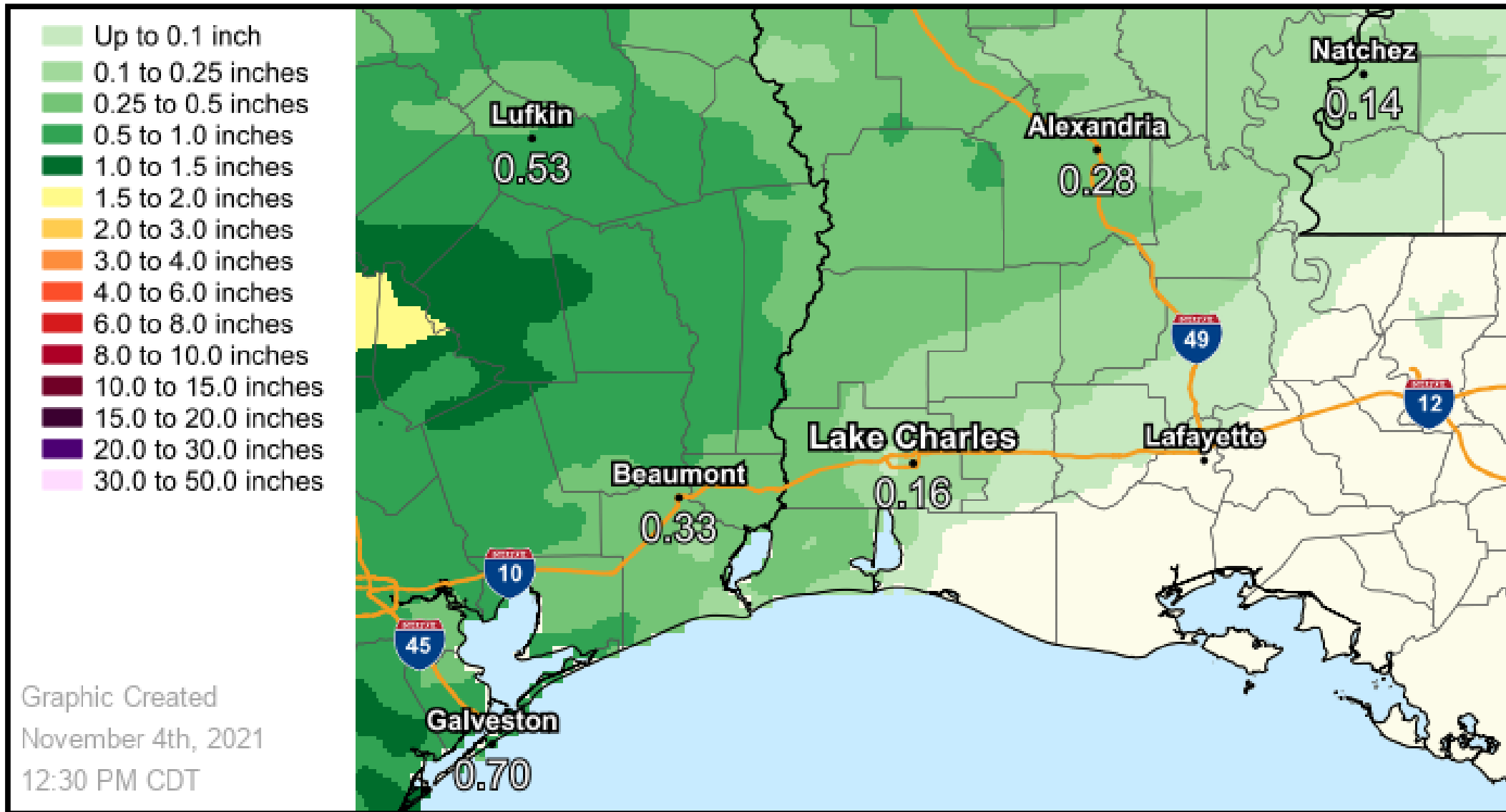
Cool and dry weather continues through the weekend into next week. The next chance for rain will be towards the end of next week.

