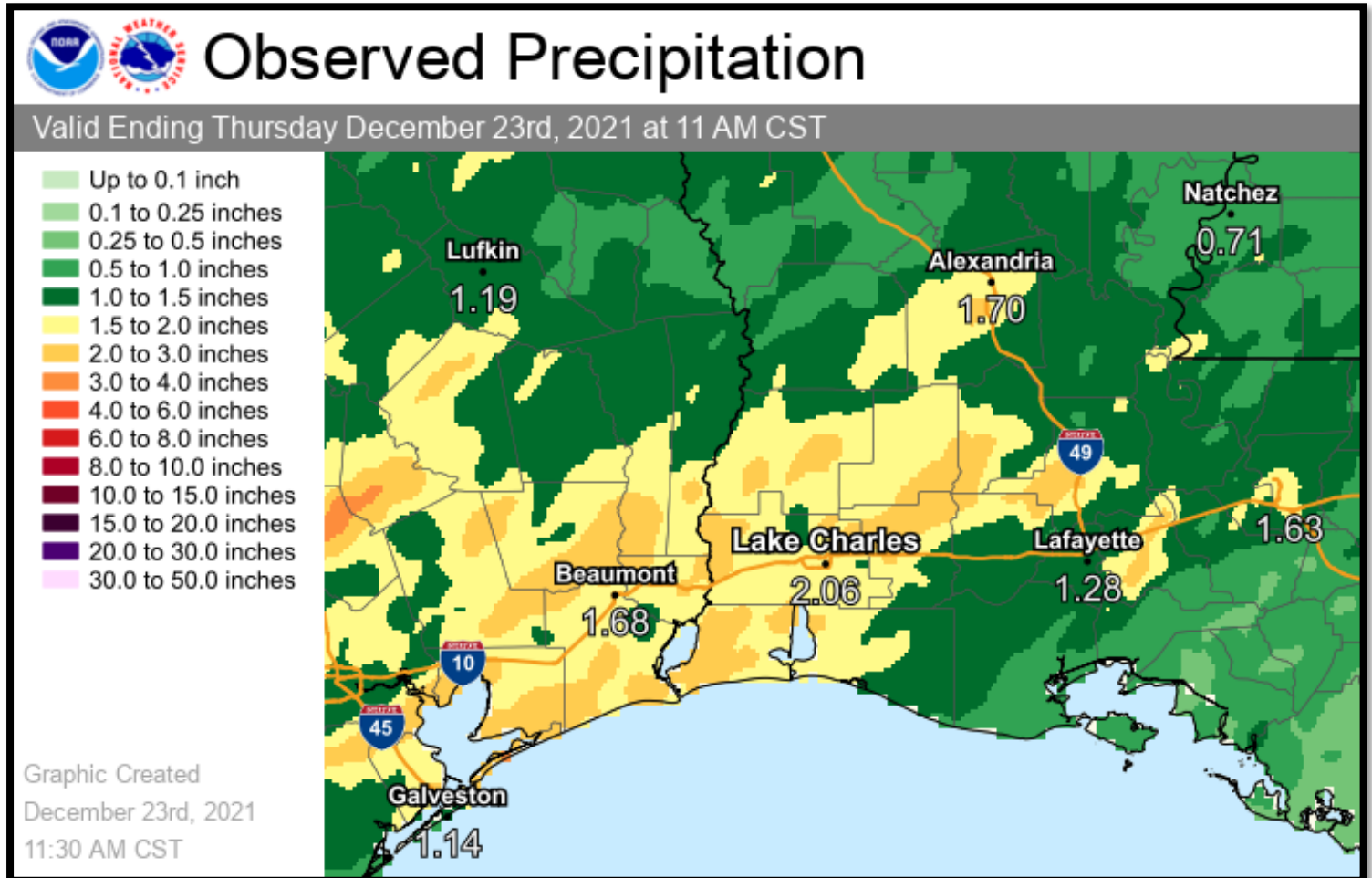
TOP STORY:

Unseasonably warm and humid conditions will occur over the Christmas Holiday weekend. It will stay warm into next week. However, rain chances will increase as a front tries to approach the area.

