## Key Messages:

- Scattered showers and storms still possible later this evening into tonight
- Most likely threat after 8 PM EDT along and west of I-65
- A few strong storms could be possible, with gusty winds as the main threat

## What Has Changed:

- The risk for severe storms is decreasing for our area. The Marginal Risk (level 1 of 5) has been trimmed farther west.

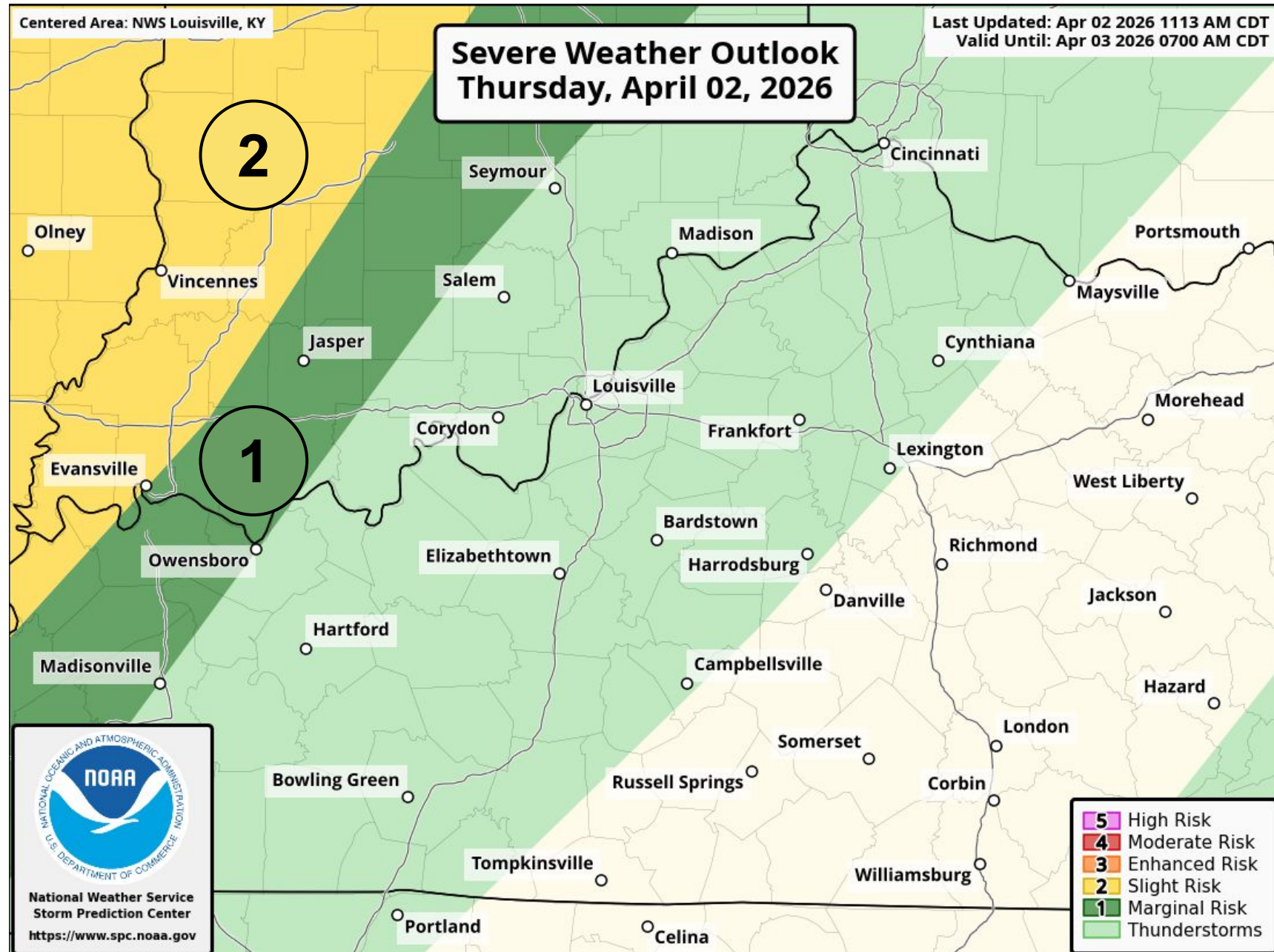

3:52 PM

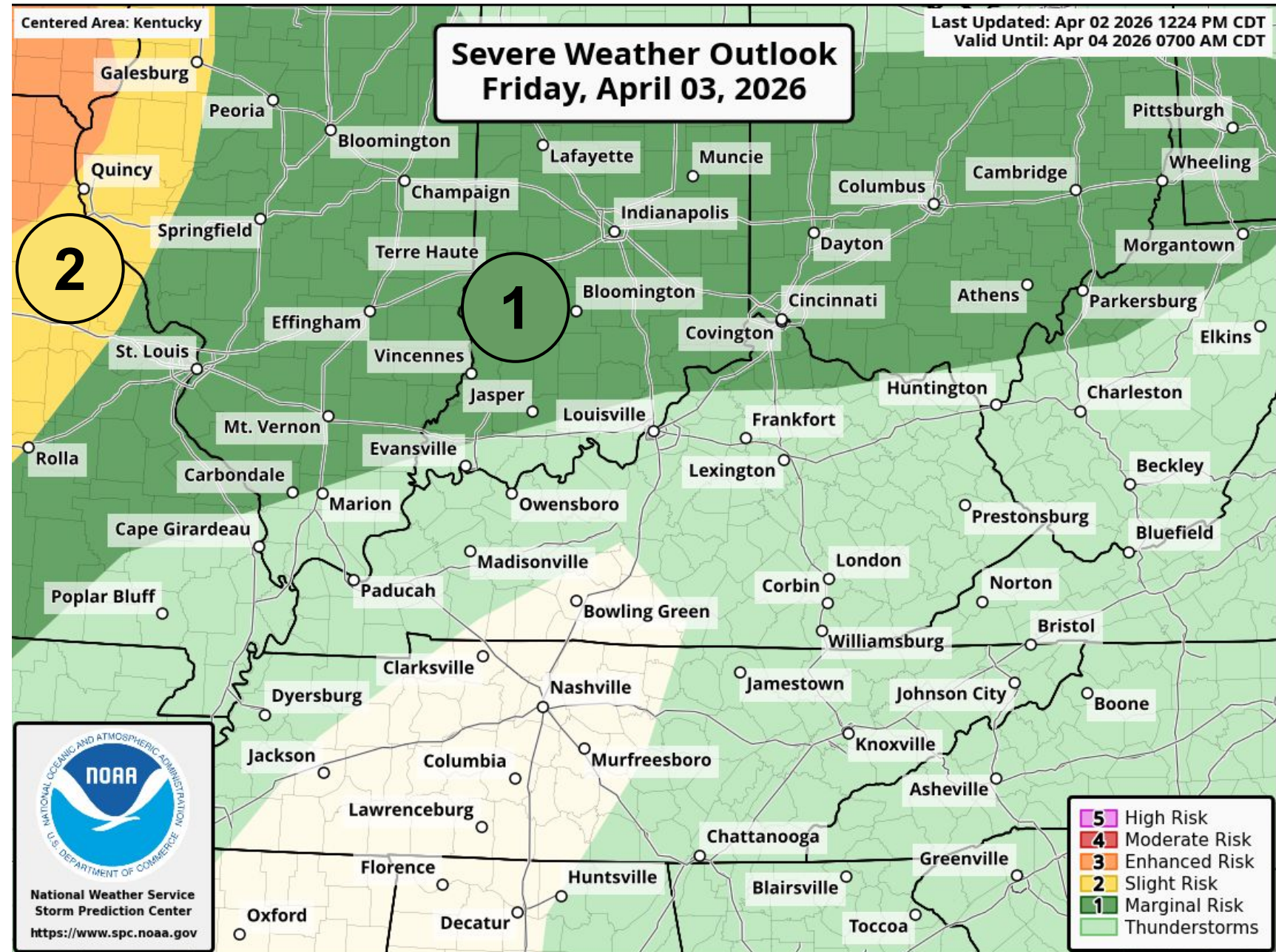
Greatest chance for stronger storms will be during the afternoon

- Marginal Risk (level 1 of 5) has now shifted north of the Ohio River