Rainfall in the Past Week



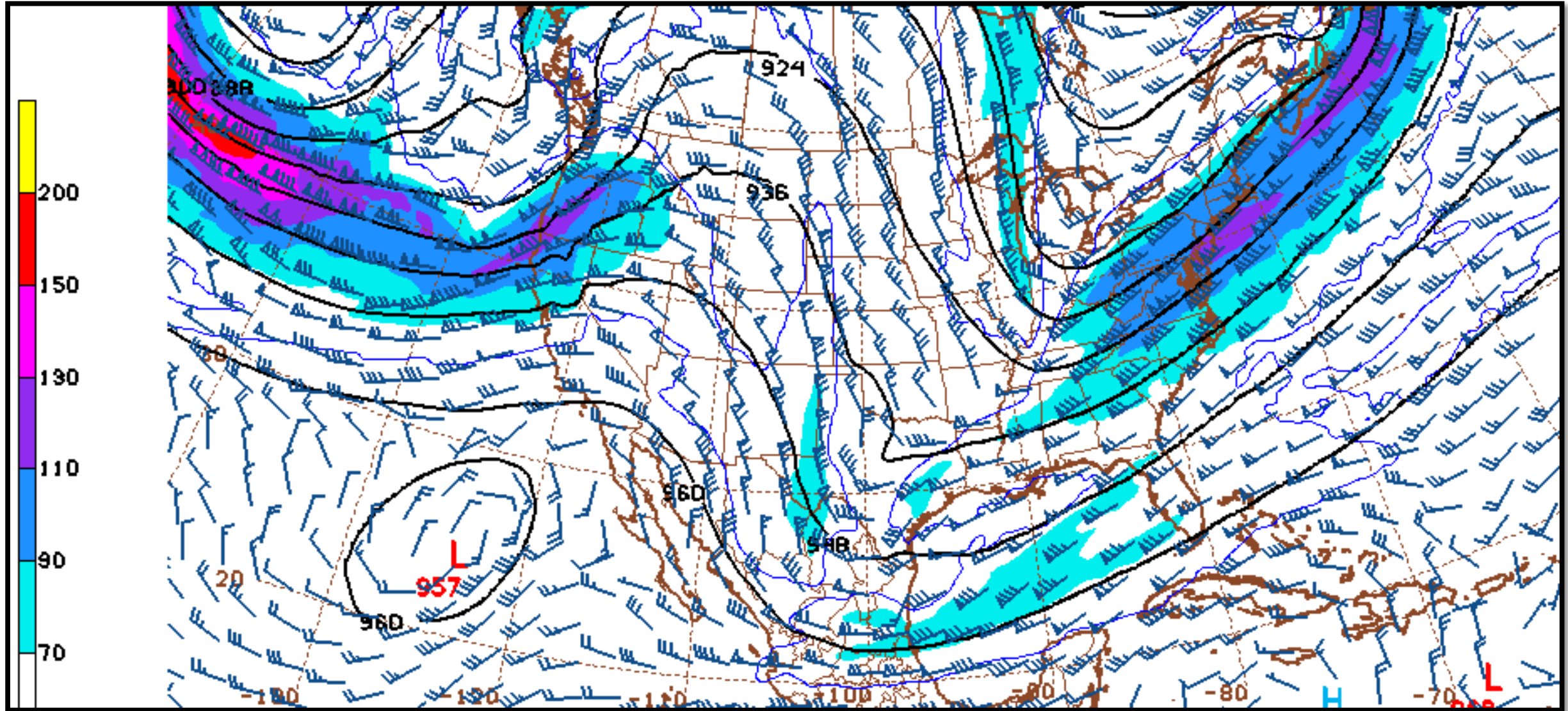

Upper Level Steering Patterns



