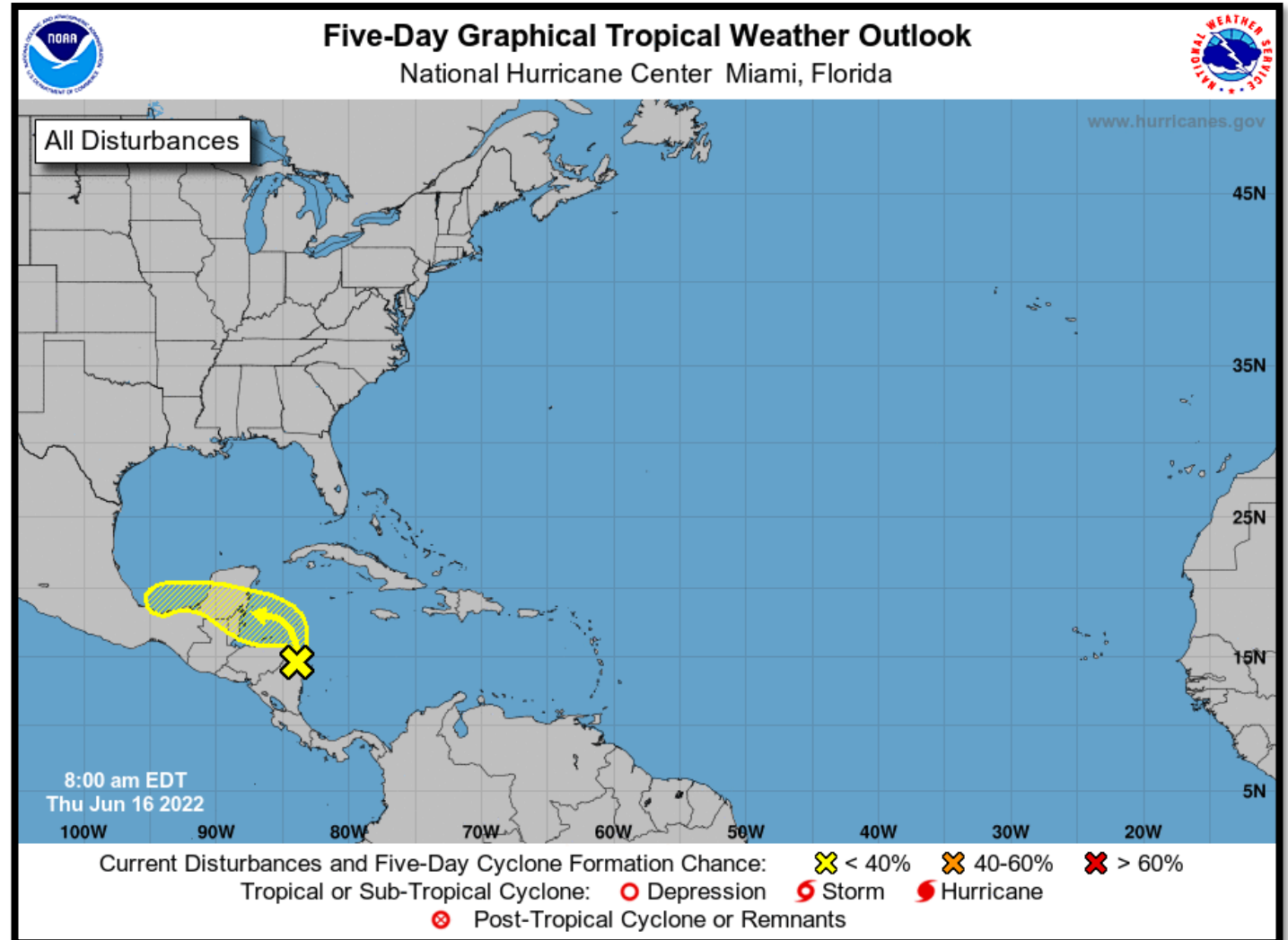

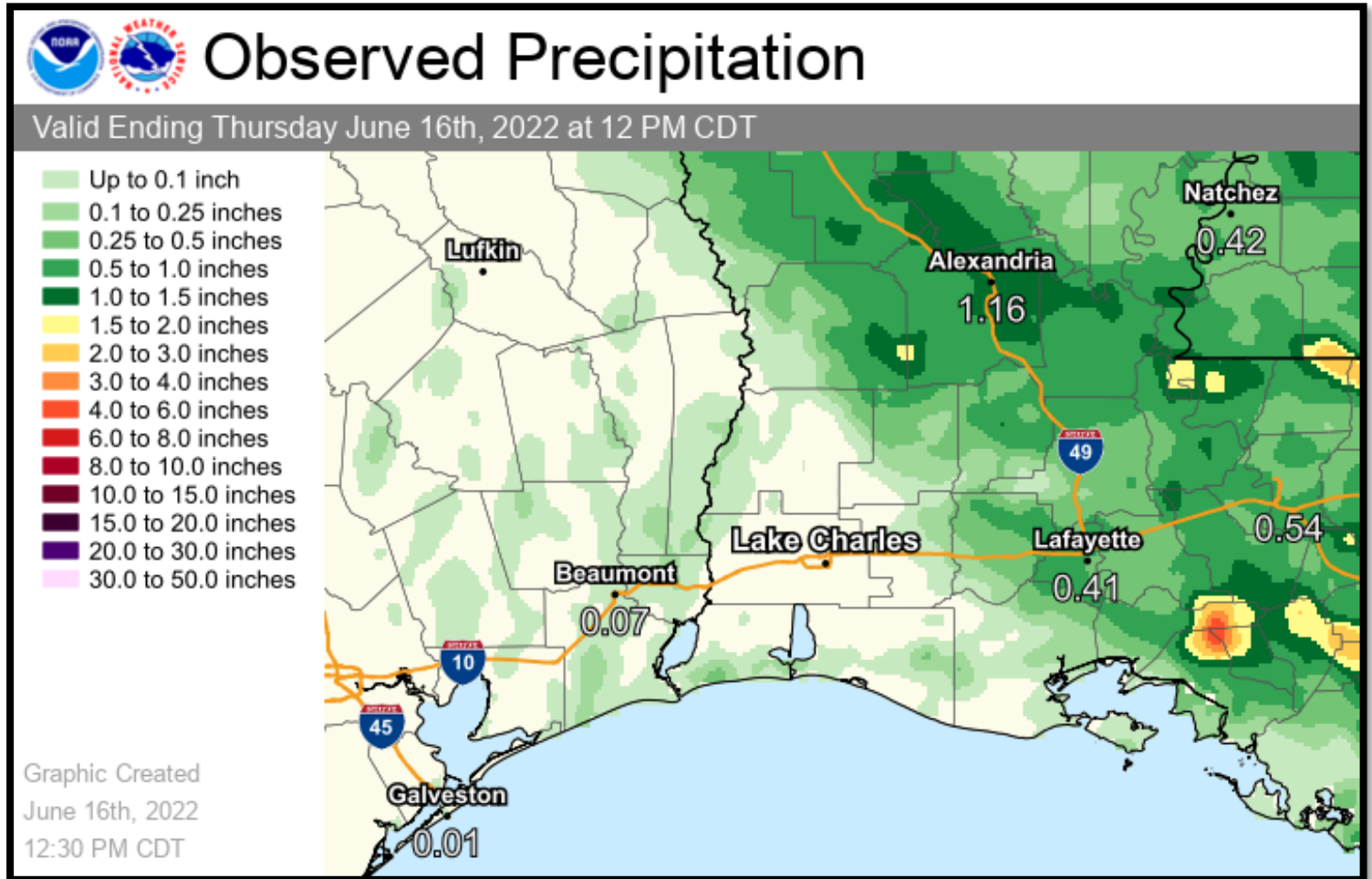
Abnormally hot weather to continue. A few showers or storms could bring relief over the next day or two.

