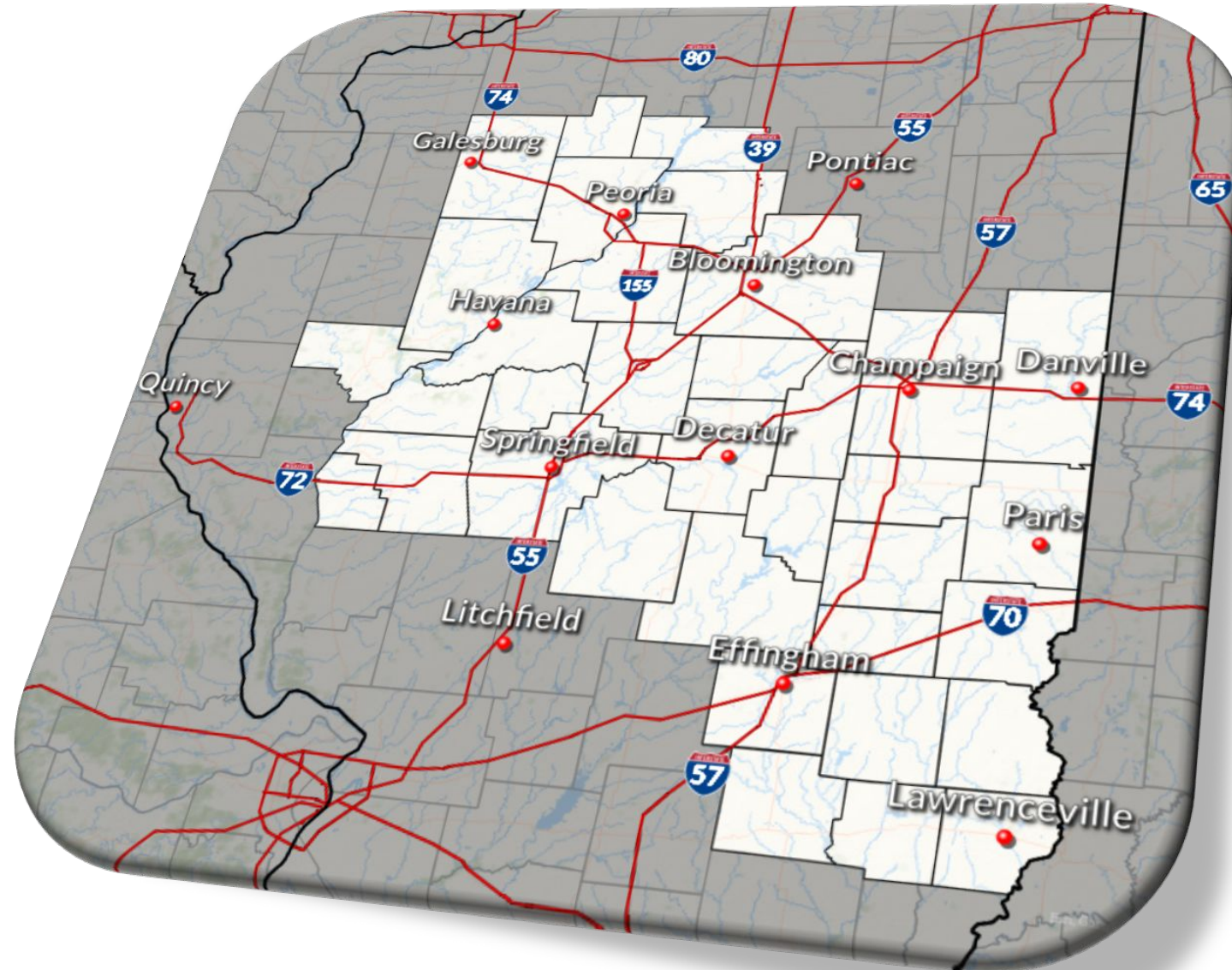

Bottom Line Up Front

What	Where	When	Impacts
Hot & Humid	Central/SE IL	Fri-Sun	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Risk for heat related illness for those without effective cooling and hydration
Scattered Thunderstorms	Central/SE IL	Sat night-Tue	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dangerous cloud-to-ground lightning• Locally heavy rain• Locally gusty winds

- Hot and humid conditions return for Friday through Sunday with afternoon heat indices peaking at 95-100 degrees.
- Scattered storms are forecast Saturday night through early next week. While organized severe weather is not expected, dangerous lightning, locally heavy rain, and gusty winds are possible.

