2. Meet the Hurricane Hunters, Specialists from the National Hurricane Center, and Meteorologists from your Florida Keys National Weather Service;
3. Learn how the Hurricane Hunters support the National Weather Service mission to protect life and property.
4. Learn about storm preparedness and response from Monroe County Emergency Management and first responders who serve the Florida Keys during a tropical cyclone emergency.

The primary goal of the Hurricane Awareness Tour is to help the Florida Keys of Monroe County better prepare for tropical storms and hurricanes and help build a Weather-Ready Nation.
