A Couple Chances for Showers and Storms This Week

Key Messages:

- Well-above normal temperatures through the rest of the week.
- Best chances for rain: Thursday and Saturday
 - ◆ **Low-end risk** for strong/severe storms Thursday
 - ◆ **Strong storms** also possible Saturday
- **Cooler and drier weather** returns Sunday into early next week

Gusty Winds are the Main Hazard with Strong Storms

Key Messages:

- Scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected to approach central KY and southern IN from the west Thursday morning
- Depending on how widespread clouds and precipitation are during the day on Thursday, a few strong thunderstorms may develop in the afternoon and evening
- Main (Conditional) Severe Hazard: Gusty Winds

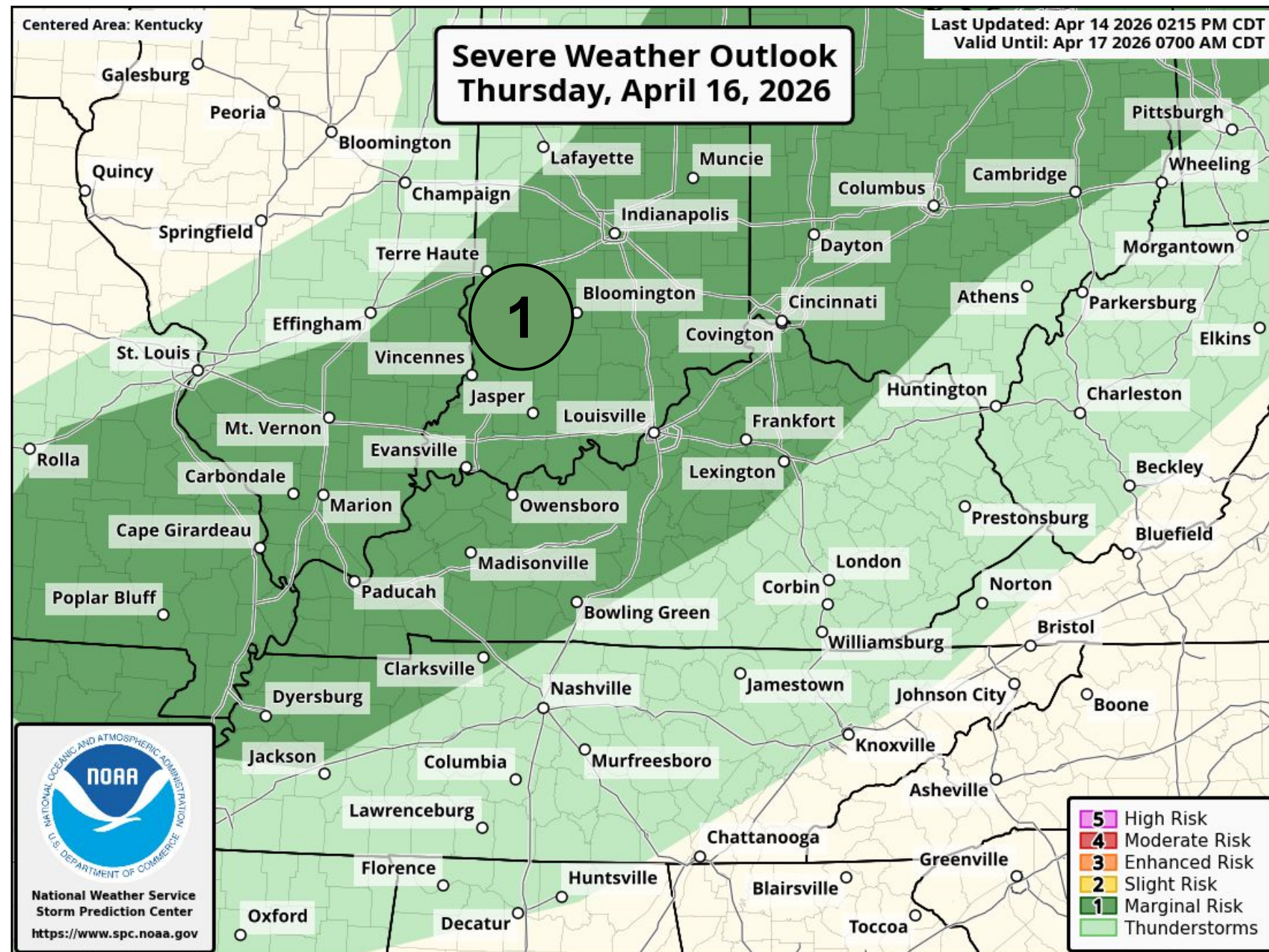
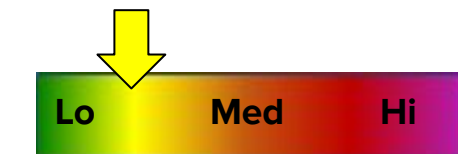