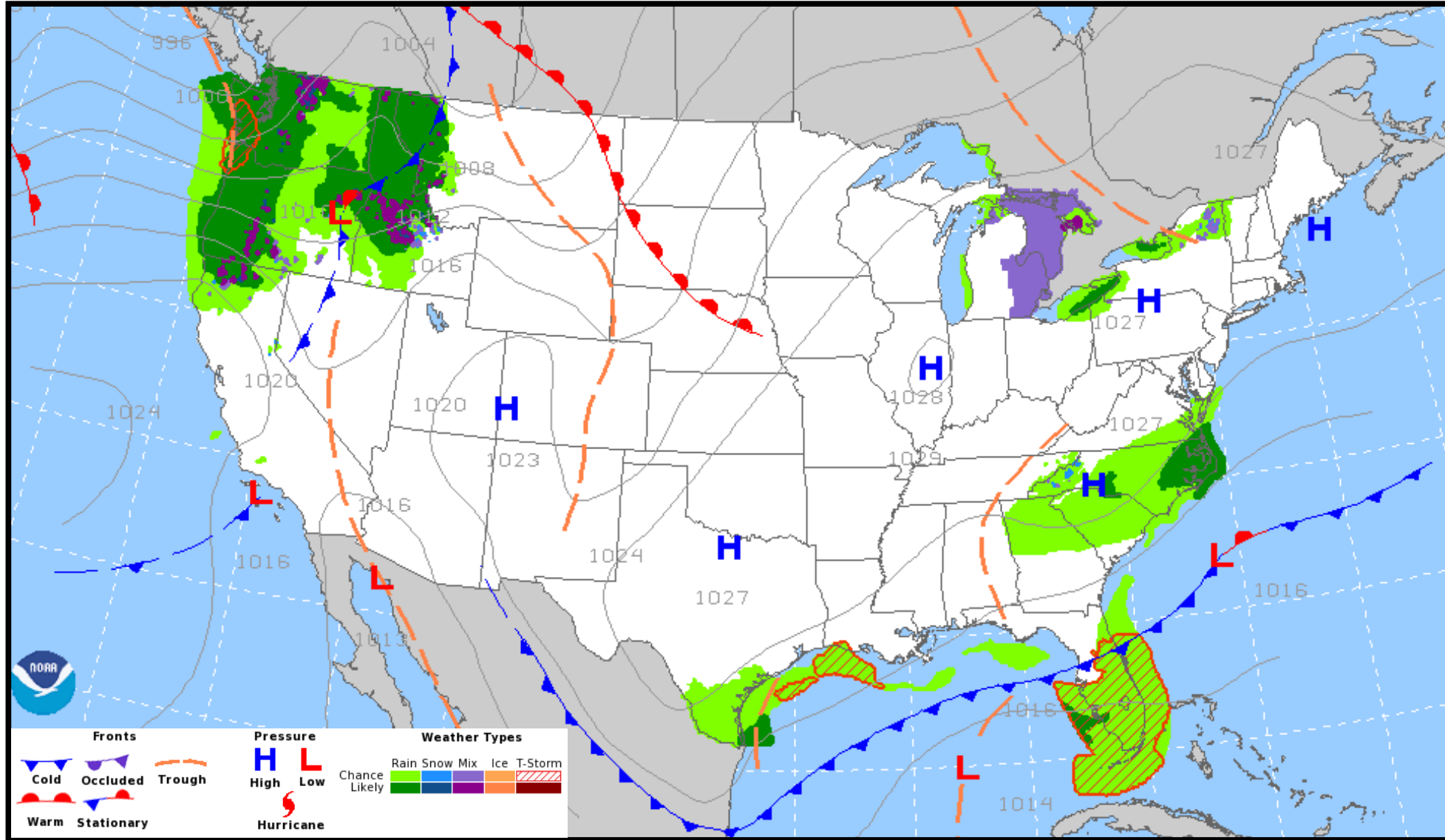

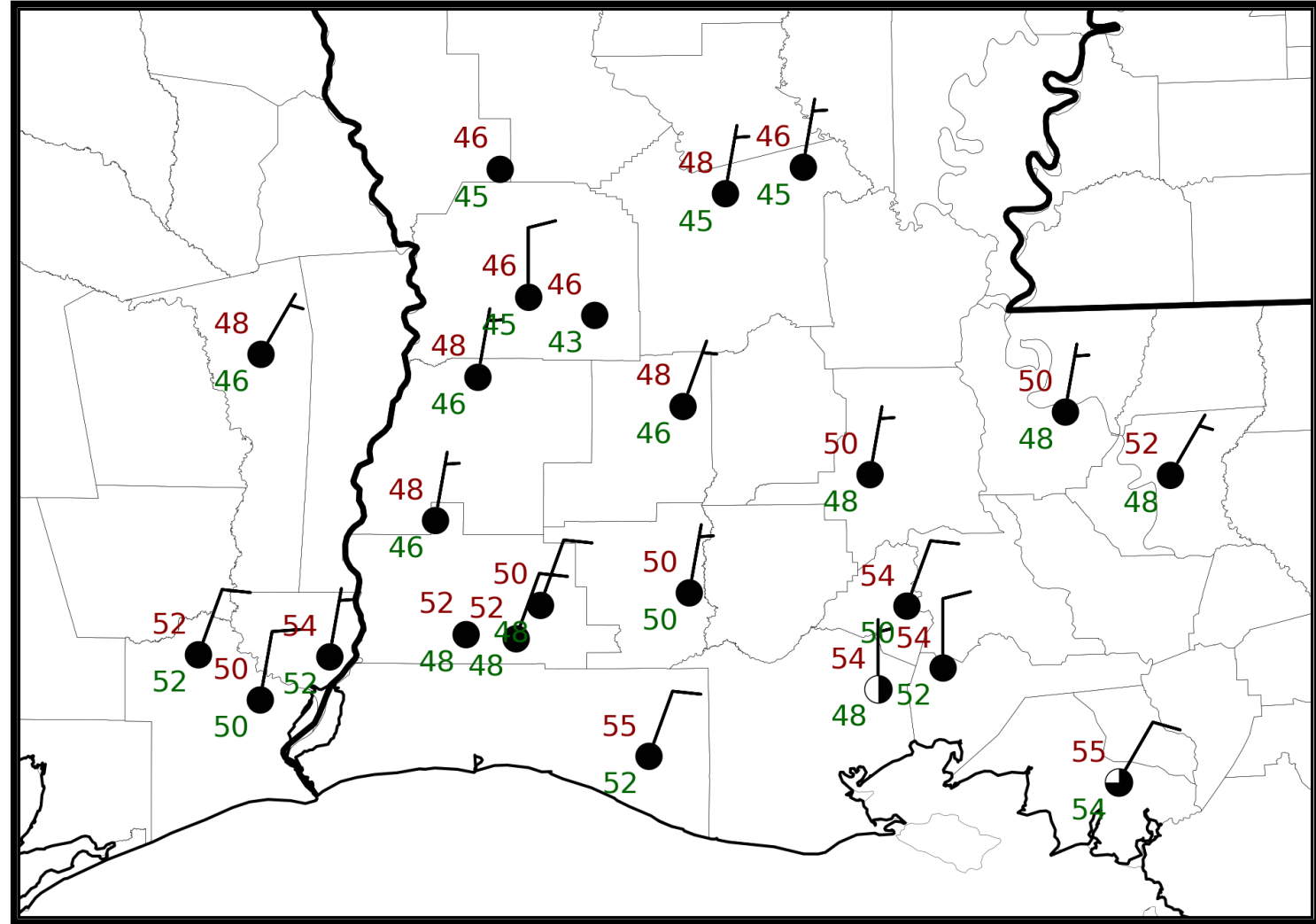


6 am Weather Observations

Under cloudy skies, temperatures were in the mid 40s to mid 50s. Winds were out of the north at 10 mph.

