<b>Concord</b>	WBO WBAS WSO	1902- 1933, 1937- 1996	A Weather Bureau office was opened in November 1902, then closed at the end of July 1933. After a few year hiatus, a new office was established just before Christmas 1937, at the First National Bank building. The office moved to the municipal airport in May 1941. The station began 16 hour a day operations in 1950, which continued until resuming full-time status in late 1970. The office closed in 1996, and was merged with the office in Gray, ME.
<b>Manchester</b>	WBO	1893	
<b>Mount Washington</b>	SigSvc WBO	1870- 1892, 1935- 1952	The Signal Service established an office south of Gorham on Mount Washington in 1870, operating until 1892. Operations on the mountain resumed in 1932, with Weather Bureau involvement beginning in 1935. Operations were contracted out to the Mt. Washington Observatory Corporation in 1952; the observatory remains in operation.
<b>Nashua</b>	CWSU	1978- present	The Boston-area Center Weather Service Unit operates at the ARTCC in Nashua.