Another Chance for Storms on Saturday

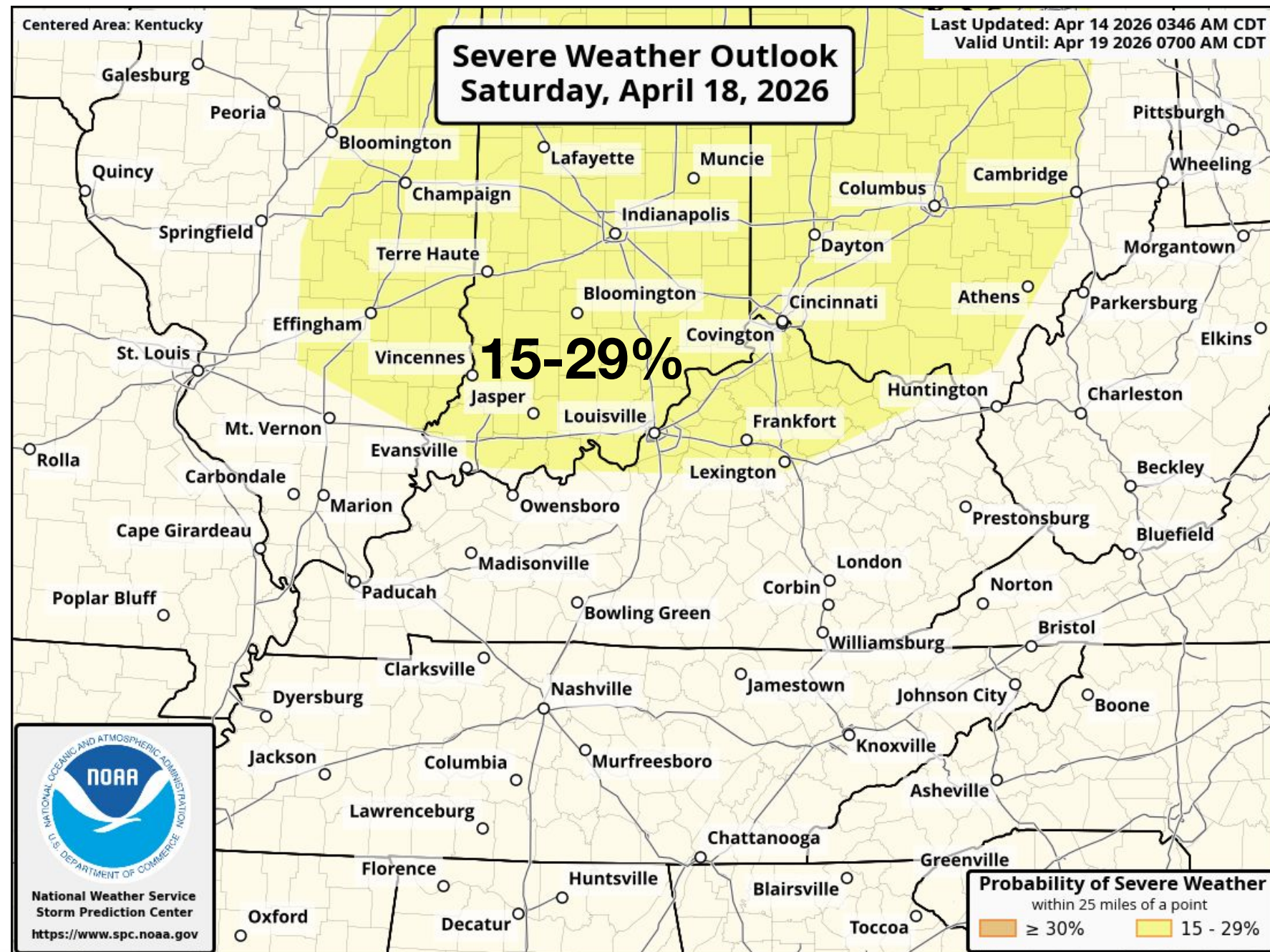

Gusty Winds are the Main Hazard with Strong Storms

Key Messages:

- A cold front will move across the region Saturday afternoon and evening, with a line of showers and storms expected to develop just ahead of the front.
- Uncertain if instability (fuel) will be sufficient for strong to severe storms
- **Main Severe Threat:** Gusty Straight-Line Winds
- **Main Time Window for Storms:** midday through early evening
- The expected timing and severe weather potential is likely to change over the next few days
 - ◆ Stay tuned to the latest forecast updates!