Rain during the past week was mainly 1 to 3 inches, and just about all of that fell on Saturday with a cold frontal passage.

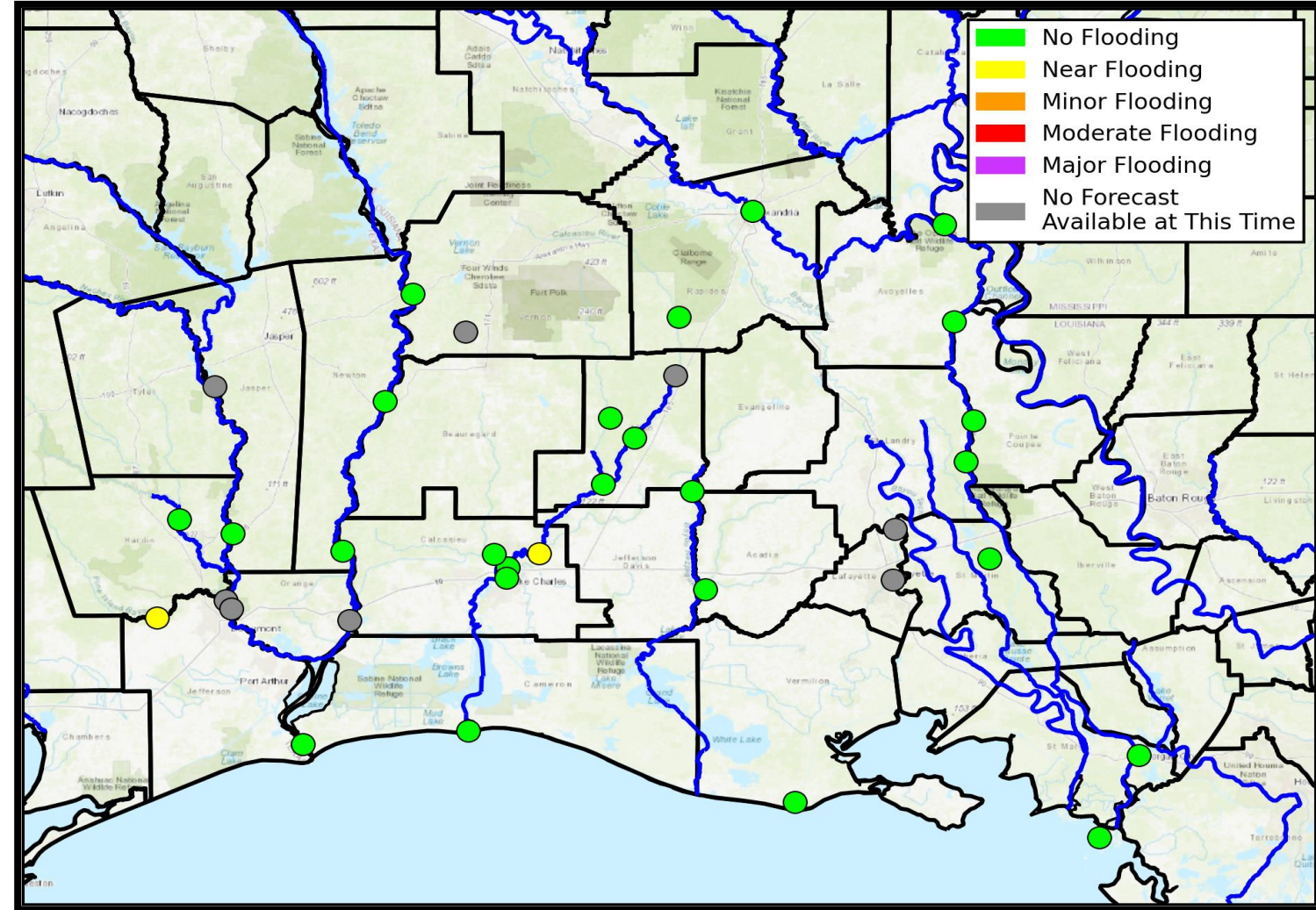


River Forecasts

With the overall dry conditions no river issues are noted.

