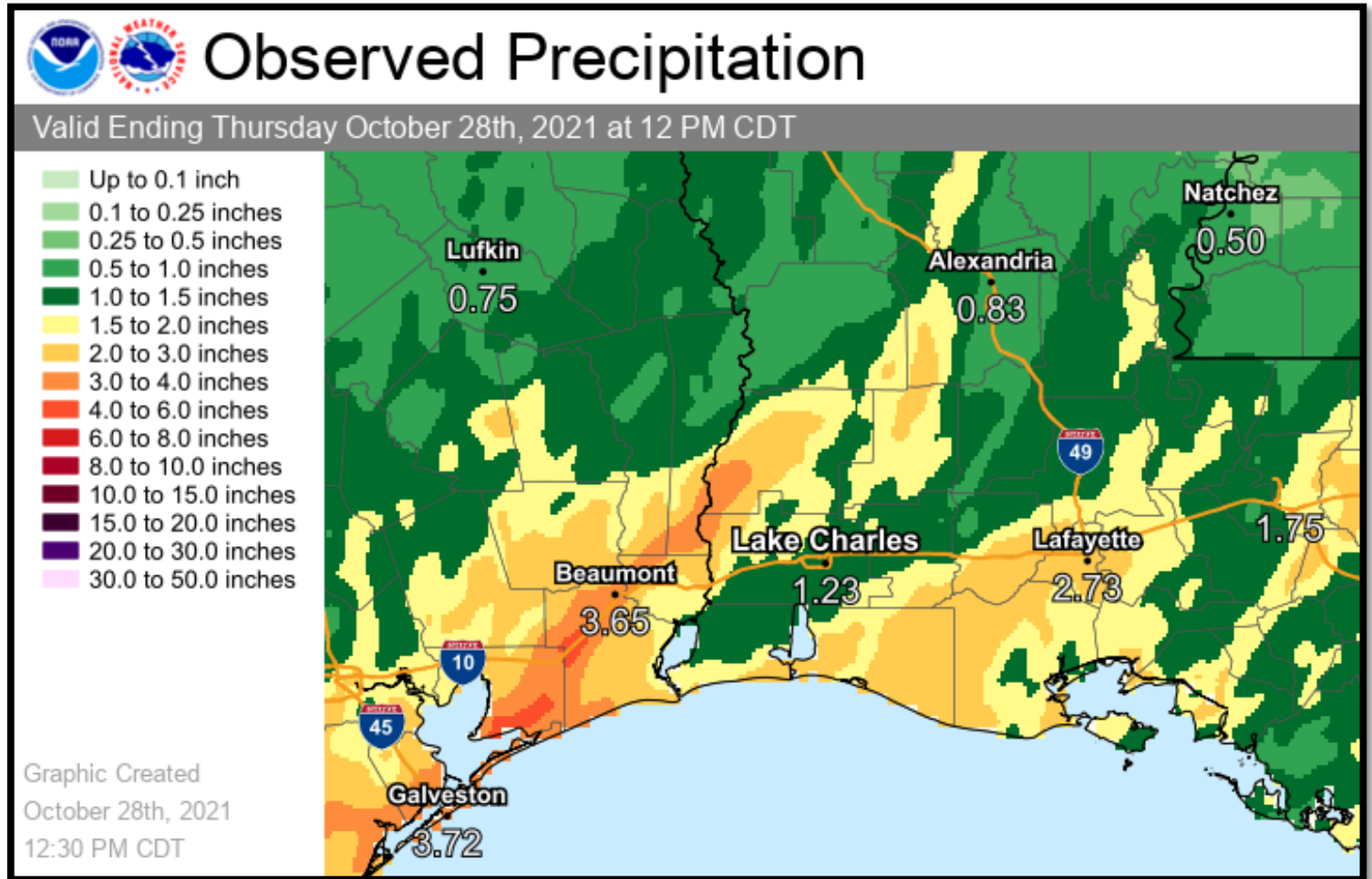


TOP STORY:

