



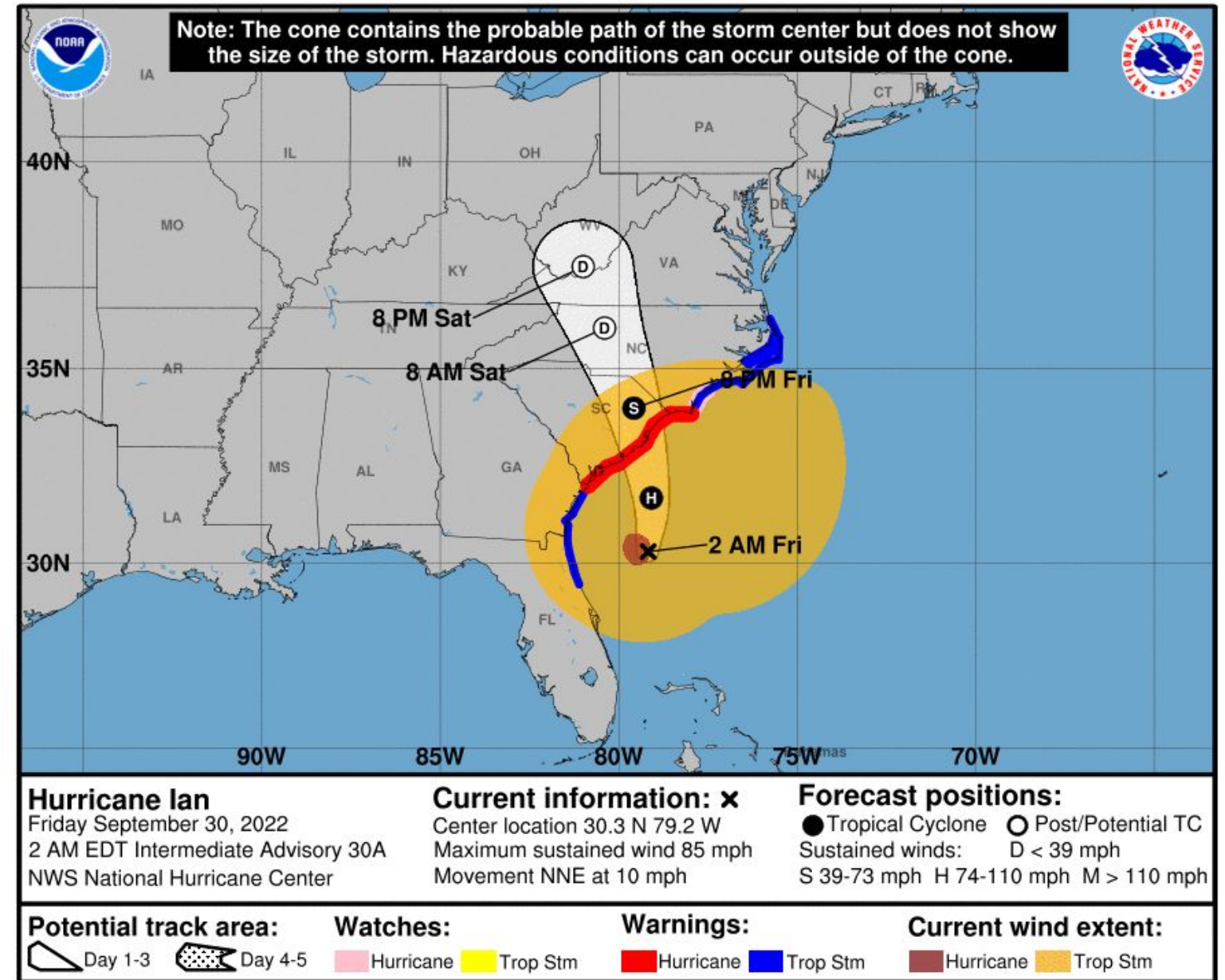

## Rain Showers Starting Tonight and Continuing Through the Weekend

### Key Messages

- There is still uncertainty on the exact track, but recent trends have suggested a path further east. This would result in less rainfall across eastern Kentucky.
- Rain is expected, but confidence is lower for flood risk.
- Rainfall in the past 14 days has been limited, so soil conditions are dry across most areas. Additionally, creeks and water bodies are running near-normal for this time of year.

