THREE MINOR INJURIES IN COLLIER, NONE IN BROWARD, HENDRY, GLADES, NO NUMBER AVAILABLE FROM DADE COUNTY, BUT PROBABLY HUNDREDS. DAMAGE ESTIMATES BETWEEN 13 TO 20 BILLION DOLLARS MOSTLY IN DADE COUNTY. DAMAGES IN BROWARD COUNTY LESS THAN 100 MILLION DOLLARS, 8 MILLION DOLLARS IN COLLIER COUNTY, AND NEGLIGIBLE IN HENDRY AND GLADES COUNTIES.

ESTIMATED 900,000 PEOPLE EVACUATED IN SOUTH FLORIDA. MORE SPECIFIC COUNTY BY COUNTY NUMBERS LATER. 25,000 IN SHELTERS BROWARD COUNTY, 3100 IN COLLIER, 450 IN GLADES, HENDRY AND DADE N/A AT PRESENT.

REMARKS...ESTIMATED 63,000 HOMES DESTROYED IN SOUTH DADE COUNTY WITH 175,000 TO 250,000 ESTIMATED HOMELESS. RADAR ON ROOF OF BUILDING DESTROYED ALONG WITH SEVERAL OTHER PIECES OF EQUIPMENT. WIND AND PRESSURE TRACE FROM WSFO/NHC WILL BE AVAILABLE.