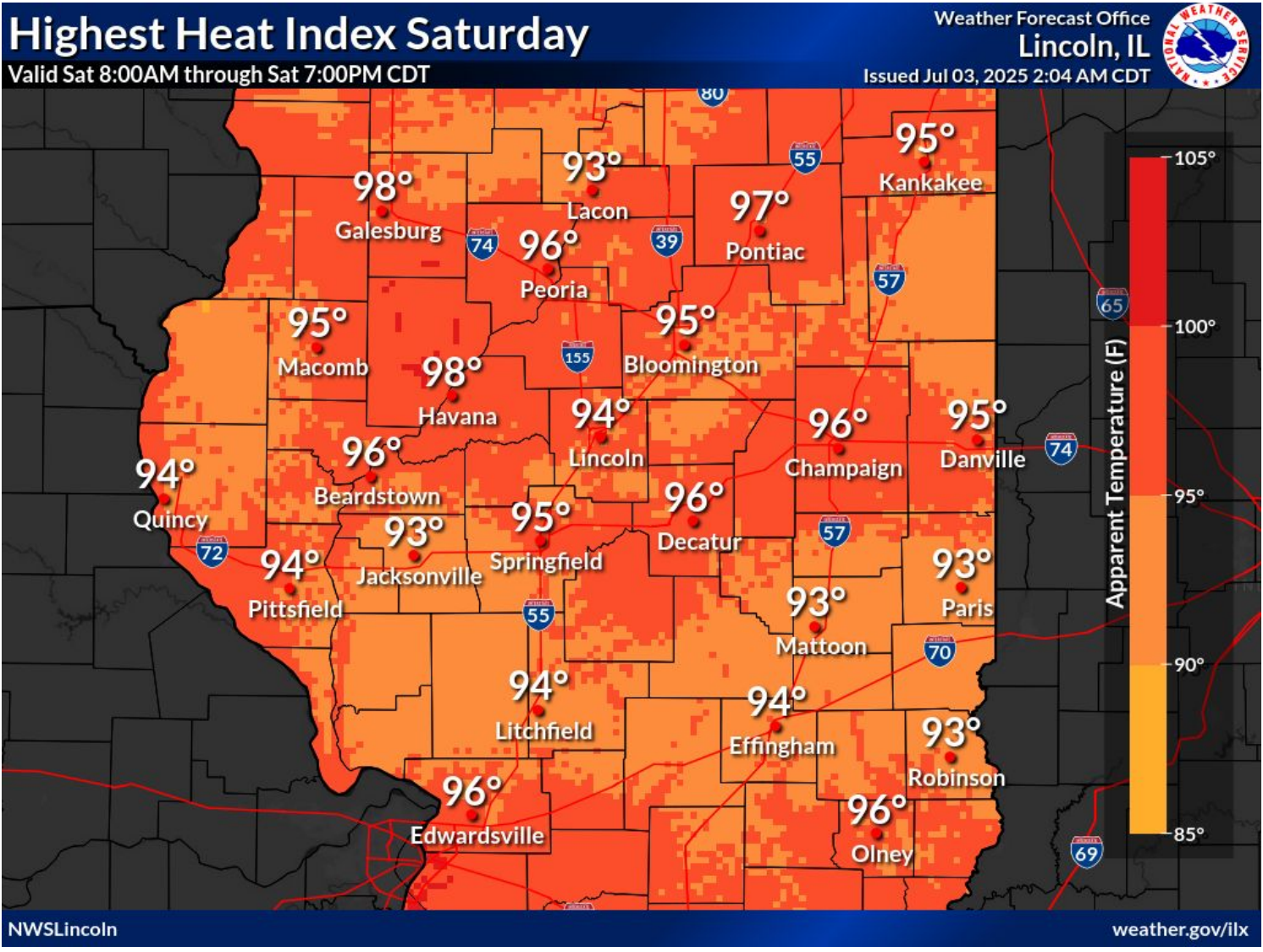
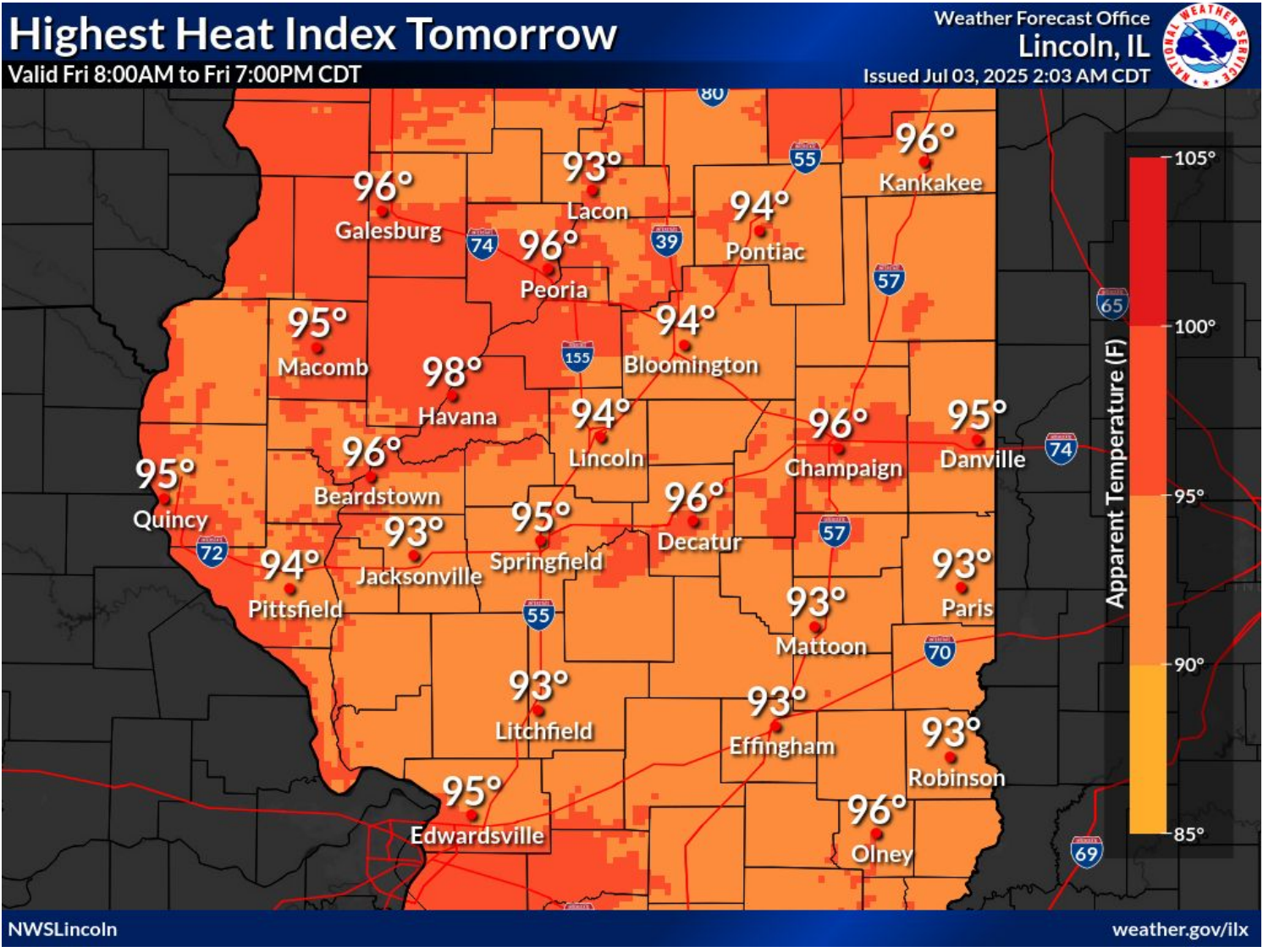