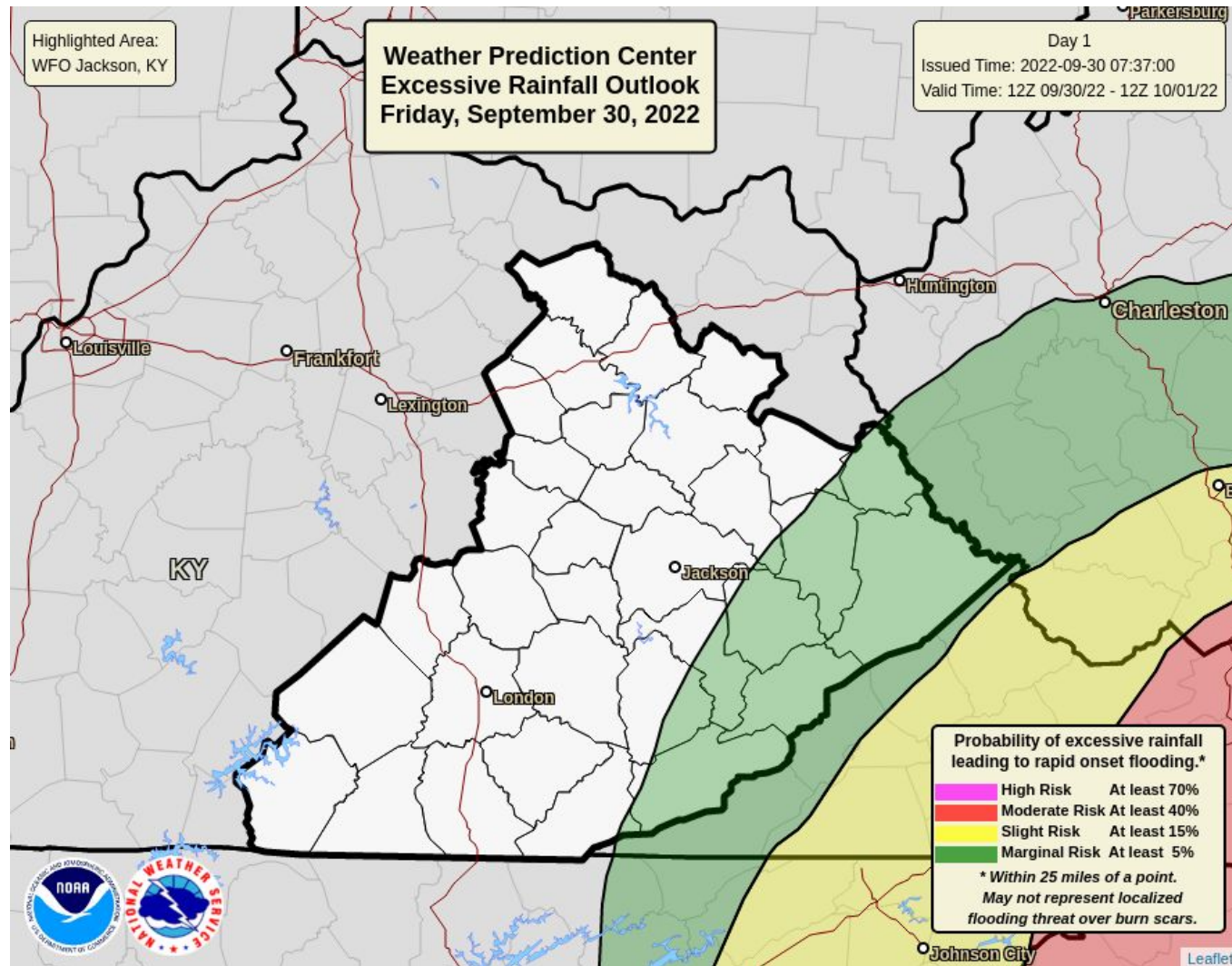

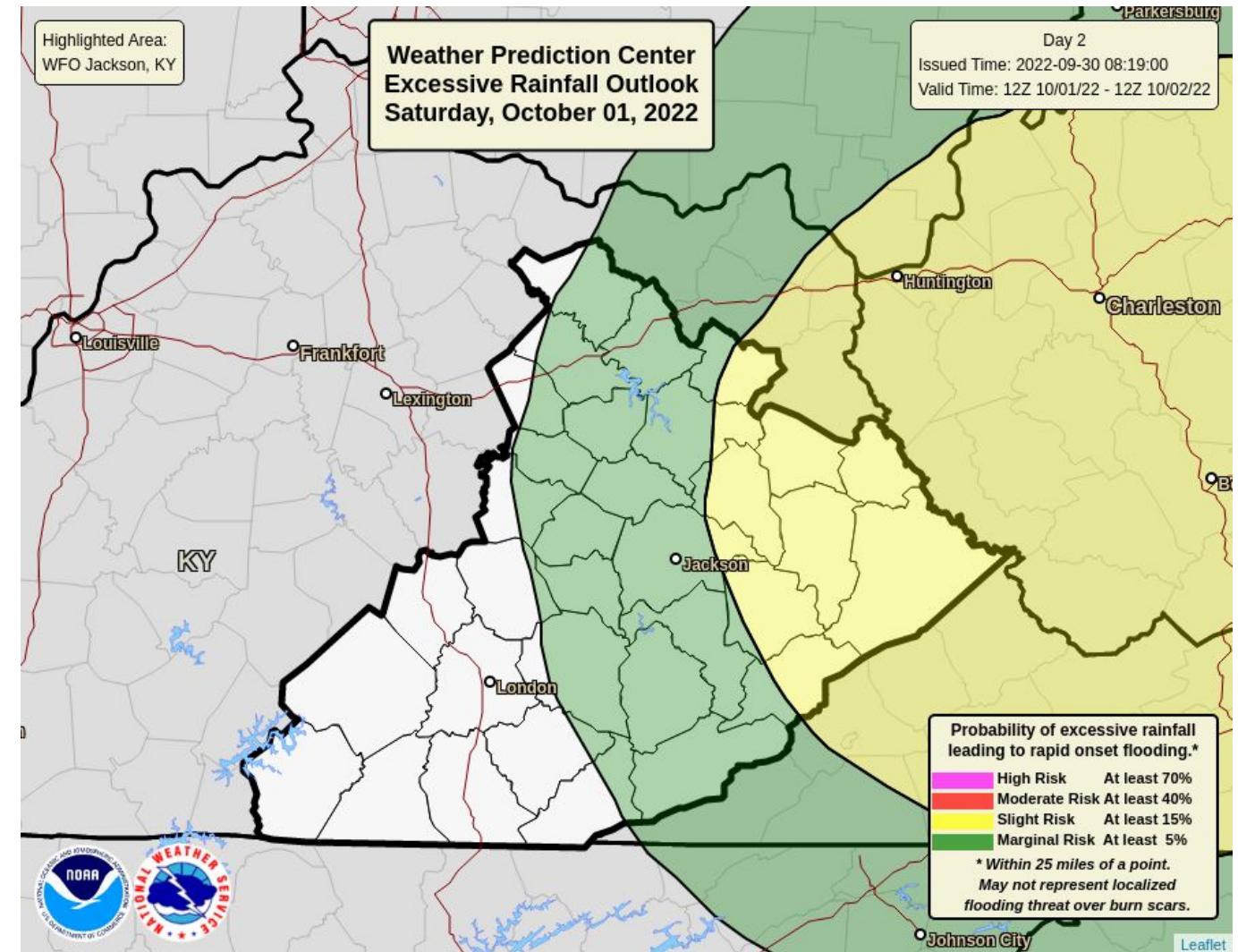

Periods of heavier rainfall rates may cause some high water concerns late tonight through Saturday, mostly for the far-east and southeast.