Most of the rainfall occurred over the eastern half of the area where general amounts were between one quarter and one inch.

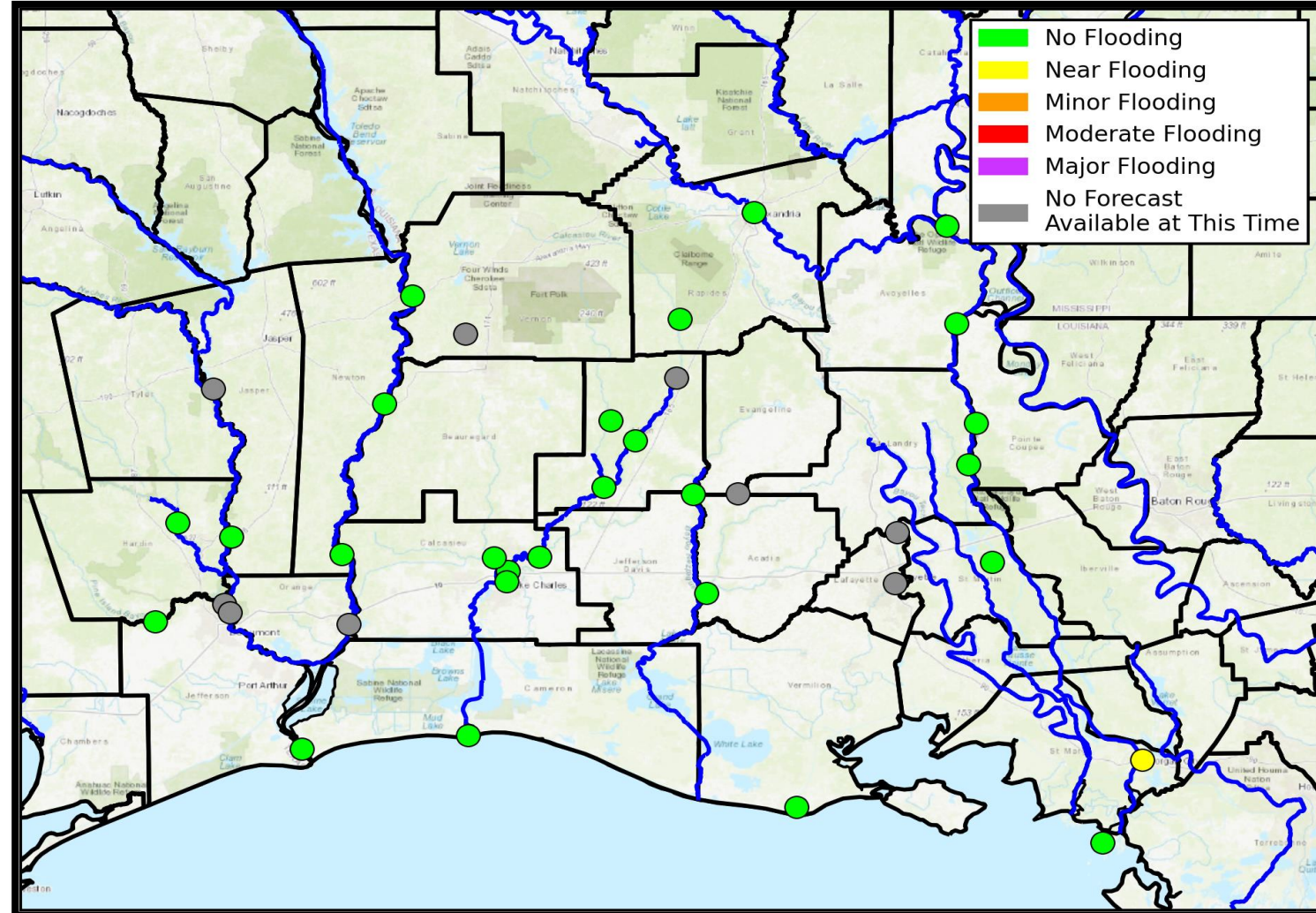

No flooding on area rivers at this time.

