## **Key Points**


## **This Afternoon-Evening's Severe Threat:**

- Hazards: Damaging Winds, Large Hail, Isolated Tornadoes, and Localized Flooding
- Timing: 2:00 PM 10:00 PM
- Coverage: Numerous to widespread thunderstorms are expected
- Damaging wind gusts are the greatest threat, but large hail and isolated tornadoes are also possible
- Heavy rain and localized flooding are also threats
- Some uncertainty remains regarding development and exact evolution of the storms later today








## **Severe Storms Possible this Afternoon-Evening**




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## **Today's Severe Weather Hazards**

**60** mph

Primary threat is damaging wind gusts; Large hail and isolated tornadoes also possible





- Unlikely Possible
  - Likely
- Isolated tornadoes are possible. Risk is slightly higher over northwestern portions of the area ahead of the surface low



**Damaging Winds** 

**80** mph

• Damaging wind gusts in excess of 60 mph are possible. There is the potential for 70 to 80 MPH gusts in a few storms.

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
## Large Hail

**1.50**" 2.00" 2.50+"

• Large hail around 1-1.5" in diameter is possible with some storms.

Storms will generally move west to east at about 40 MPH

# Heavy Rainfall Threat through Tonight

Potential for flash flooding in areas receiving repeated rounds of storms

## WHAT

Thunderstorms capable of producing heavy rainfall and localized flooding. Damp soil from recent heavy rain could also allow for flash flooding to quickly develop.


### WHERE

All of Central Indiana

## WHEN

Thunderstorms are expected today and tonight, with coverage and intensity highest during the afternoon into the evening hours







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# ZIANCEDRISK

Numerous severe storms possible.

Some longer lived severe storms -- a few intense storms possible. Have multiple ways to get NWS warnings and seek shelter immediately when warnings are issued for your location.







# Do You Really Know How Deep the Water is?

12 inches of fast-moving water can carry away a small car.

WHEN FLOODED **TURN AROUND** DON'T DROWN

6 inches of fast-moving water can knock over and carry away an adult. 18-24 inches of fast-moving water can

# carry away most large SUVs, vans and trucks.