Heat Index Forecast Friday and Saturday

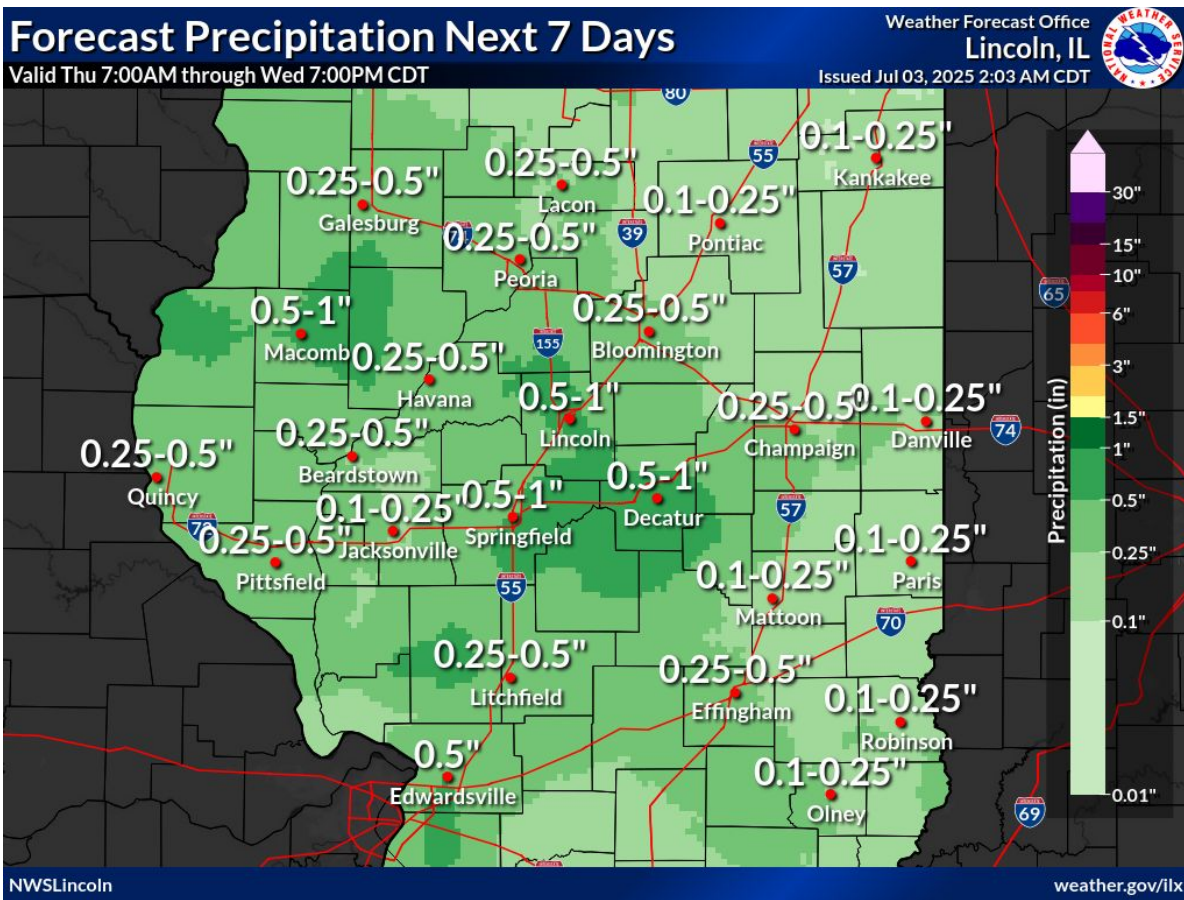




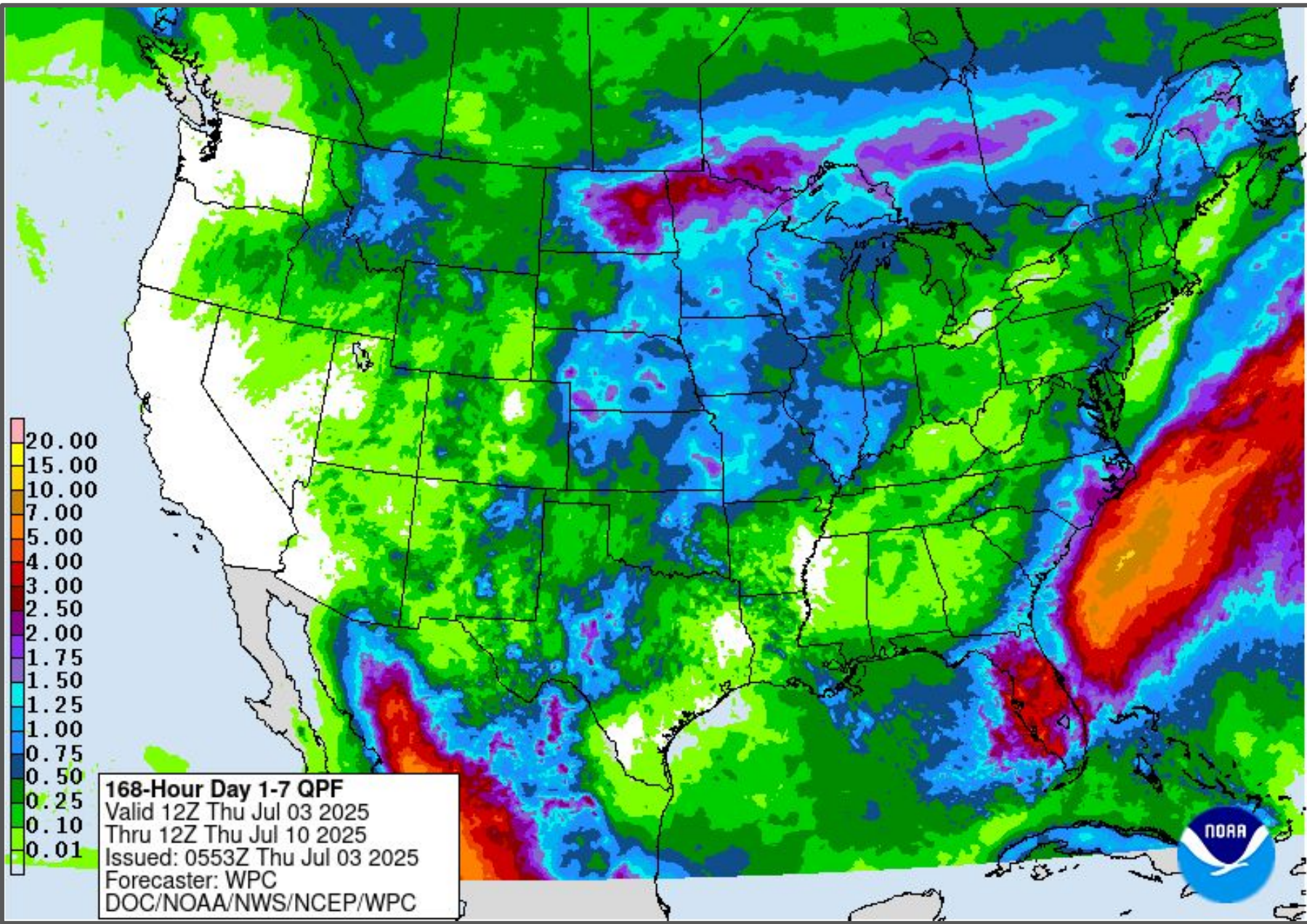