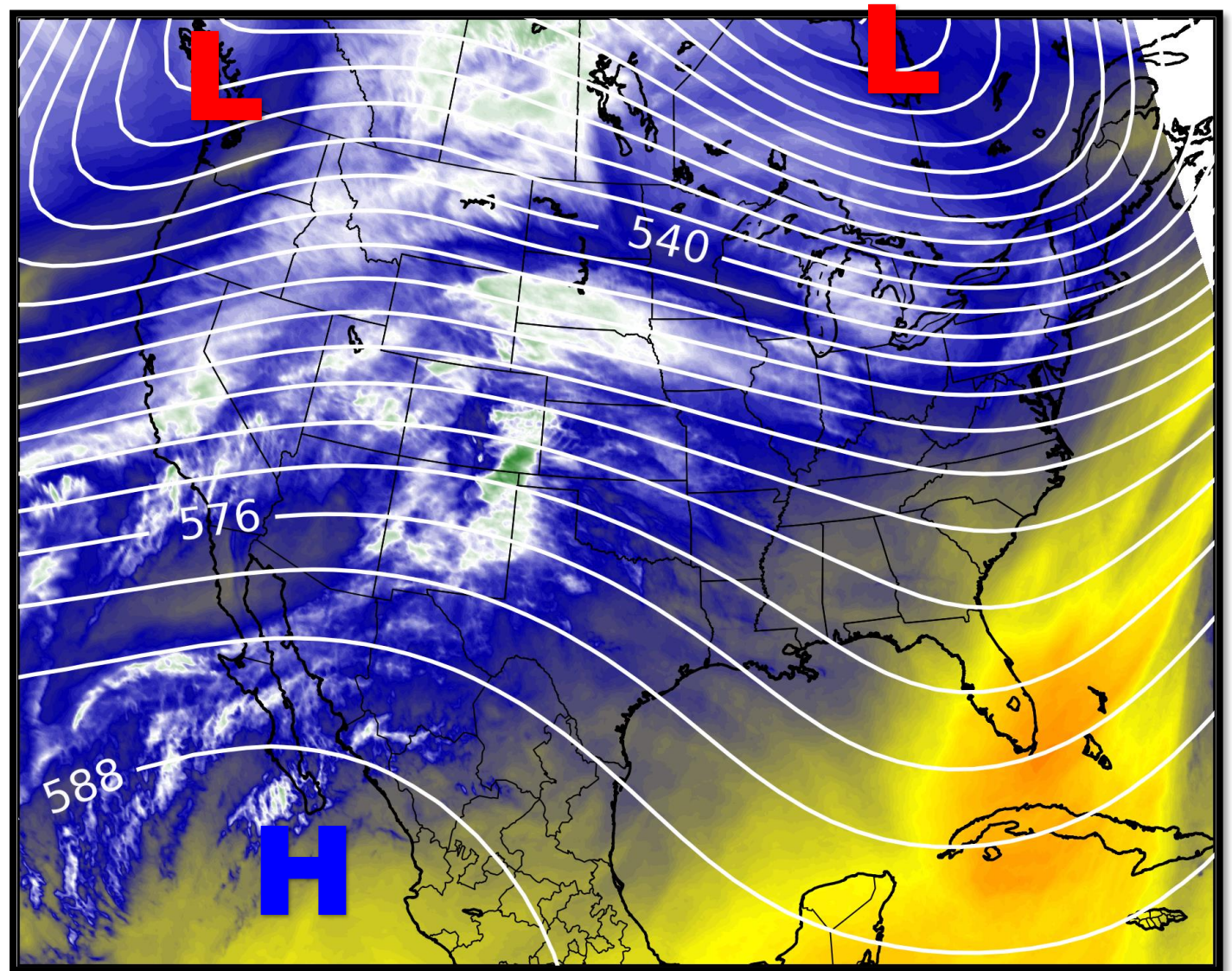


Upper Level Steering Patterns

A series of upper level lows will affect the northern sections of the country. Meanwhile, an upper level ridge over Mexico will build across the Gulf of Mexico and southern US.

