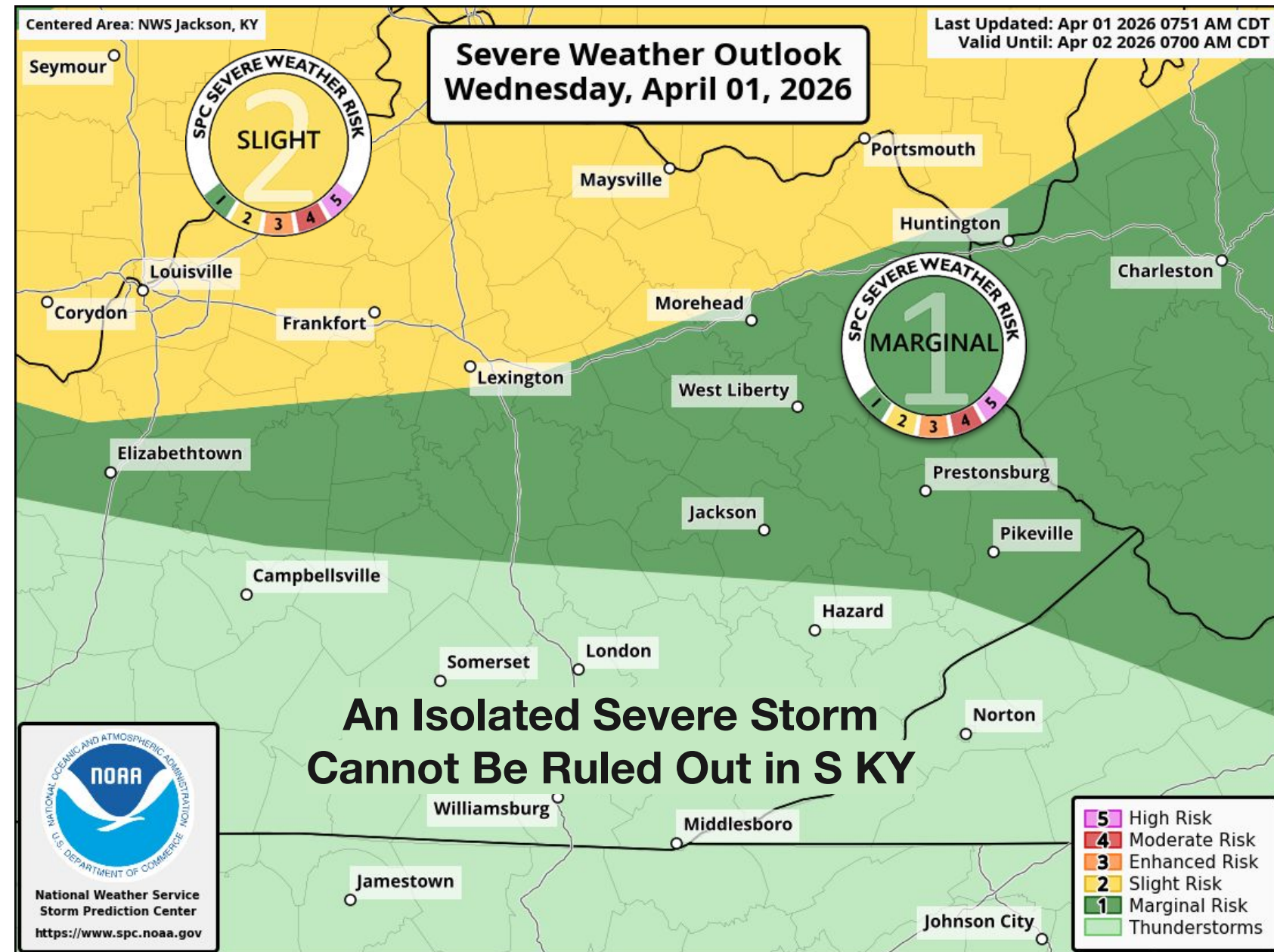

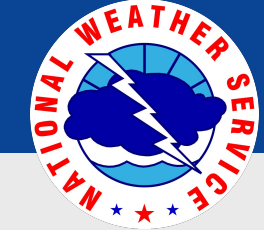
Multiple Rounds of Storms Expected This Afternoon and Evening

Key Messages

- Scattered showers and storms continue across Eastern Kentucky this morning, and additional storms should develop this afternoon.
 - Some of the afternoon storms could become marginally severe, posing a risk for hail and gusty winds.
- **NEW: There is now a Slight (2/5) Risk for locations north of Interstate 64.**
 - Confidence is increasing that organized clusters of storms may approach northern portions of the forecast area **this evening**.
 - These evening storms pose an increased risk for **damaging wind gusts**, although a spin-up tornado cannot be ruled out.

