



Day 2 (Thursday) Outlook







- Slight risk for severe thunderstorms for areas roughly north of Highway 190
- Marginal risk for severe thunderstorms elsewhere.

Timing:

- Estimated start time Early Thursday Morning
- Peak Time Late Thursday Morning
- End Time Late Thursday Afternoon











- Overall the risk for tornadoes is low
- 2 4% almost all areas






- Damaging wind gusts is the primary risk.
- 15 29% roughly north of Highway 190
- 5 14% elsewhere






- Large hail risk is low.
- 5 14% for most areas.
- 0 5% elsewhere

























STORM TOTAL PRECIPITATION FORECAST





- Flood risk remains very low.
- Rainfall forecast 0.10 to 1.00 inch.


STORM TOTAL PRECIPITATION FORECAST





Key Message:

- Rain ends Thursday Thursday evening
- Chilly temperatures Friday and Saturday
- Warming trend Sunday into early next week
- Another strong system possible next Tuesday or Wednesday.
