
Severe storms possible tonight with large hail. The active weather pattern continues through next week.

Rainfall in the Past Week




Several rounds of rain have dropped 1.5 to 2 inches of rain across the area.



River Forecasts




Minor flooding is forecast on the Calcasieu River near Glenmora and Oberlin. Portions of the Calcasieu river are near flooding.



Upper Level Steering Patterns




Upper level low pressure centers will migrate east in the coming days.

weather to the region.




6 am Weather Observations



Light southeast winds and mostly cloudy skies were seen this morning. A Dense Fog Advisory was in effect.


Temperatures were in the upper 40s to low 50s and winds were out of the southeast at 5 to 10 mph.