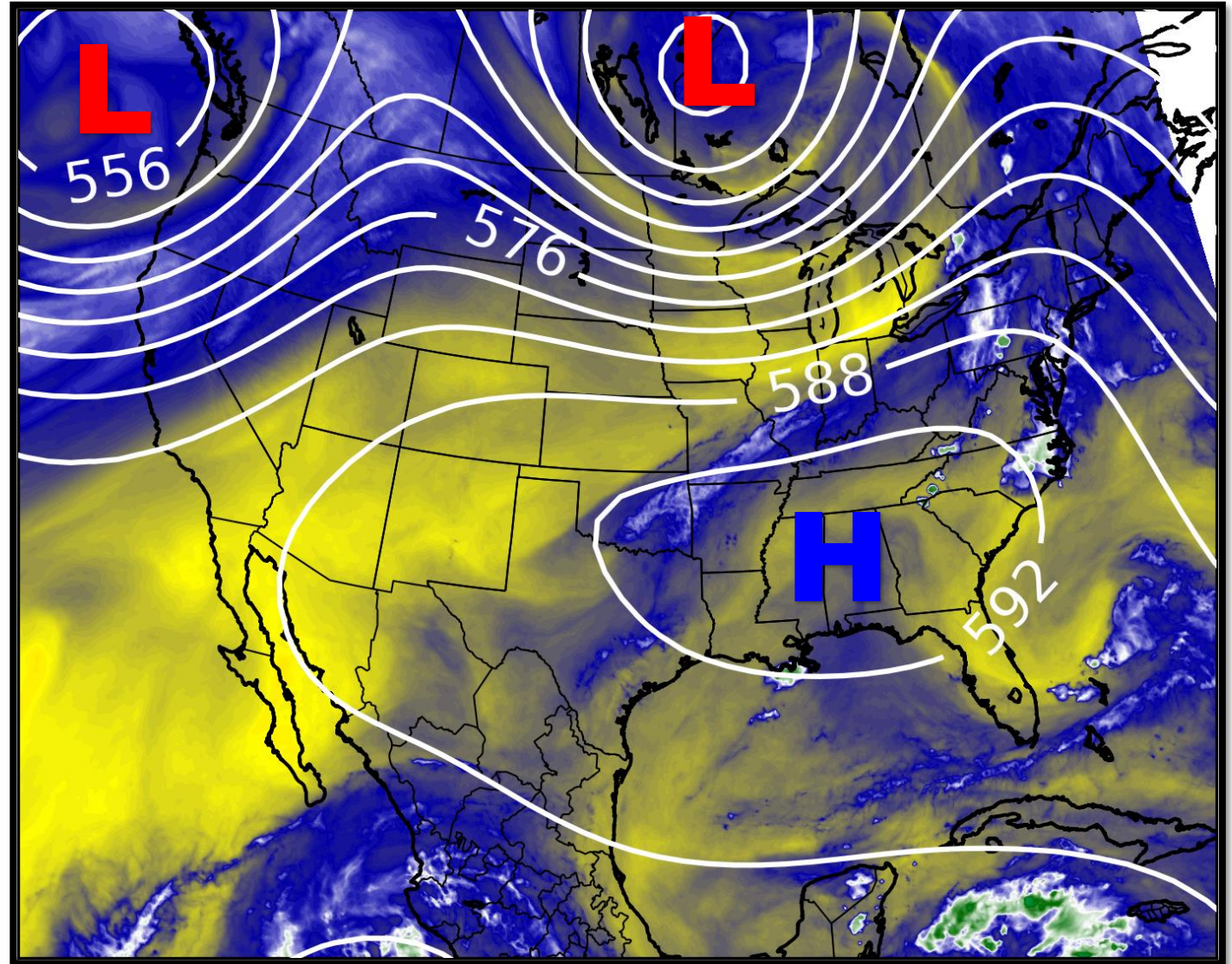


Upper Level Steering Patterns



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A broad area of high pressure aloft was located over the southeastern US.

