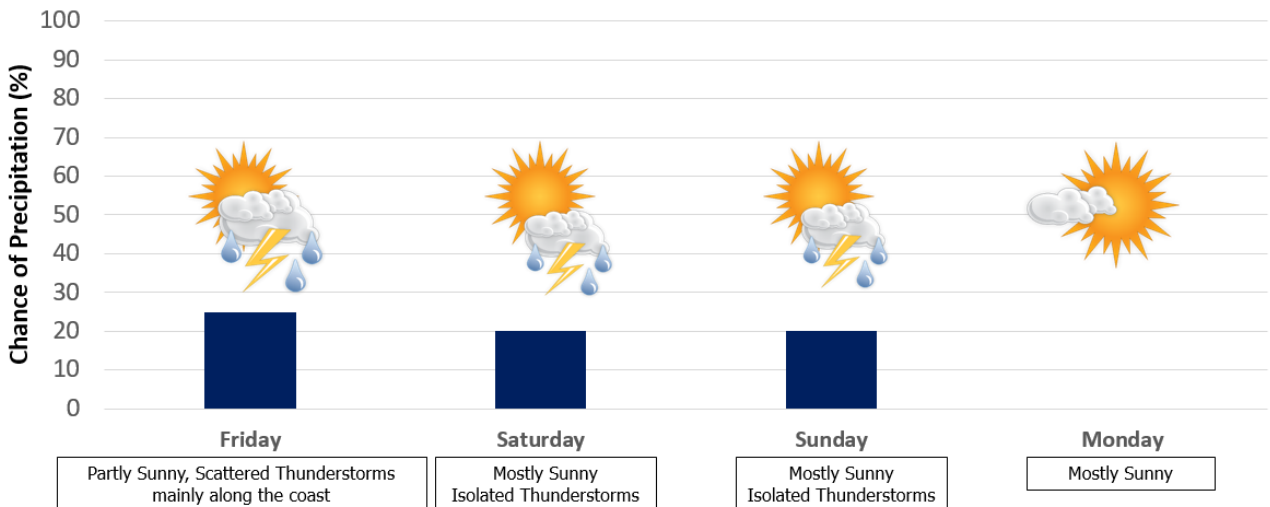

Overview: The low pressure system off Cape Hatteras will move away from the area as high pressure reigns over the Carolinas through Monday. Scattered thunderstorms today mainly along the coast, other isolated thunderstorms Saturday and Sunday.

Impacts: Moderate Risk of Rip Currents for the southeast North Carolina beaches north of Bald Head Island for today.