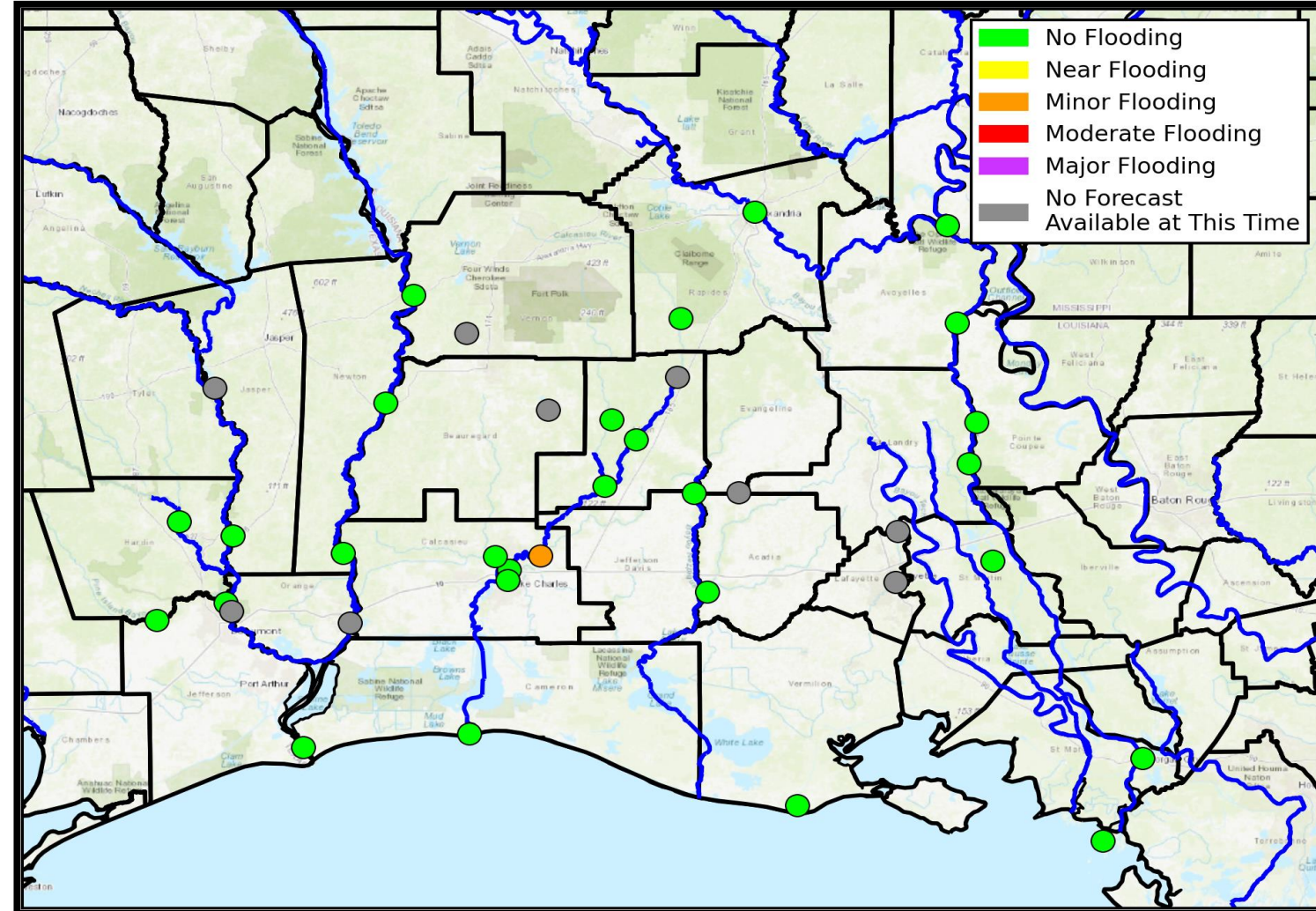
Cooler and drier weather can be expected through the next several days. Dry weather will continue well into next week with our next chance of rain not expected until Wednesday.

The Calcasieu River near White Oak Park is the only river in flood this week.

