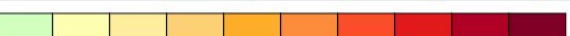

Minimum Temperature Forecast (°F)



Level 1 of 5 (Marginal) risk for severe weather

- **Scattered Storms** (40-50% coverage) mid-late afternoon and evening.
- Main severe hazard:
 - ◆ **Damaging Winds**
 - ◆ *Localized flash flooding possible*
- **Best Chance for Severe Timing:**
 - ◆ 3 pm - 10 pm EDT
- **Uncertainty:** Precise location of strongest storms. Timing in any given location.

Risk Level	Count
Low	1
Medium	2
High	1



STAY INDOORS **DURING HEAT WAVES**



Stay indoors in **air conditioning** whenever possible. If your home doesn't have AC, check if your area has a cooling center.



Remain hydrated by drinking **water** and avoiding alcohol.



Check on those **most vulnerable** to heat, including children and the elderly.



If you must go outdoors, go early or late in the day, and dress in light-colored clothing.
