



Wintry Weather Possible on Friday and Saturday

- A combination of snow, sleet, freezing rain, and rain is possible across portions of northeast SC and southeast SC Fri. and Sat.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rain associated with a cold front may transition to a wintry mix late Thursday night into Friday. Snow, sleet, or freezing rain may continue Friday into Saturday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If accumulations of snow, sleet, or freezing rain occur, portions of the area could see hazardous travel conditions throughout the weekend. Power outages are also possible in areas of ice accumulation. At this time, the highest potential for accumulating ice will exist east of I-95 with a better chance of snow or sleet west of I-95.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> None at this time
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is high uncertainty regarding the track of the storm and temperatures which will determine if parts of the area see snow, sleet, freezing rain, or rain.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Breezy conditions are likely throughout the weekend which may worsen potential impacts.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dry weather and cooler temps are expected Sunday and Monday.