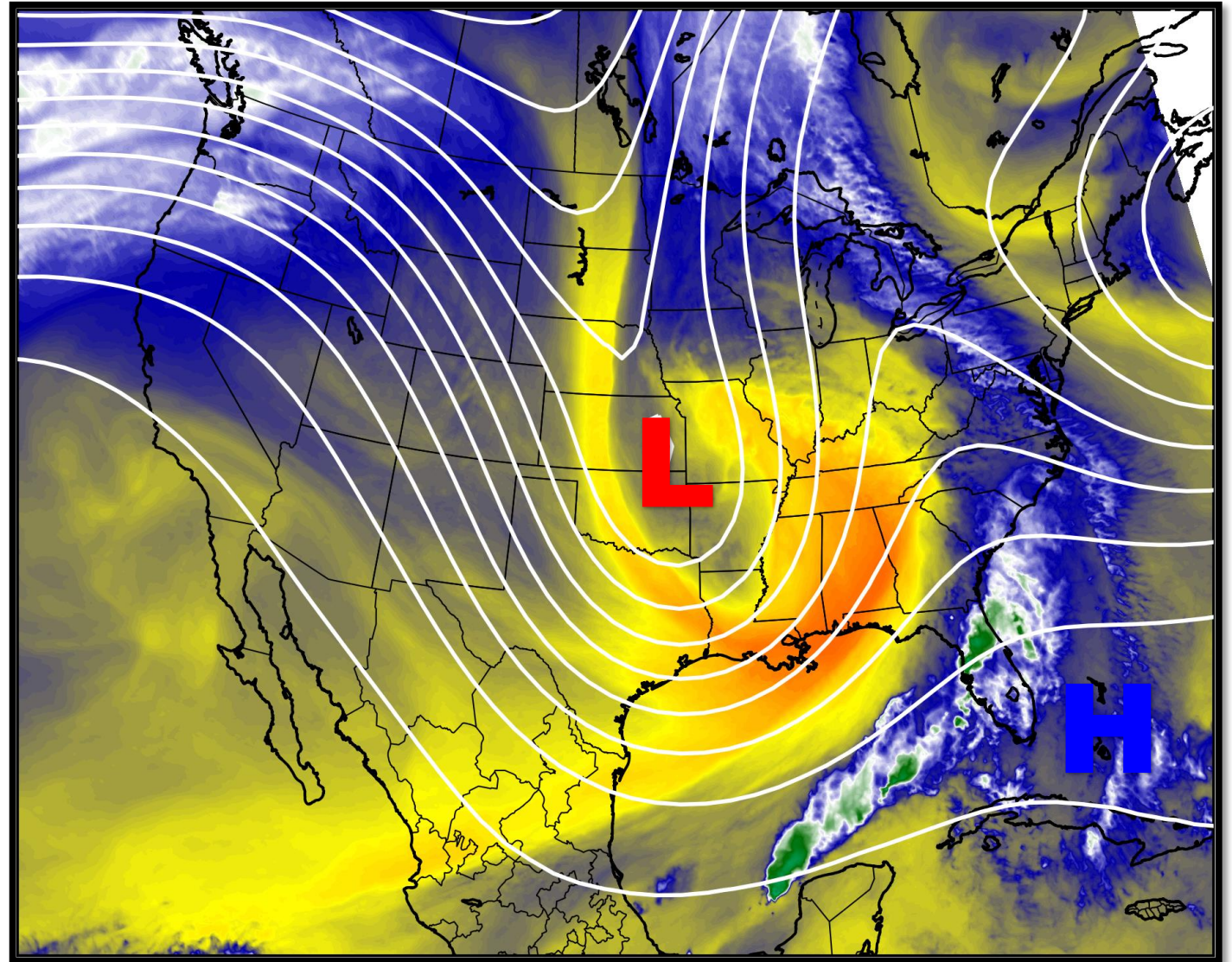


Upper Level Steering Patterns

A deep trough of low pressure is situated over the center of the country, which is the source of today's drier and cooler weather.