Locally heavy rain from storms Sun-Wed.



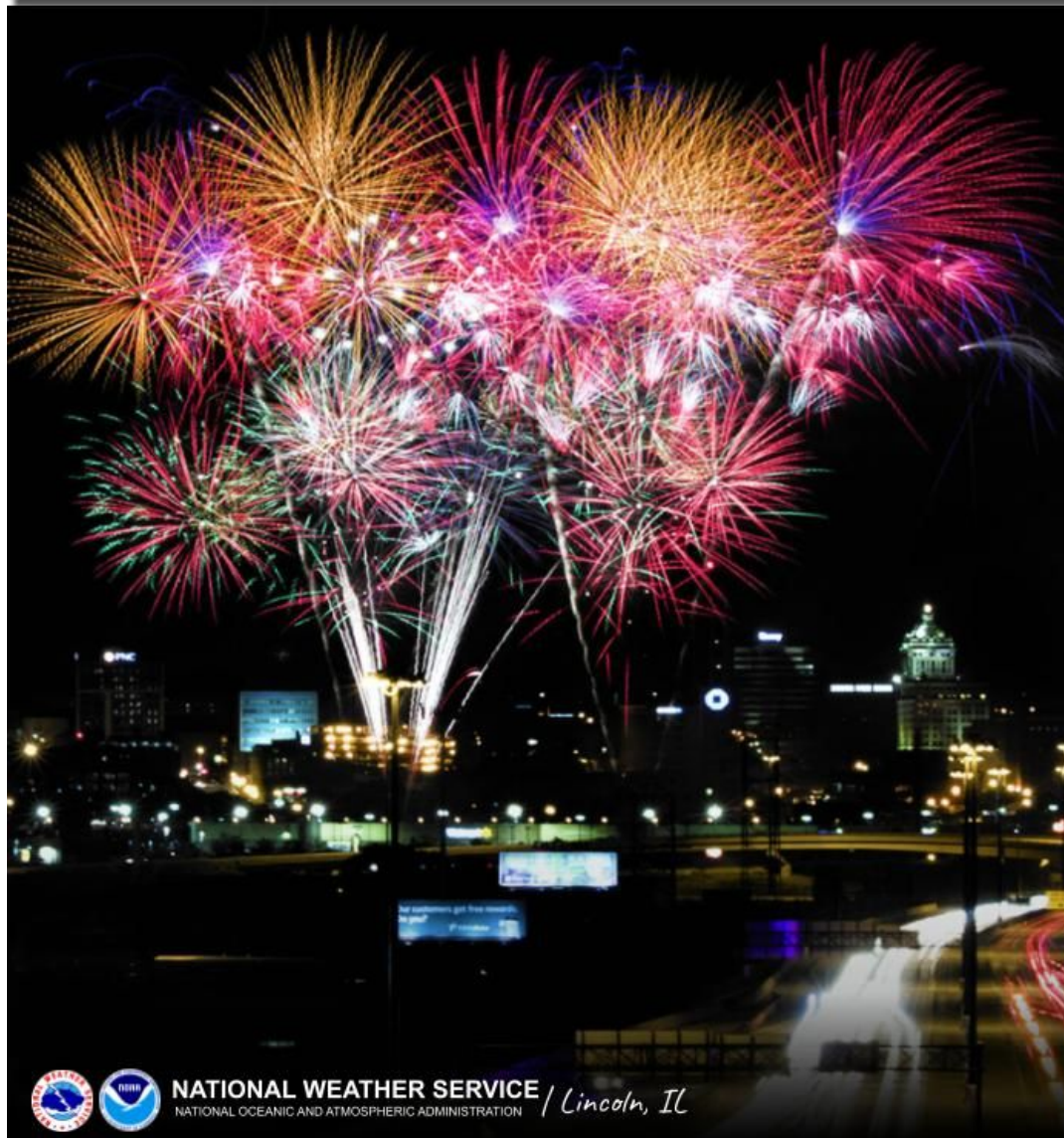

