The parish experienced tropical storm force winds mainly in gusts. No damage or significant impacts were reported.

The parish experienced tropical storm force winds mainly in gusts. No damage or significant impacts were reported.

The parish experienced tropical storm force winds, with sustained TS winds reported at a few sites along the immediate coast and shoreline of Lake Pontchartrain. Away from the immediate coast tropical storm winds were mainly in the form of gusts. Storm surge resulted in minor flooding of low lying roads outside the HSDRRS levees, including through Venetian Isles and in parking lots along Lakeshore Drive and West End Point.

The parish experienced tropical storm force winds, with sustained TS winds reported across near the mouth of the MS River. Elsewhere, TS wind reports were mainly in the form of gusts. Storm surge resulted in minor flooding of low lying areas outside the HSDRRS levees, including through Myrtle Grove Estates.

The parish experienced tropical storm force winds mainly in gusts. Storm surge resulted in minor flooding around the Shell Beach area, with parking lots becoming inundated.