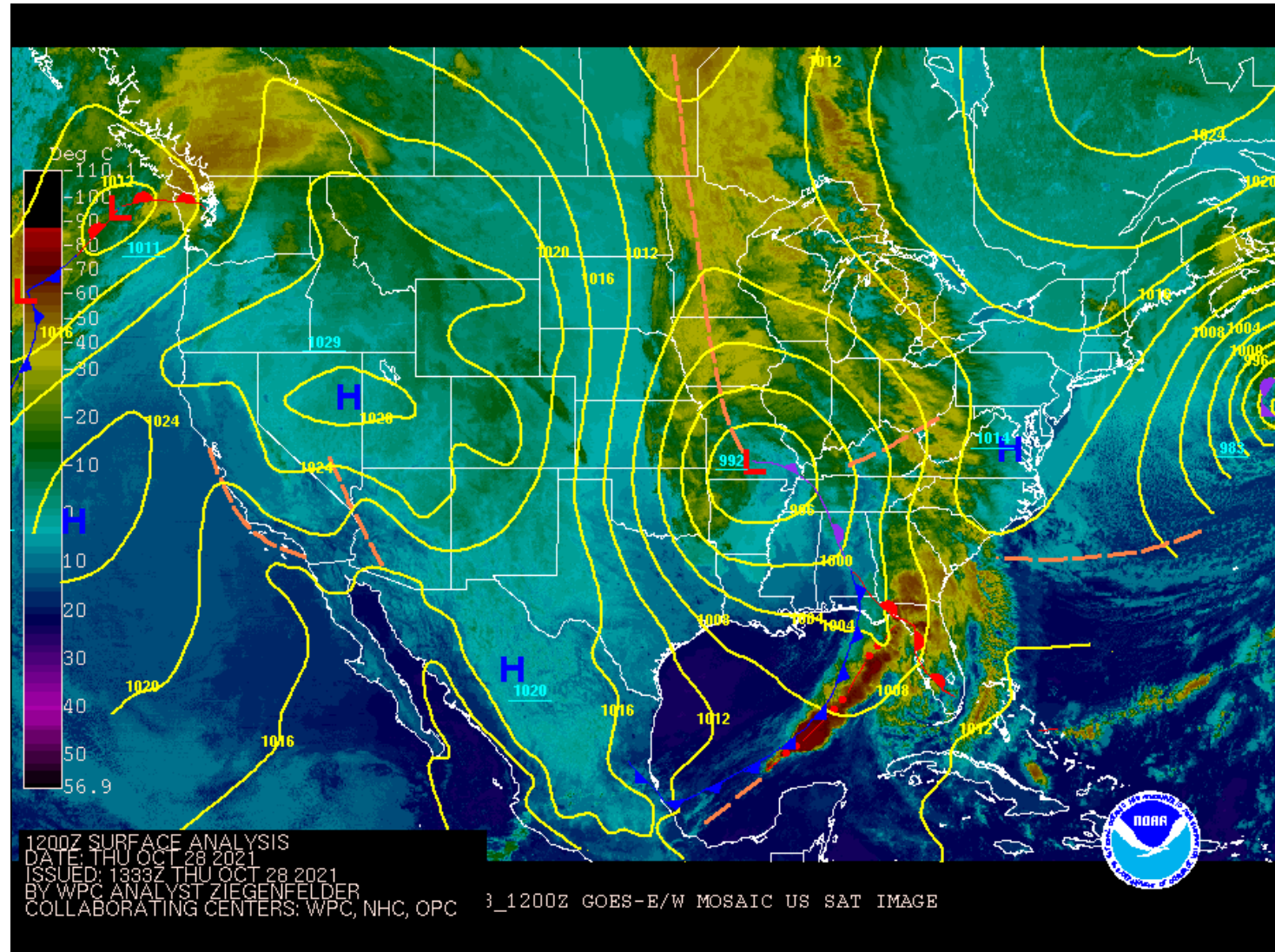


Surface Weather Map with Fronts

Low pressure is located over southern MO, with yesterday's cold front seen to our east crossing the FL Panhandle. High pressure is back to our west over the Rockies.

