Weekly Weather Update




TOP STORY:





Upper Level Steering Patterns




Dry northwest flow is set up for the next couple of days.



Surface Weather Map with Fronts






6 am Weather Observations




Under partly to mostly cloudy skies, temperatures were in the upper 50s to mid 60s.

2 pm Weather Observations




Under partly to mostly sunny skies, temperatures were in the 70s. Winds were out of the north to northeast at 10 to 15 mph.