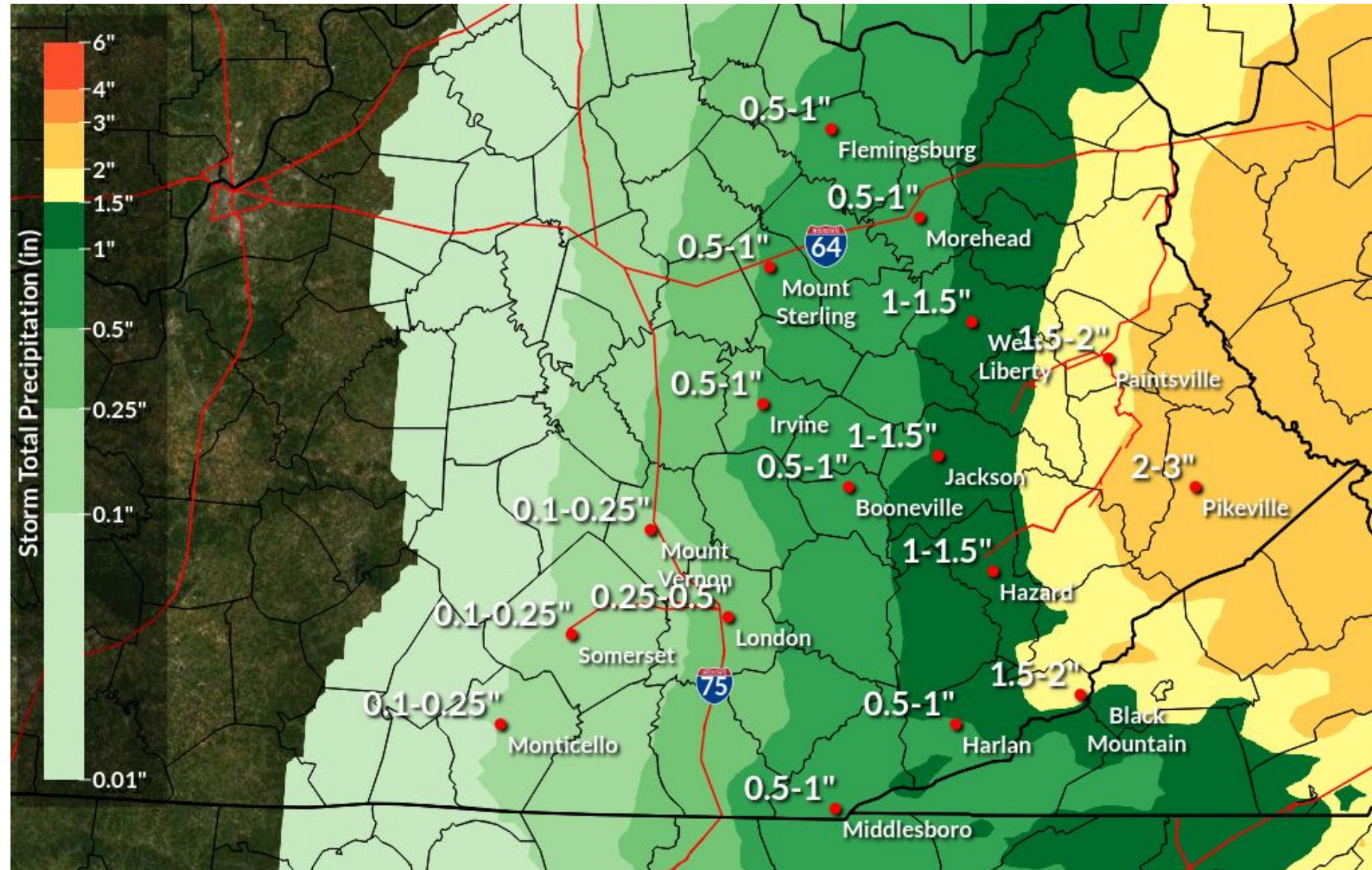
# Total Rainfall Forecast

## Overview

- Highest rainfall potential will be closer to the Virginia/West Virginia border over the 3-day span.
- Rainfall amounts decrease the further west you go.
- Rainfall totals have trended lower over the last day or so. Changes in rainfall amounts are possible, as there is still uncertainty on the exact storm track.



**Storm Total Rainfall from this Evening through Sunday Night**

(Higher amounts possible at locations that see repeated rainfall)