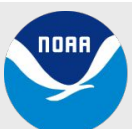

 - Sky – mostly clear

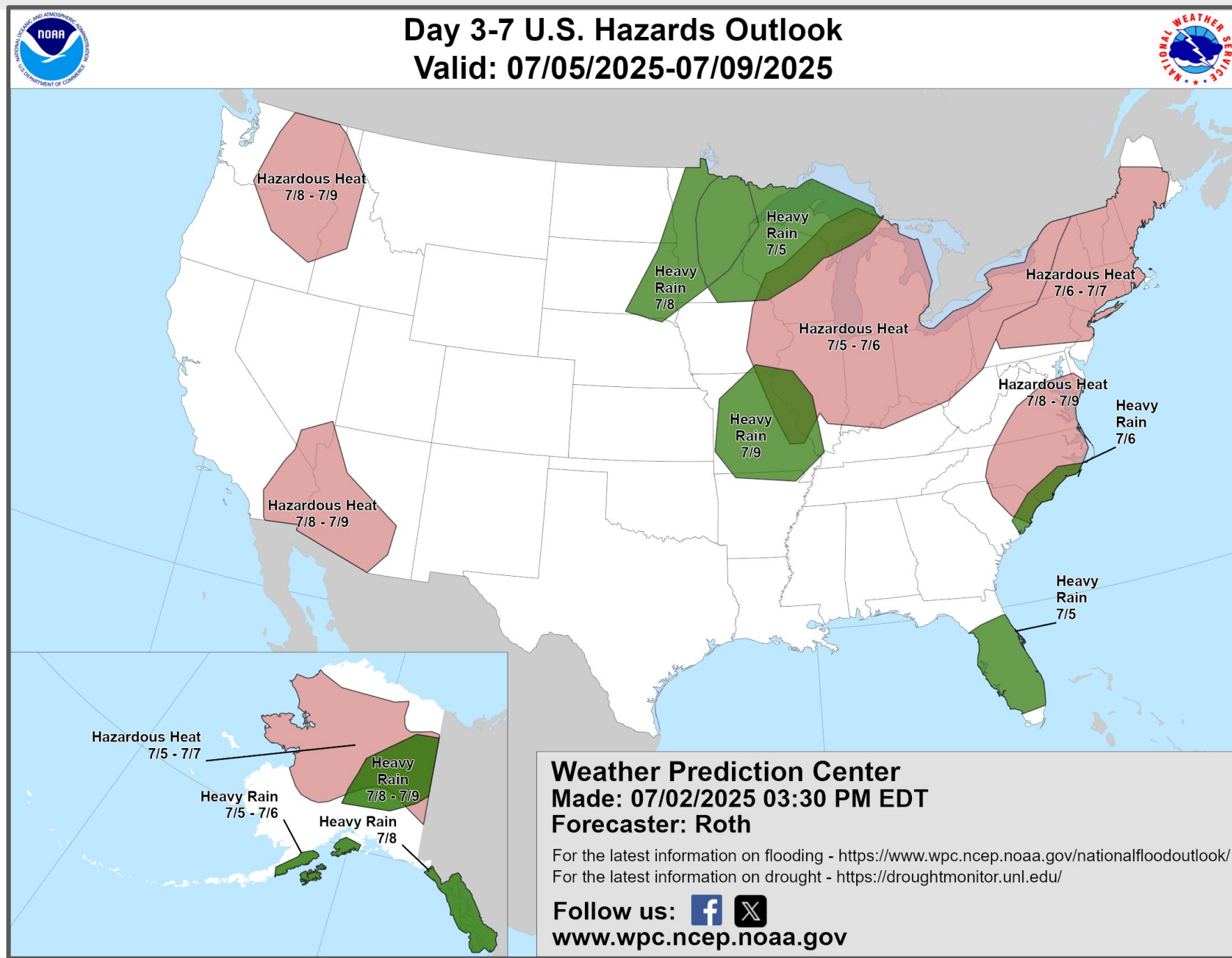

