5. FLOODING IN CWA:

FLASH FLOODING/PONDING OCCURRED ACROSS THE SOUTHERN PARTS OF OUR COUNTY WARNING AREA FROM 110 AM CDT TO 615 AM CDT IN HARDIN COUNTY, FROM 240 AM CDT TO 0745 AM CDT IN JEFFERSON COUNTY, FROM 5 AM CDT TO 9 AM CDT IN SOUTHERN JASPER AND NEWTON COUNTIES, AND FROM 550 AM CDT TO 945 AM CDT FOR ORANGE COUNTY ALL ON JUNE 27, 1989. ADDITIONAL FLOODING HAS OCCURRED SINCE THEN AS THE REMNANTS OF ALLISON ARE LINGERING ACROSS OUR CWA.

6. STORM RELATED FATALITIES AND PROPERTY DAMAGE:

TWO TEENAGE BOYS WERE DROWNED IN BEAUMONT ON TUESDAY AFTERNOON JUNE 27, 1989 AFTER THEIR RUBBER RAFT CAPSIZED AND WAS SWEPT DOWN A DRAINAGE PIPE BY FLOOD RUNOFF.

PROPERTY DAMAGE ESTIMATES FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY TOTALED 2.6 MILLION DOLLARS WITH THE WORST FLOODING IN TEN YEARS. COLE