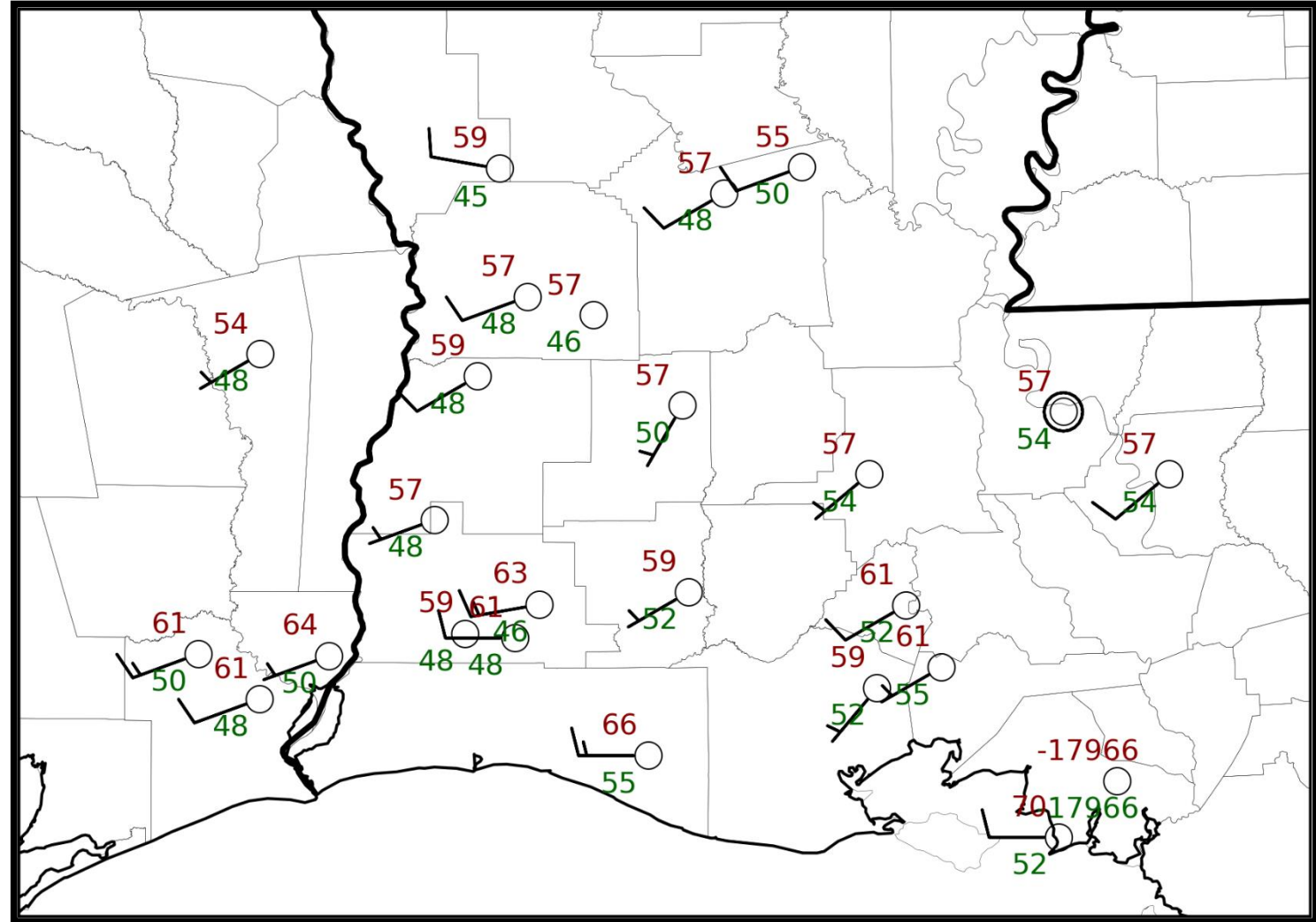


6 am Weather Observations

Early this morning, skies were clear and temperatures were in the mid 50s to mid 60s.

