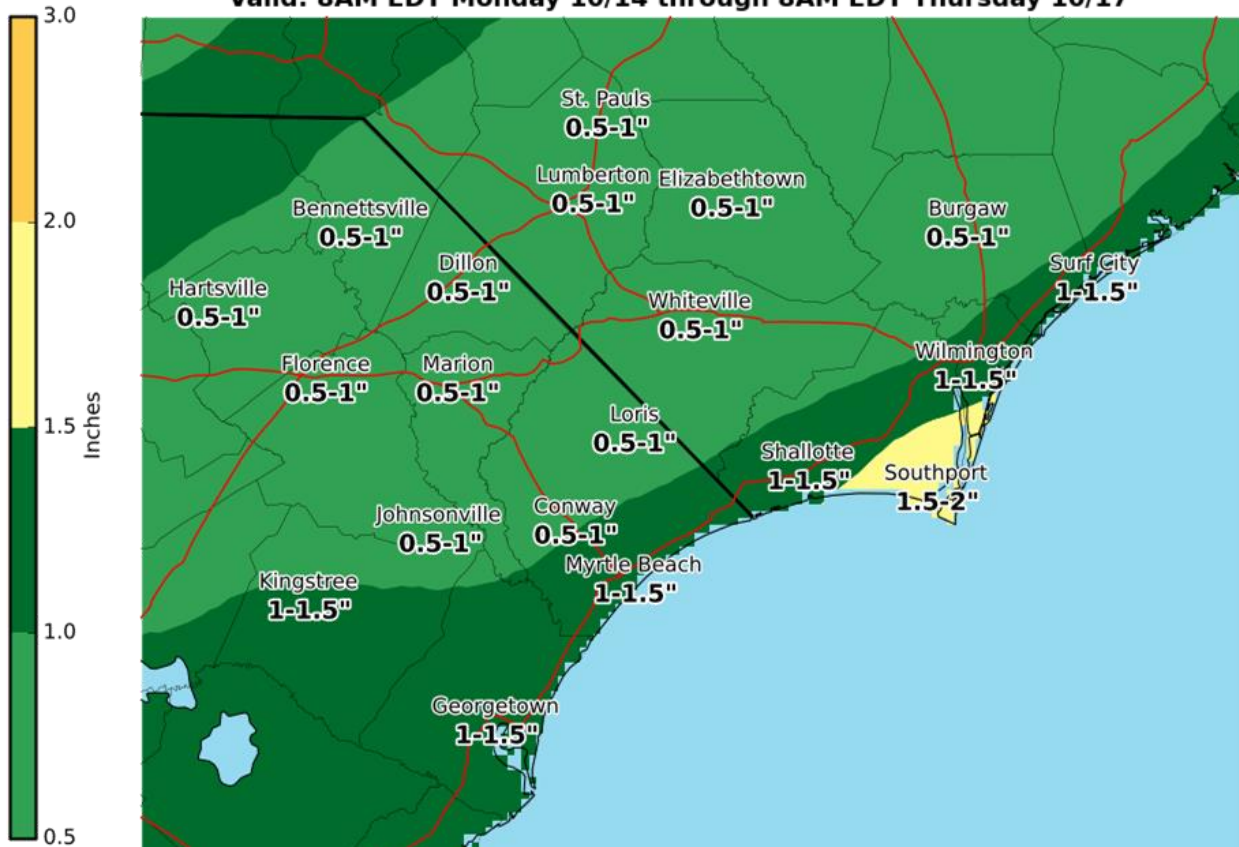
Overview: A front will remain stalled in the area into Wednesday morning before a strong cold front ushers in cooler high pressure for the end of the week.

- Highlights:**
- Forecast rainfall is in addition to the 0.50" to 1.00" that fell across the area early Monday.
 - Best rainfall chances will be Tuesday night into Wednesday.
 - Strong cold front to cross the area Wednesday afternoon.
 - Severe weather is not anticipated with the passage of the front.
 - Highs in the upper 60s, lows in the mid to upper 40s Thursday and Friday.

Impacts: Minor coastal flooding along the lower Cape Fear River at Wilmington is possible through mid-week.