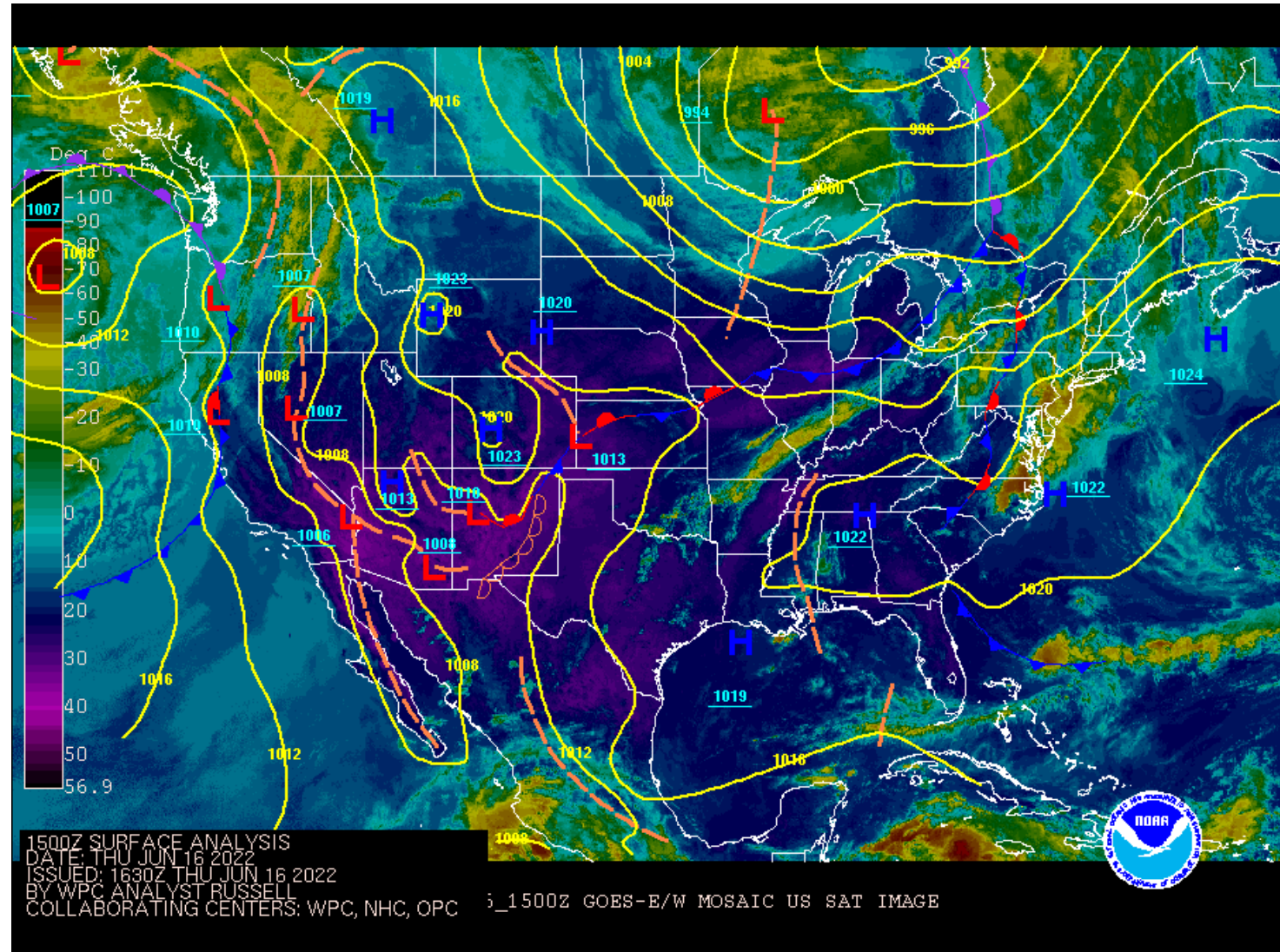


Surface Weather Map with Fronts



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Surface high pressure extends across the southeastern US with a weak disturbance moving west across Mississippi.

