A few showers and thunderstorms will be possible as we head into the weekend, with a Marginal Risk for severe weather in place tomorrow for all of south LA. Otherwise, hot and dry conditions continue.



Parts of SE TX saw 1-2 inches of rain this past weekend, due to a nearby frontal system.


Elsewhere, less than an inch of rain fell in the last week.



#### River Forecasts




Tides are somewhat elevated along parts of the coastline, due to persistent onshore flow. A couple points along the Calcasieu River also remain near flood, but flooding is not anticipated.



## Upper Level Steering Patterns




A trough of low pressure is over the western half of the country, while an elongated ridge is located across the MS River Valley. A cut off low is also located off the southeastern coastline.



## Surface Weather Map with Fronts




A frontal system is located over the eastern Rockies/northern Plains.
Closer to home, high pressure continue to linger nearby.



#### 6 am Weather Observations




Skies were mostly clear this morning, expect for a couple of spots that saw some patchy fog. Temperatures were in the mid 60s to low 70s and winds were calm.



#### 2 pm Weather Observations




Partly cloudy skies and light and variable winds are ongoing across the region, due to nearby surface high pressure. Temperatures are in the upper 80s to low 90s.

## Weekly Weather Summary



- A Marginal Risk (I of 5) for severe weather is in place tomorrow for all of south LA, mainly due to the possibility of damaging winds and small hail.
- A few isolated sub-severe showers and thunderstorms will be possible on Saturday afternoon as well.
- Otherwise, hot and dry conditions continue, with above average temperatures expected each day through the end of the forecast period.
