CAROLINA.