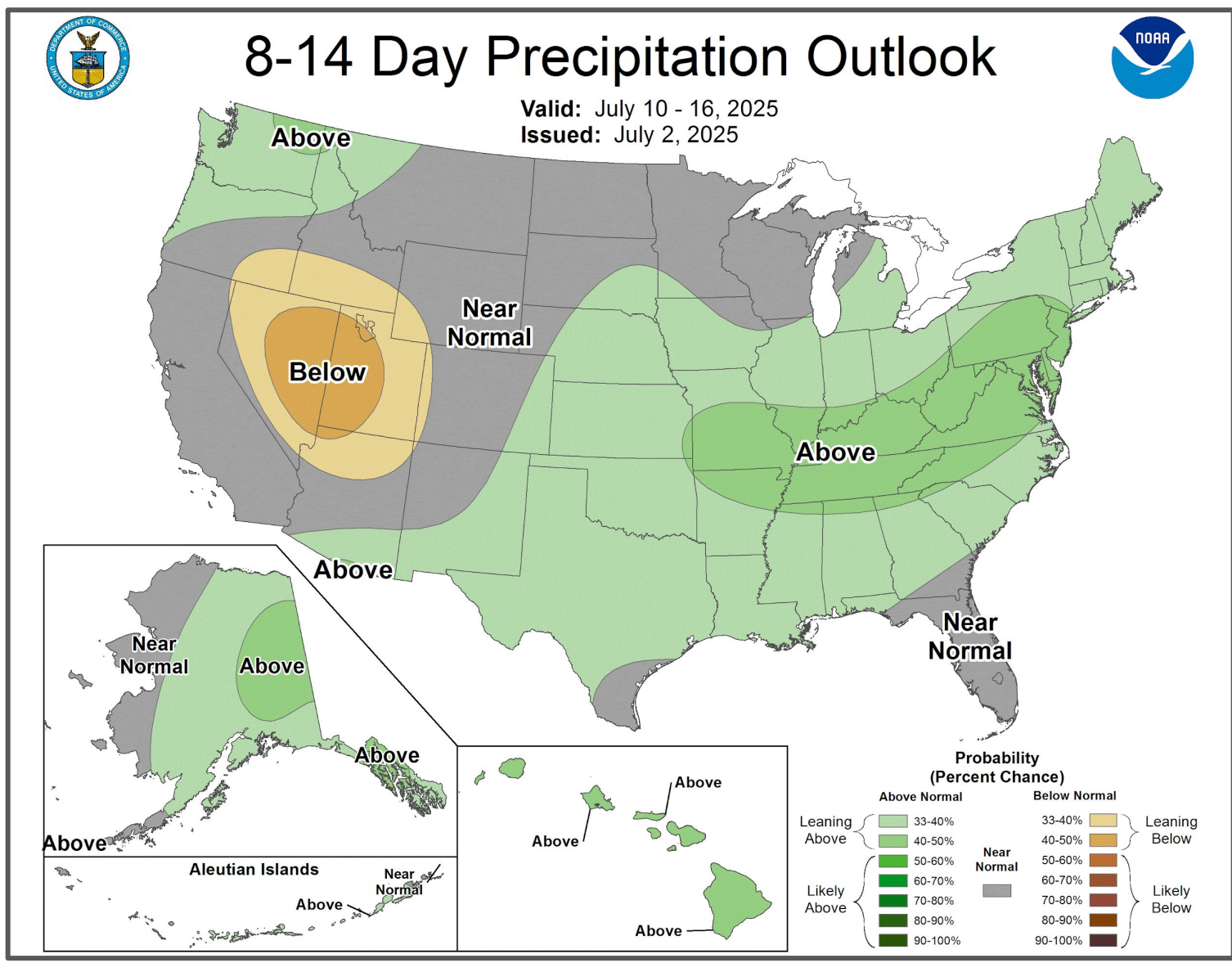
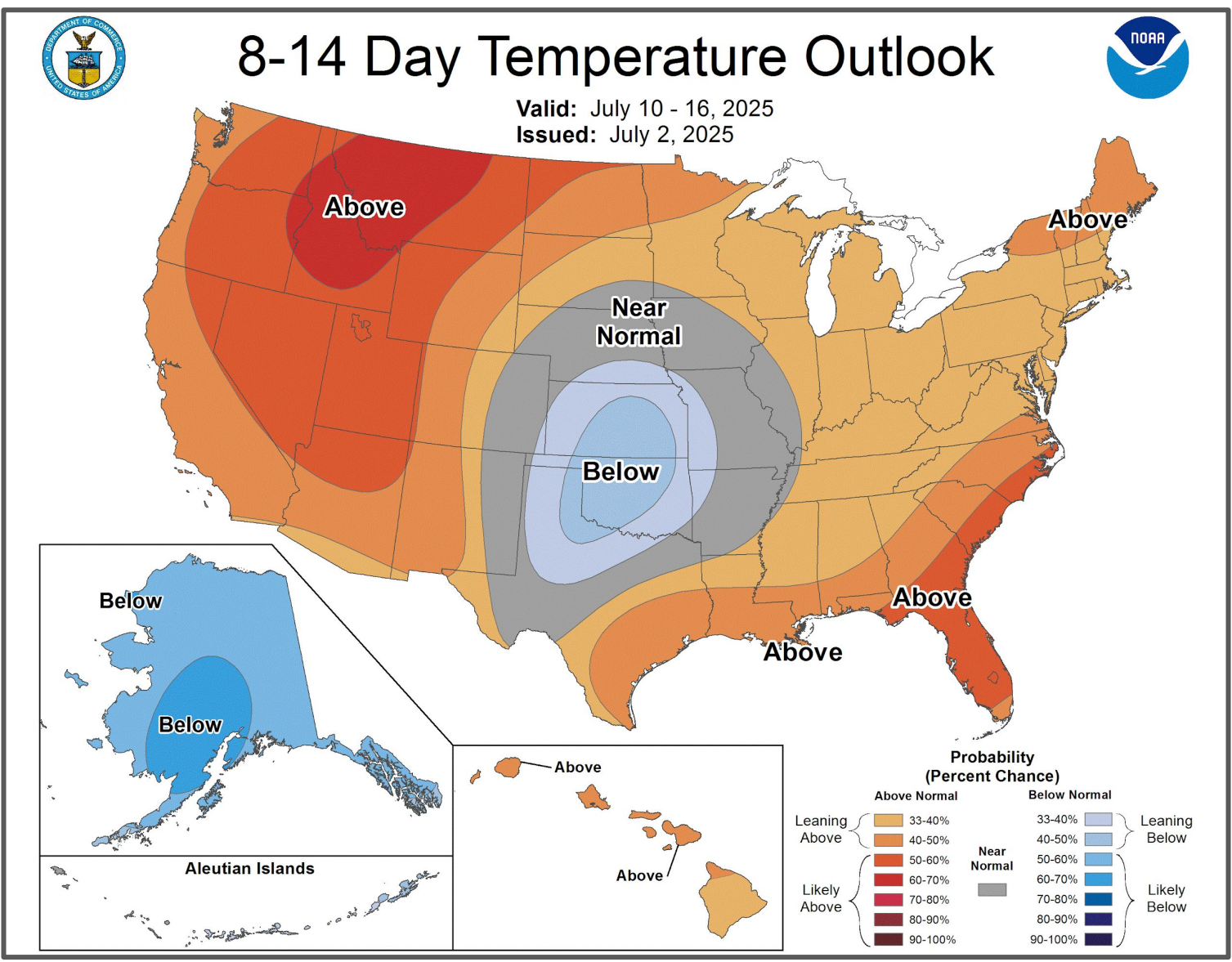