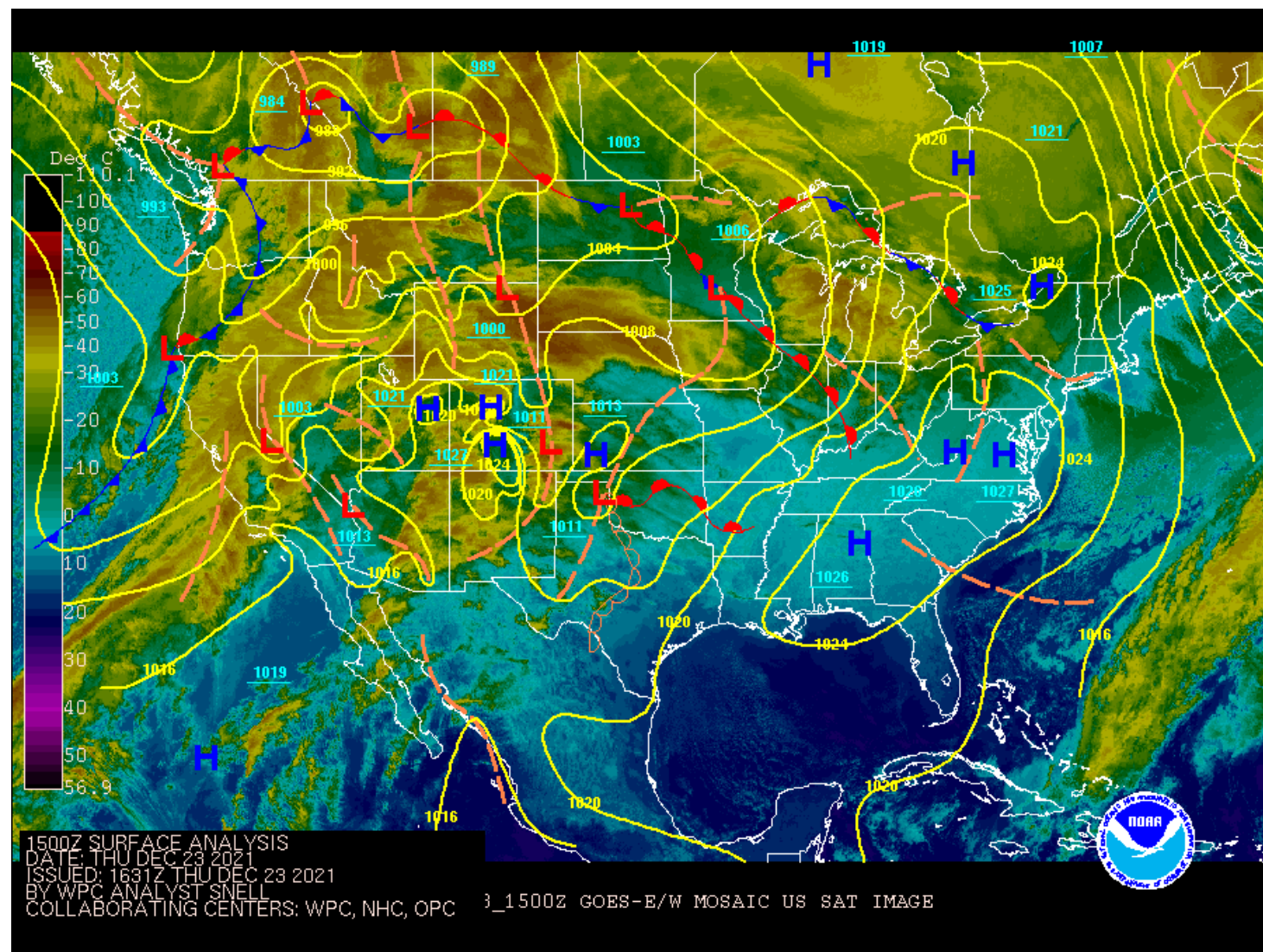


Surface Weather Map with Fronts

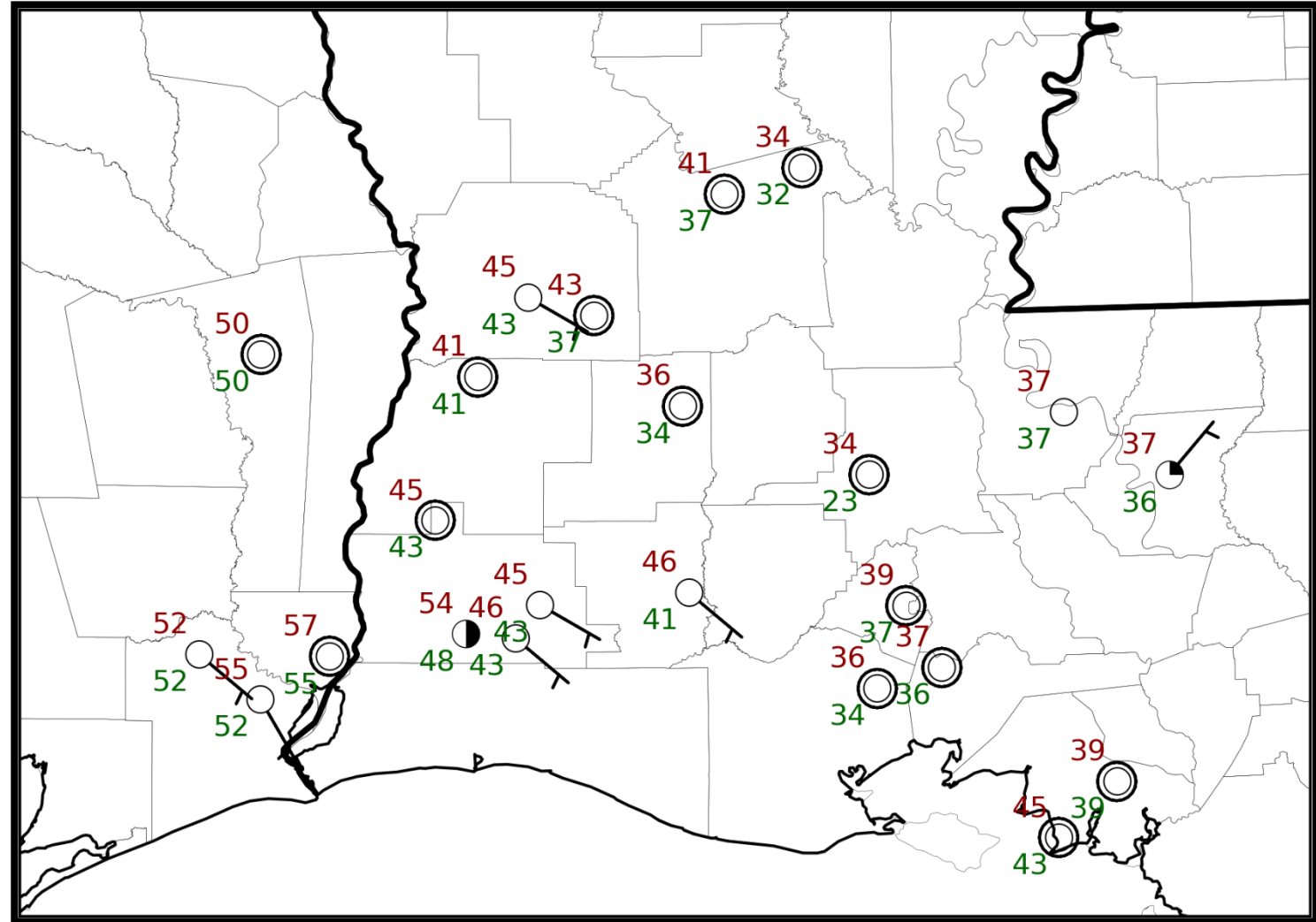


6 am Weather Observations

A little on the chilly side for Acadiana and east central Louisiana. However, southeast winds over southeast Texas made for milder temperatures.

