





Wind and Hail Probabilities

Showers and Storms Sunday, Cooler and Drier for the First Half of the Upcoming Week

Key Messages:

- **Warm and Breezy Sunday:**
Highs in the 80s and S/SW winds of 10-20 mph with gusts of 20-30 mph expected.
- **Strong to severe storms** possible late Sunday evening and overnight.
- **Main Threat:** Hail and Gusty Winds.
- Cooler and mainly dry conditions are expected Monday through Wednesday.
- Rain chances and warmer temperatures return by Thursday.