Severe Weather Hazard Probabilities

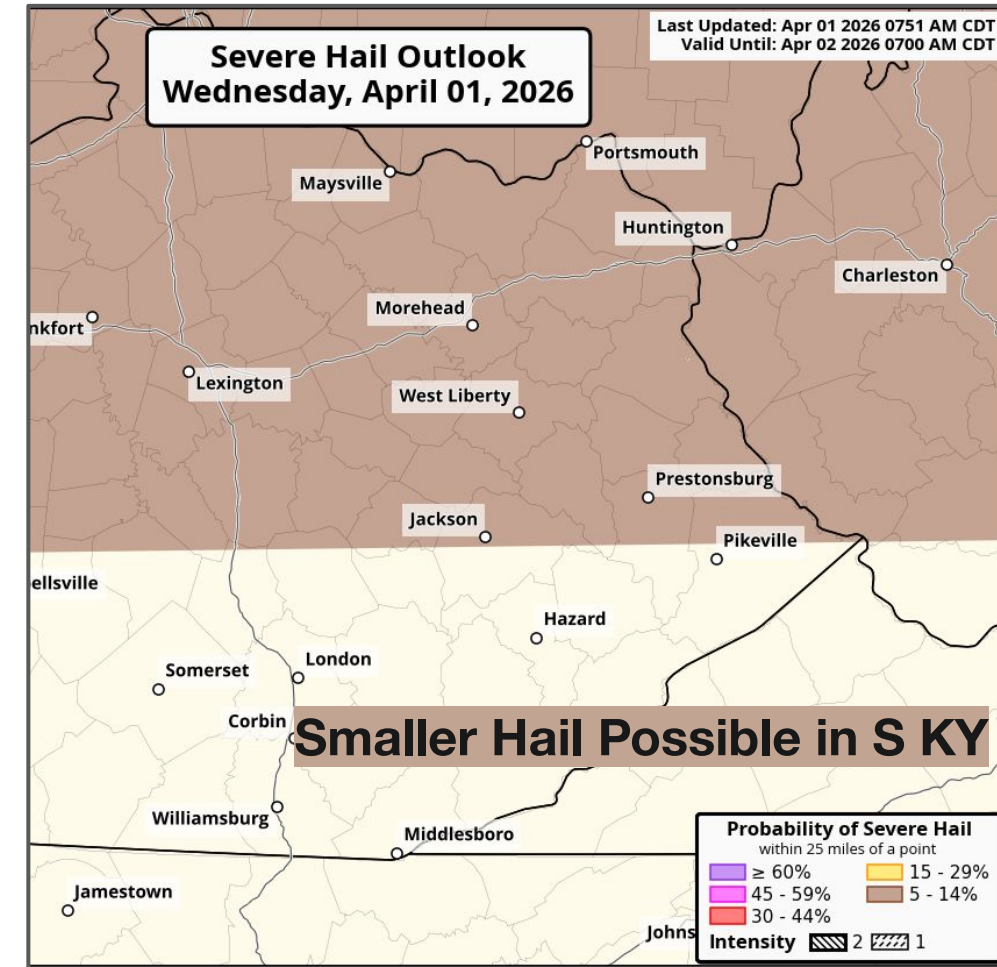
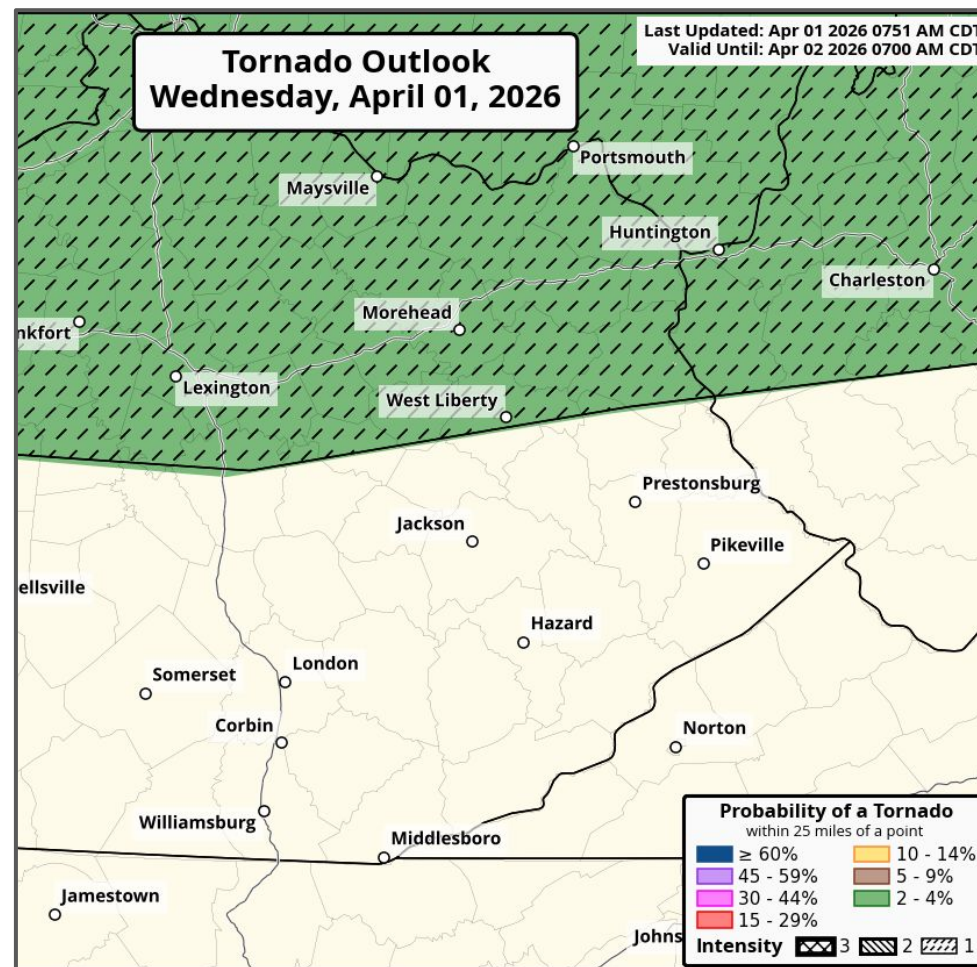
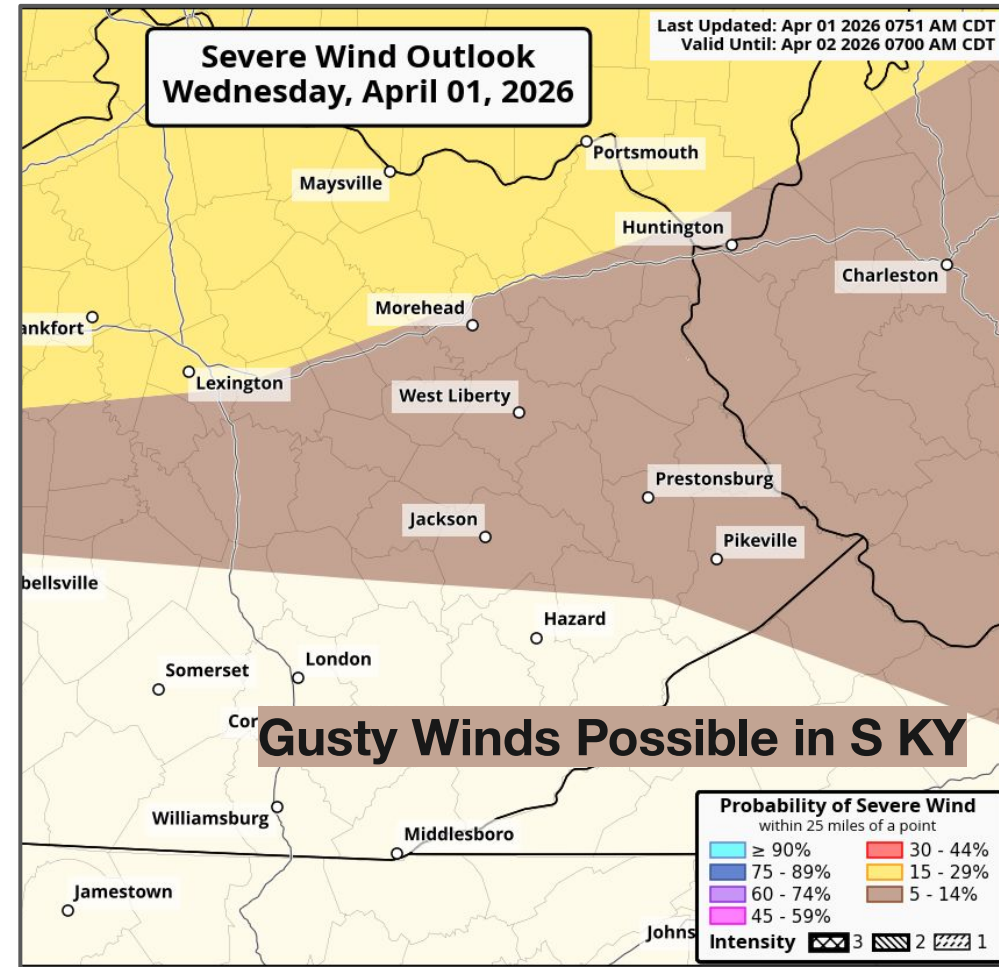

Key Messages:

- **Afternoon Storms (Area-Wide):** Damaging winds and large hail are possible.
- **Evening Storms (North of I-64):** Damaging winds are possible; an isolated/brief tornado can't be ruled out.