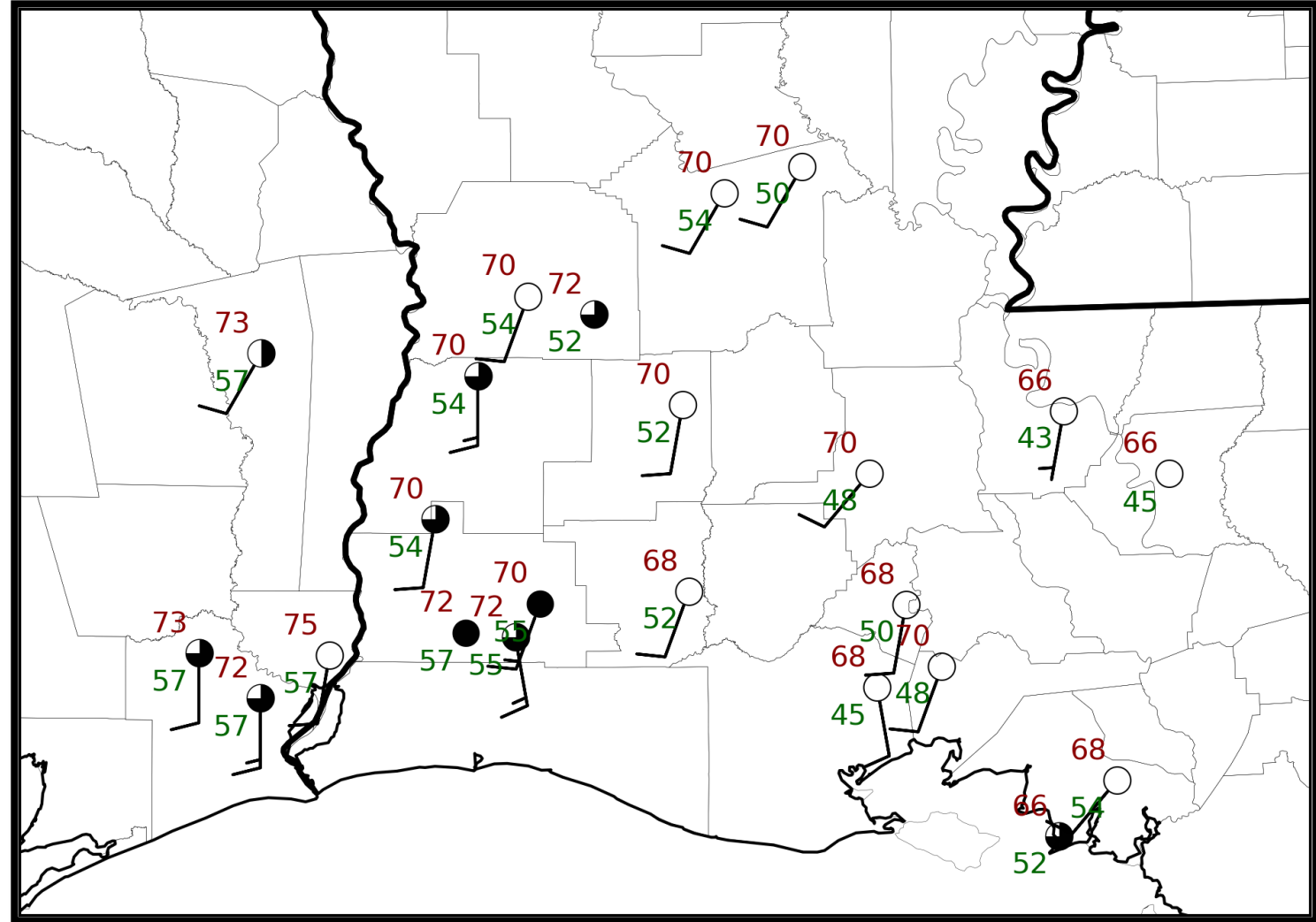


2 pm Weather Observations