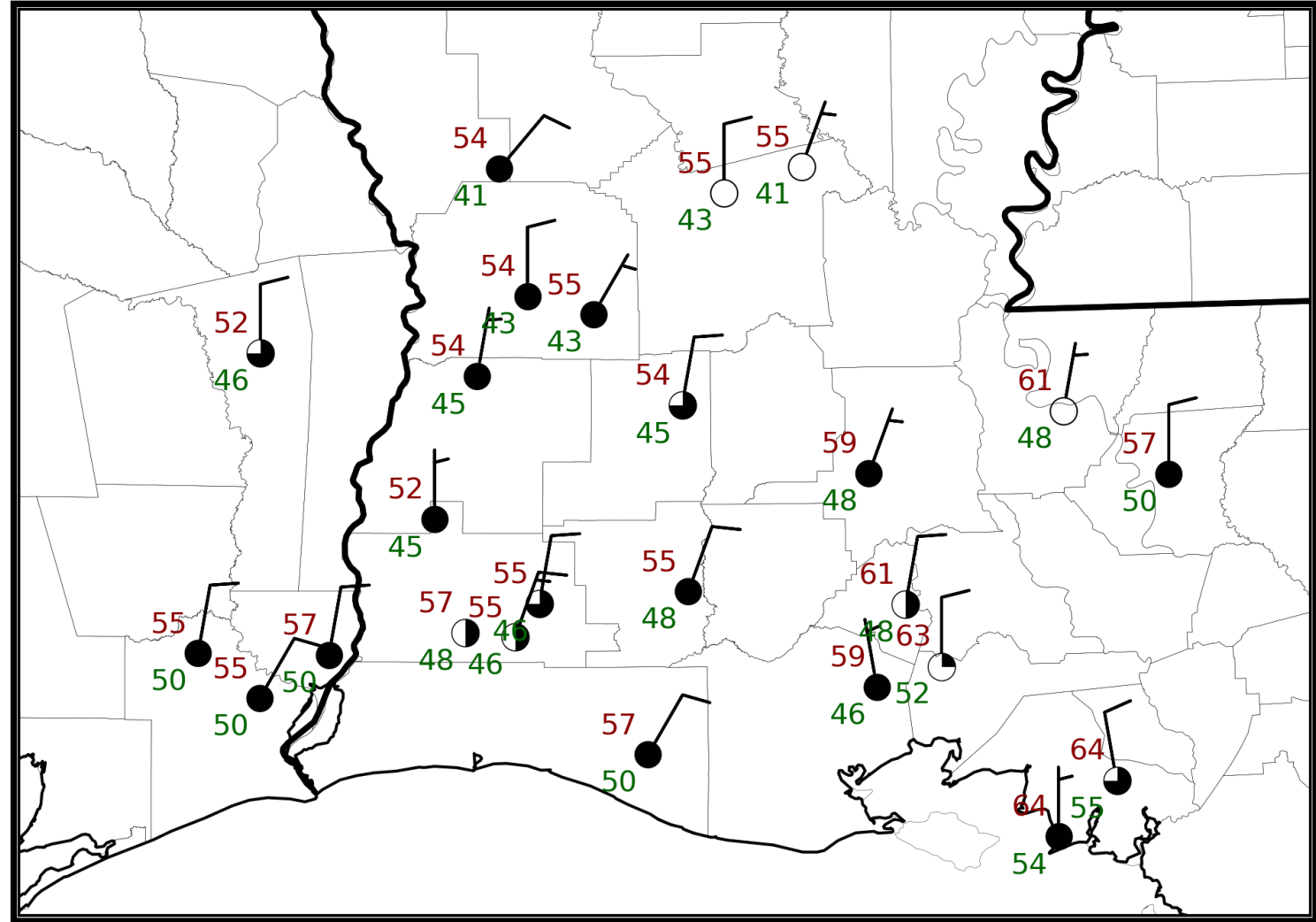


2 pm Weather Observations

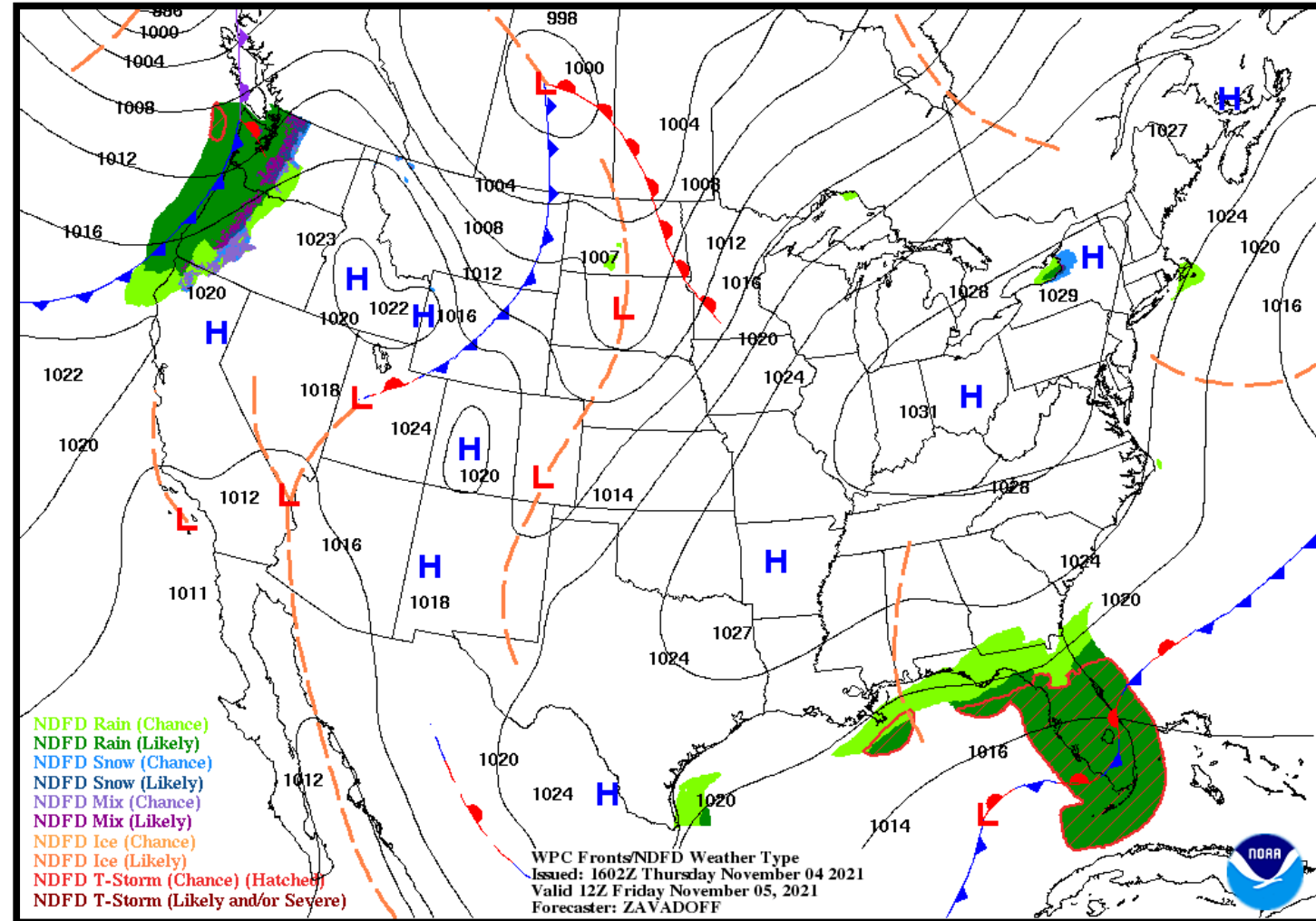
Under mostly cloudy skies, temperatures were in the 50s to mid 60s. Winds were out of the north at 10 mph.