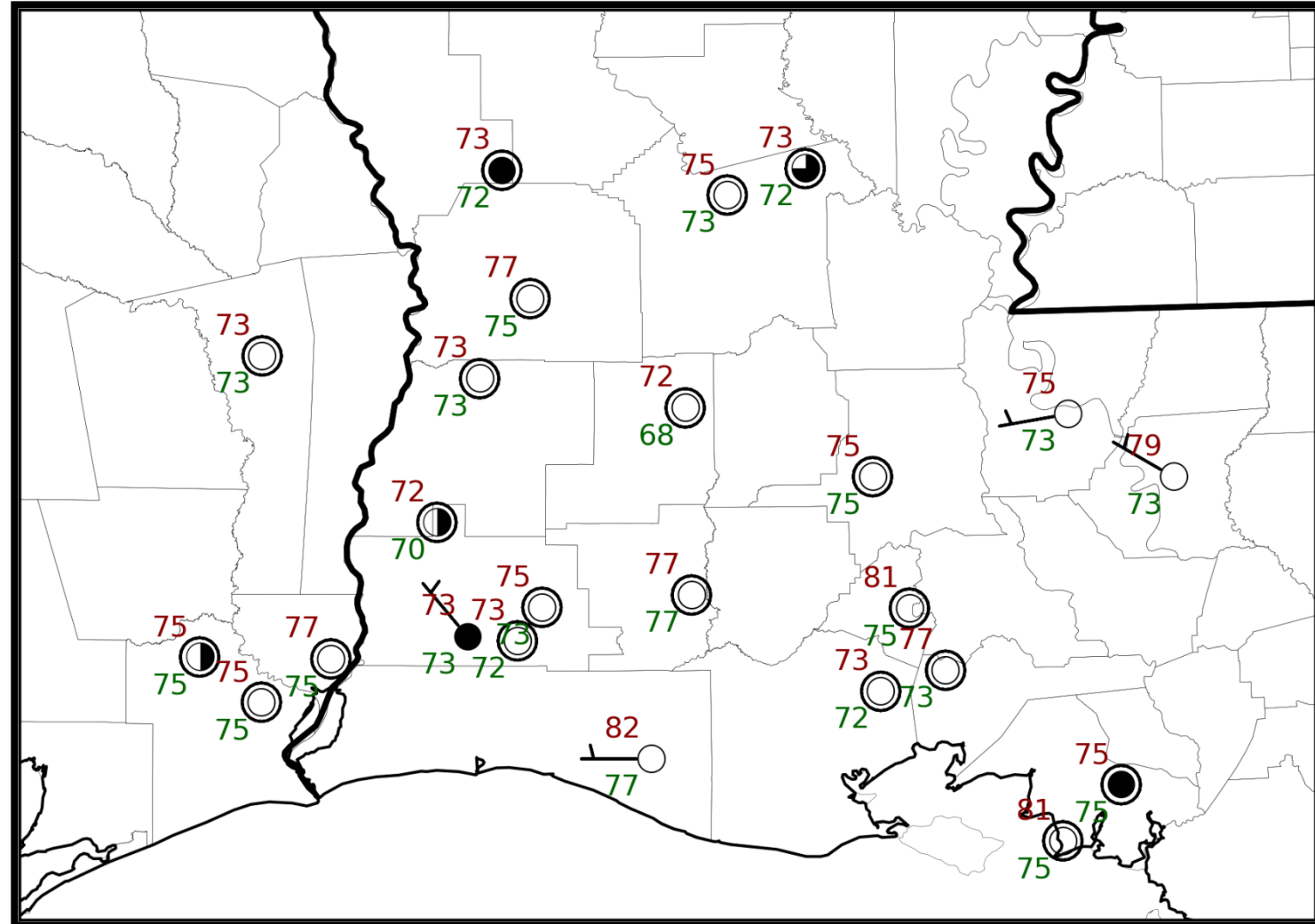


6 am Weather Observations



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Warm and muggy conditions were seen across the area this morning.

