IN BAYFRONT COMMUNITIES BURNED FROM SALT SPRAY.

ASSUME SOUTH PADRE ISLAND WAS TOTALLY EVACUATED. ESTIMATES OF UP TO 50,000 (FIFTY THOUSAND) PERSONS IN SHELTERS OVER AREA...MAINLY IN CAMERON /HIDALGO COUNTIES. INCLUDED MEXICAN NATIONALS FROM ACROSS THE BORDER. IN THE BROWNSVILLE CIVIC CENTER CROWDING WAS SEVERE WITH AN ESTIMATED 4 SQUARE FEET OF SPACE PER PERSON IN SHELTER.

NO DOLLAR ESTIMATE AVAILABLE YET FOR DAMAGE. GOVERNOR IS TOURNING CAMERON COUNTY THIS AFTERNOON AND MOST LOCAL OFFICIALS ARE WITH HIM.

OVERALL PUBLIC AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN DEEP SOUTH TEXAS APPEARED TO HAVE MAXIMIZED SAFETY ACTIONS AND SUFFERRED MINIMAL DAMAGE FROM HURRICANE GILBERT.

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