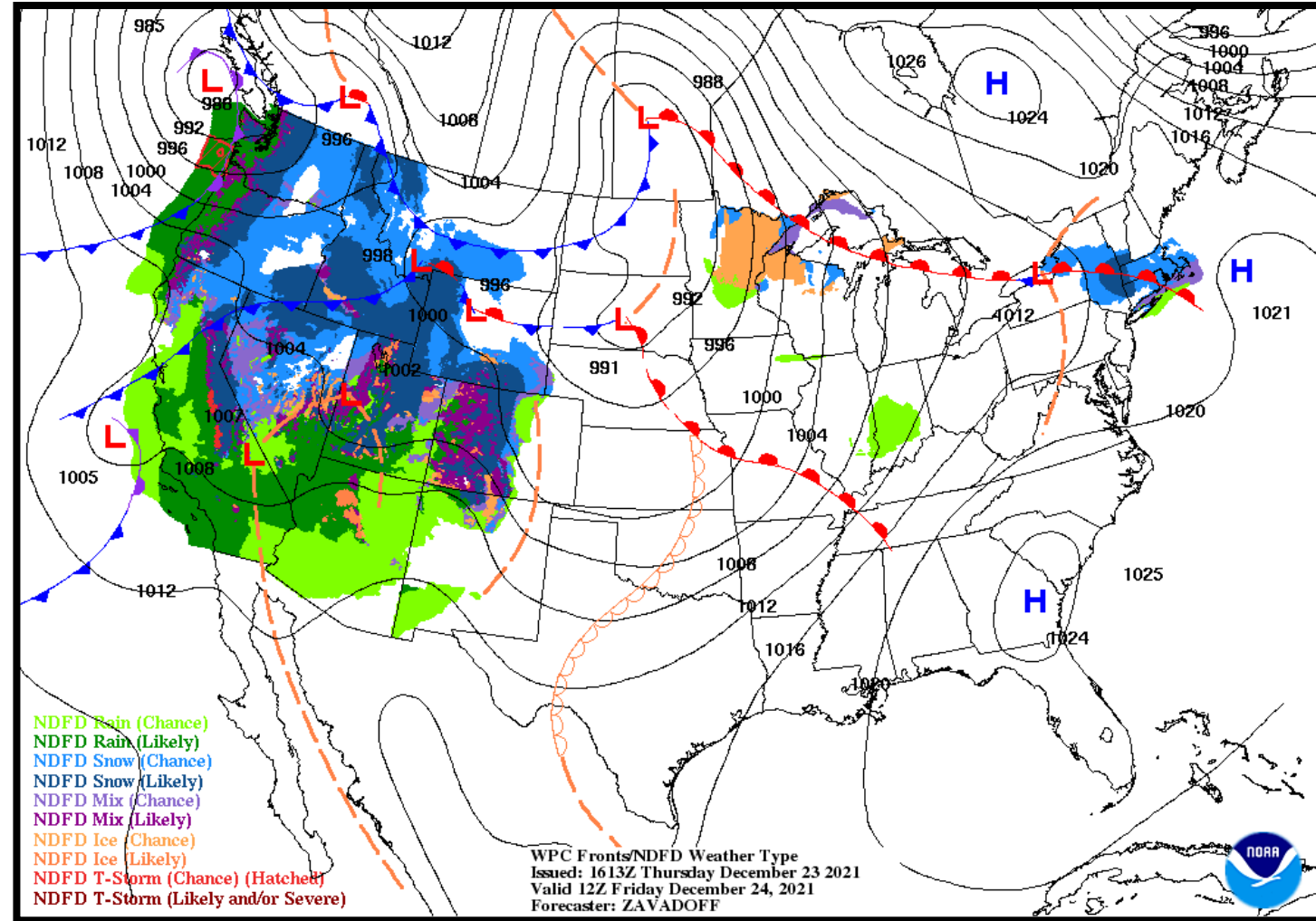
Mostly sunny. Southerly winds bringing in mild temperatures.

