- Main Hazards: Damaging Wind Gusts & Isolated Tornadoes
- Timing: Through the day, exiting local Atlantic coast by evening
- Localized Flooding Rainfall Potential
- Non-Thunderstorm Wind Gusts of 30-45 mph



High Rip Current Risk Northeast FL Beaches Today

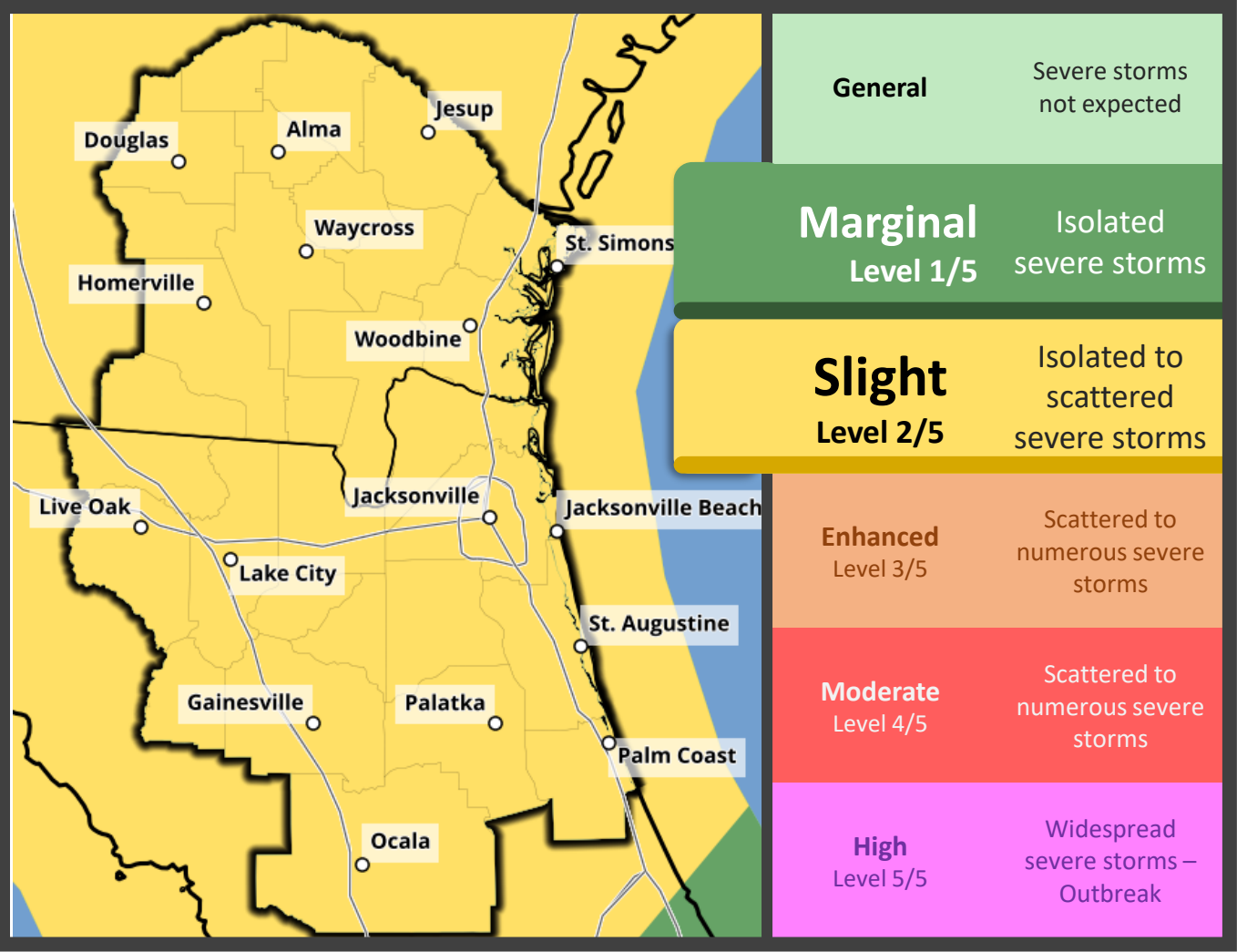


Small Craft Advisory Tonight through Thursday Night