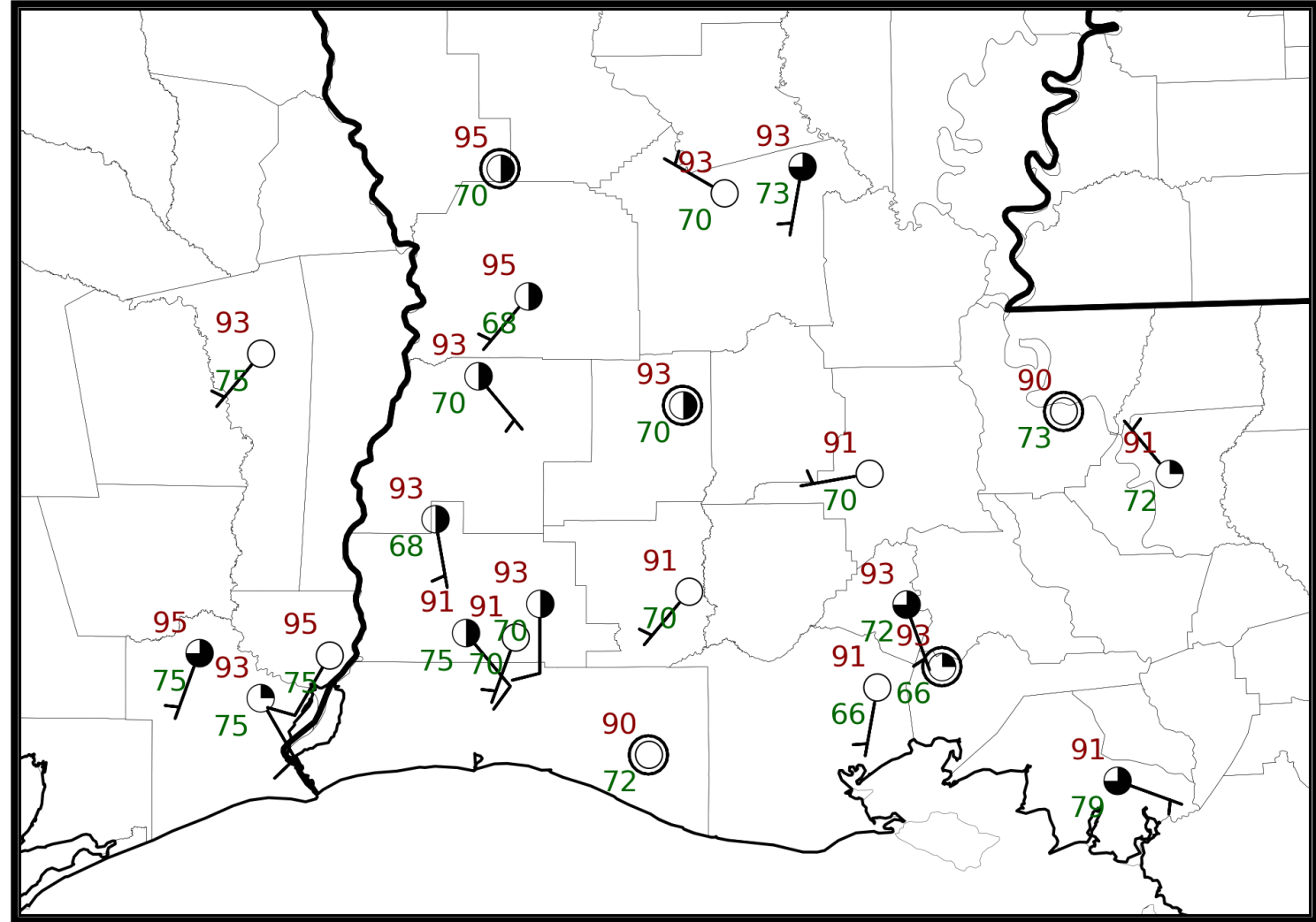


2 pm Weather Observations



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