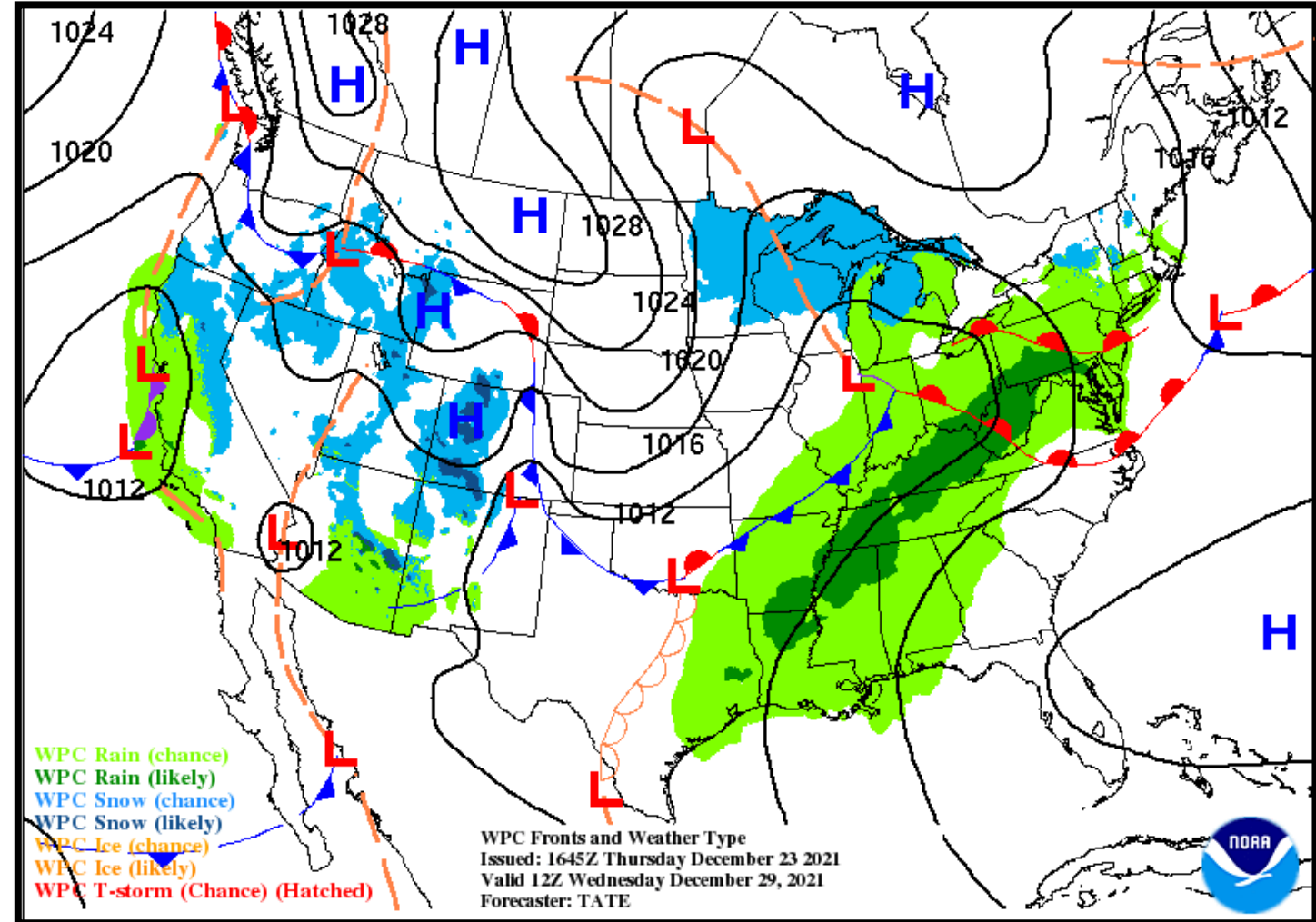