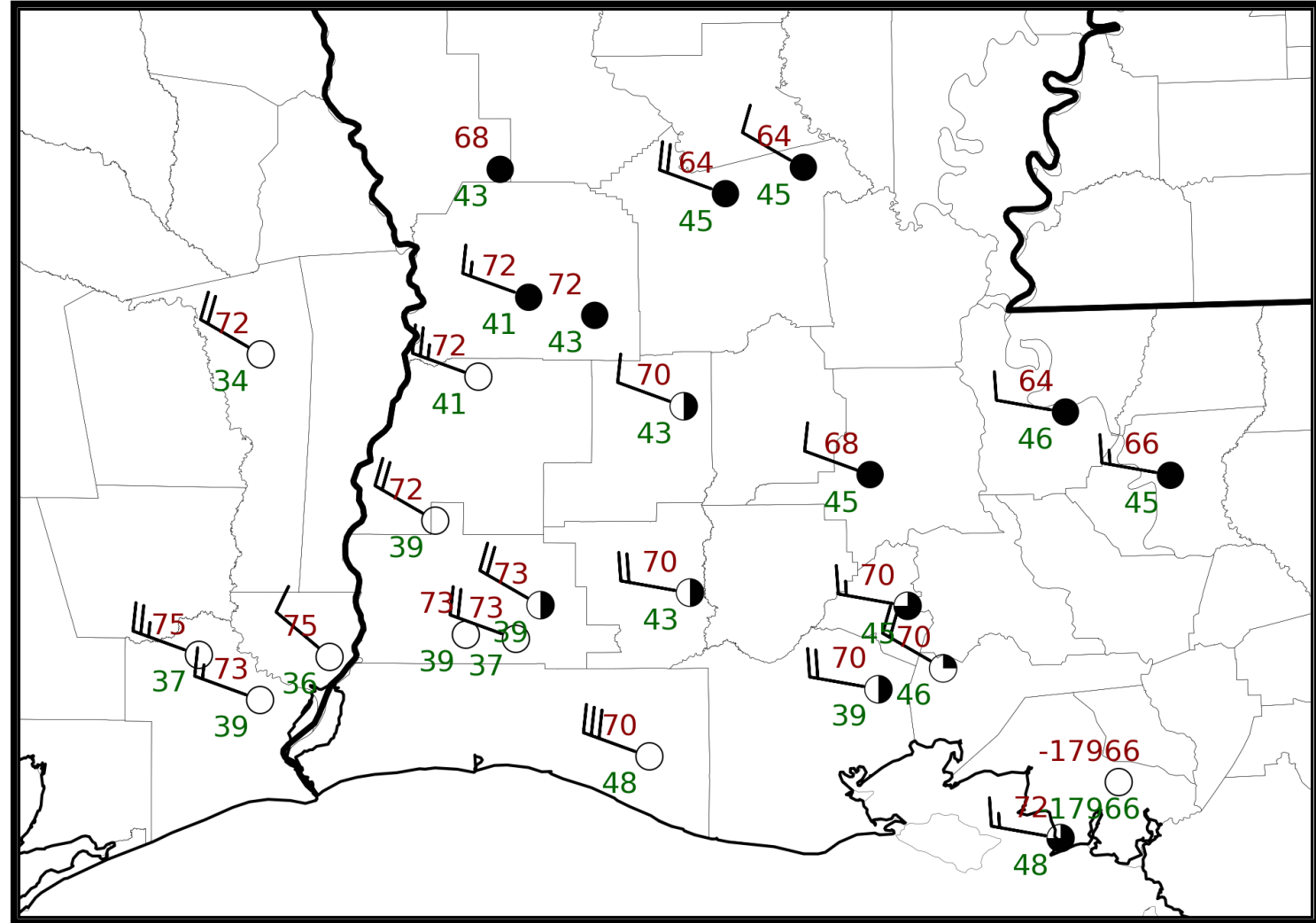


2 pm Weather Observations

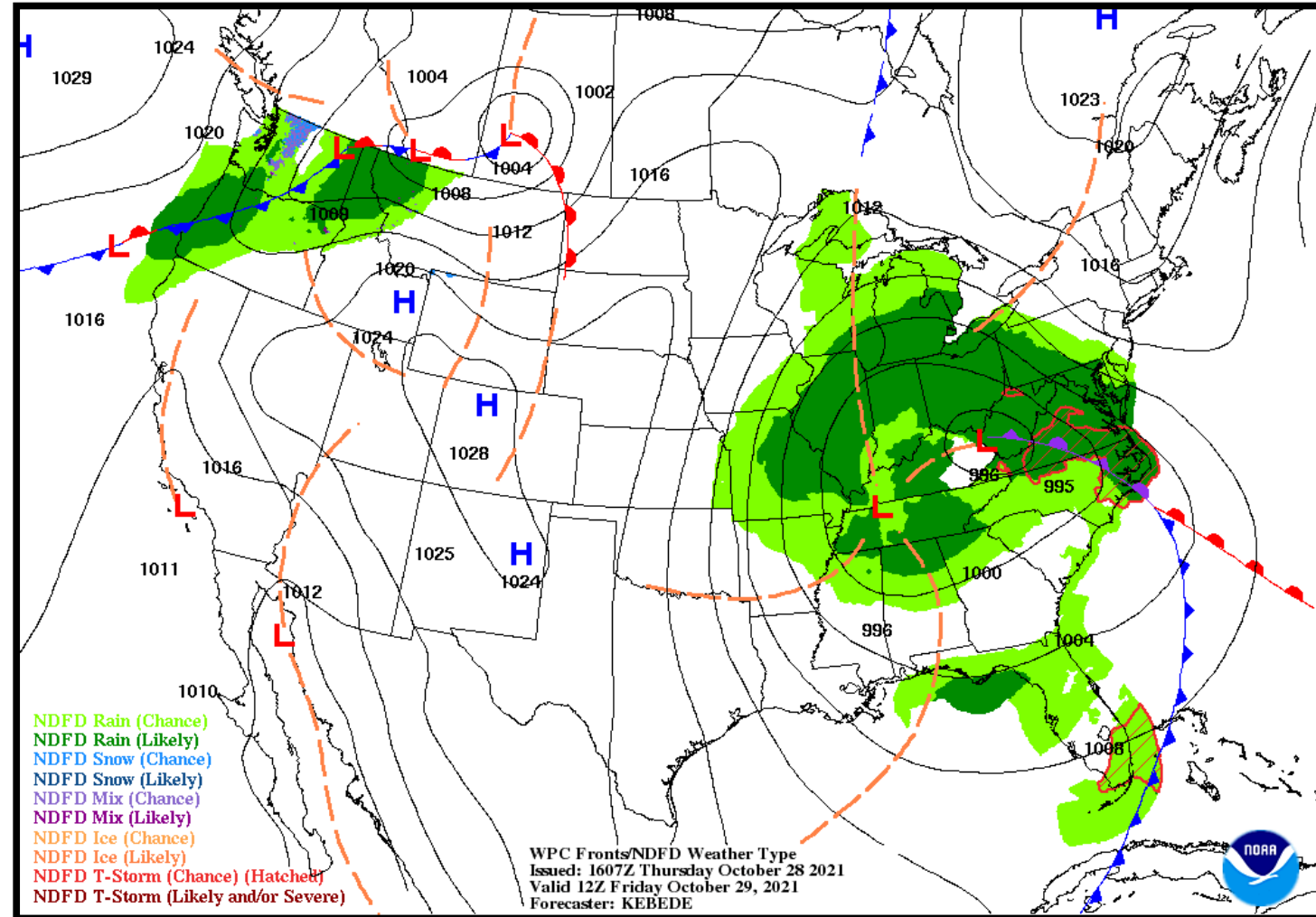
Skies are partly to mostly cloudy over the northeastern parts of the region and mostly sunny across the southwestern areas. Temps are in the low to mid 70s.

- Pleasant fall weather will continue through the weekend, with highs in the upper 60s to low 70s.
- Temperatures will begin to moderate back into the mid to upper 70s early next week, before cooling down again late next week with the passage of our next cold front.
- This front will bring us our next chance of rain around Wed-Thurs next week, with no severe weather expected at this time.
