

### **Key Messages**

- Normal flood potential this spring
- Minor flooding is expected (50% chance or greater)
- Some chance for moderate flooding (25%) chance or greater)-Wabash, parts of the East Fork White, and lower White
- CPC outlooks favor a wetter than normal pattern
- Rainfall will be the primary driver of flooding







# **90 Day Departures from Normal**



### There is no snow or ice in place across central or southern Indiana.







### **7 Day Precipitation Forecast** March 9th - 16th




# **Flood Probabilities**


### **Most Likely Range of Outcomes**

### >50% Chance of Exceedance







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