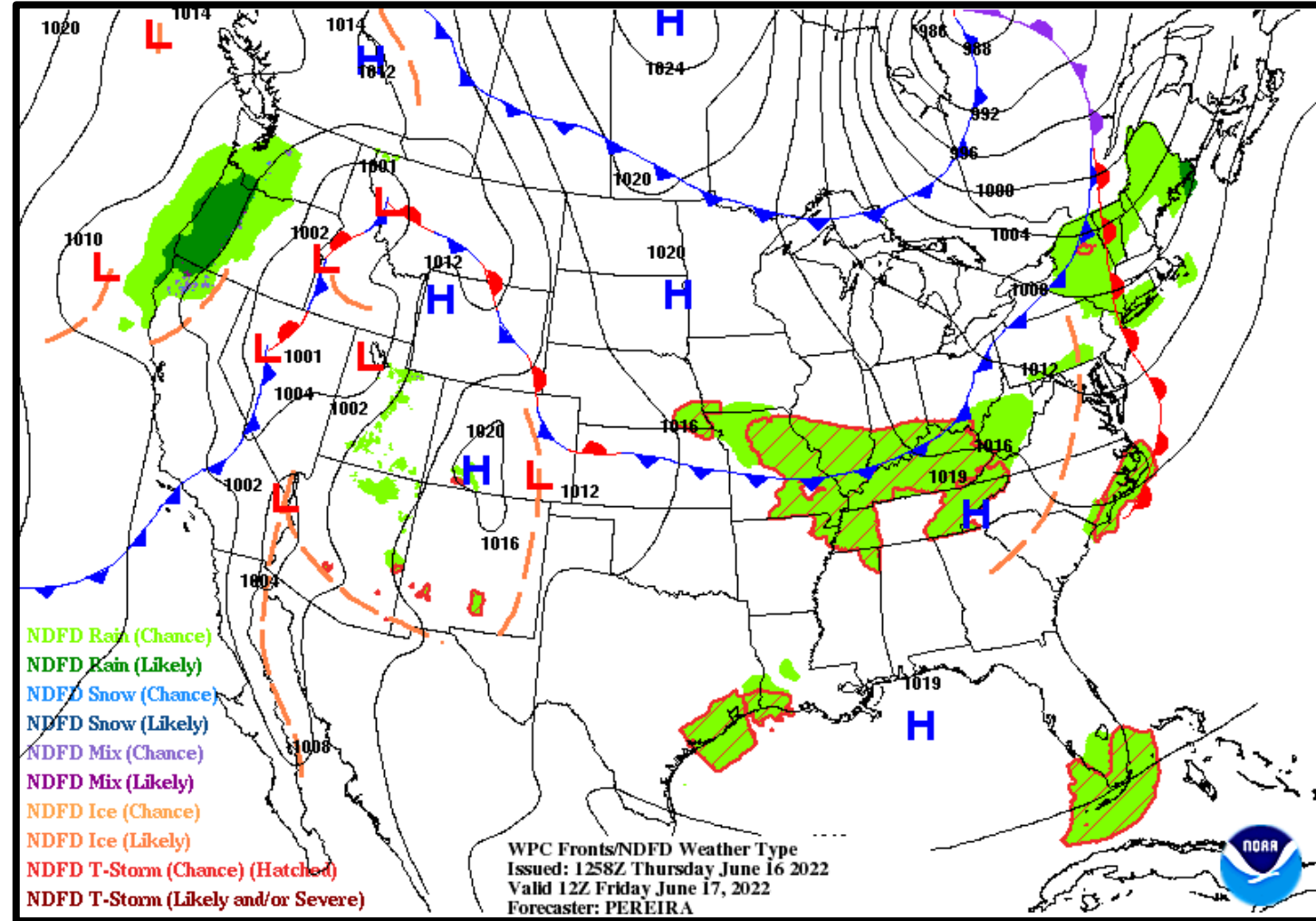
Temperatures have warmed into the 90s across the area today.