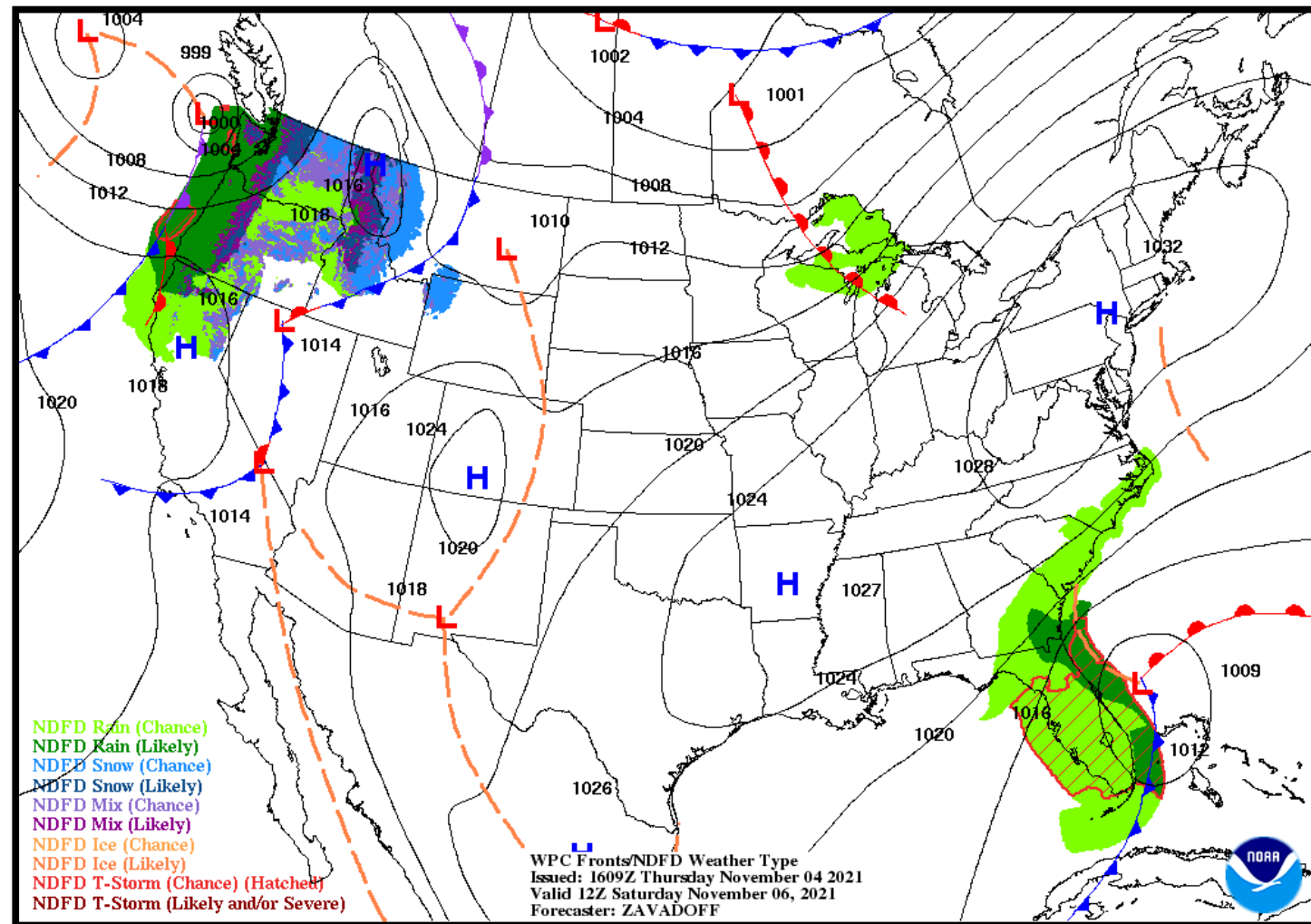
