
TOP STORY:









Rainfall in the Past Week












US Water Vapor Weather Satellite


An upper level trough over the central US has an embedded low pressure area.













US Infra-Red Weather Satellite


High pressure is over the northeastern US, with a low pressure and frontal system across the mid-south region of the US.












6 am Weather Observations


Skies were cloudy and temperatures ranged from 60 F at Alexandria to 68 F at Beaumont. Winds were from the south to southwest. Patchy drizzle was seen across the region.












2 pm Weather Observations


Under partly to mostly cloudy skies, temperatures ranged from 69 F at Abbeville to 81 F at Beaumont Municipal and Esler Field. Winds were southwest to west at 10 to 15 mph. Patchy drizzle was still seen in south central Louisiana.









