Increasing Thunderstorm Potential by Wednesday

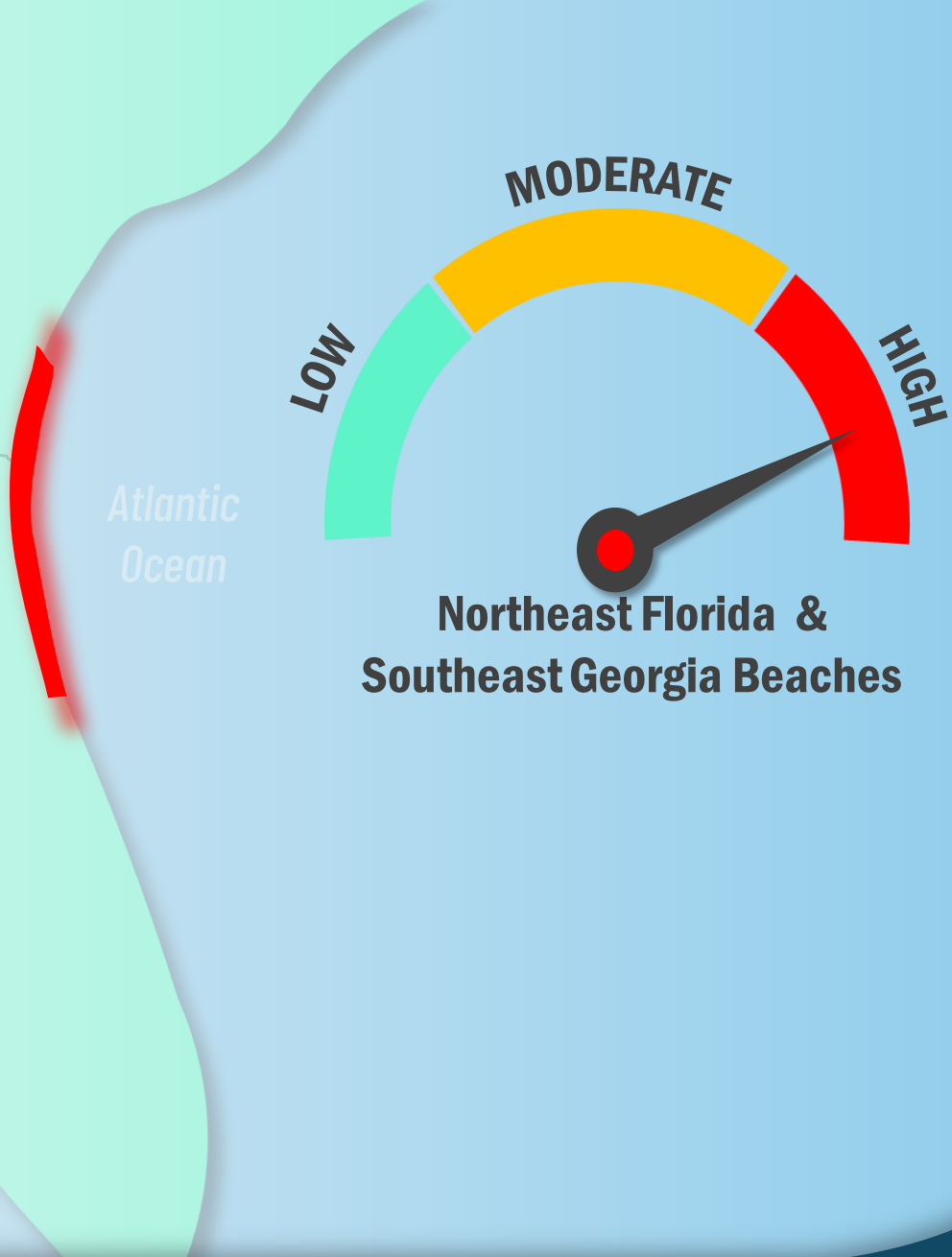


Locally Heavy Rainfall Potential Thursday, Friday & Saturday
