



Wind Advisory in Effect for Much of Kentucky and Indiana

Wind Advisory Today



Key Messages:

- A strong low pressure system will move across the Great Lakes today, with a cold front approaching the Ohio Valley this afternoon.
- Widespread 30-40 mph gusts are likely
- Scattered 40-50 mph wind gusts are possible, especially across southern Indiana, north central, and east central Kentucky.
- Strongest wind gusts expected between 9 AM - 4 PM EDT / 8 AM - 3 PM CDT

Severe Storms Likely Sunday Night



Strong Cold Front Blasts Through the Region Early Monday Morning

Key Messages:

- Gusty south-southwest winds of 40-45 mph are expected Sunday afternoon and evening ahead of a strong cold front.
- The strong cold front will move through the region quickly during the overnight period with a band of strong/severe thunderstorms.
- Main Severe Threat:
Damaging Straight-Line Winds (65-75 mph)
 - ◆ Spin-up tornadoes also possible
 - ◆ This is a **NIGHTTIME** event, so have multiple ways to get watches and warnings!

This Will Be An Overnight Event!


Key Messages:

- Storms will enter western Kentucky toward Midnight Sunday night.
- Storms will reach the I-65 corridor between 3-6 AM
- Storms will reach the I-75 corridor near sunrise Monday morning.
- These times could change slightly over the next days.

Falling Temperatures behind Cold Front

March 13, 2026
3:50 PM

Sunday to Monday Temperatures fall around 40 Degrees

- By Monday Afternoon, gusty northwest winds are expected to drop temperatures into the 30s.
- Tuesday Morning, Lows are expected to drop into the mid to upper teens. **Wind Chills** drop into the **low single digits**.
- Wednesday, temperatures begin warming back into the 50s. 60s return for Thursday and Friday.

STORM PLANNING TIMELINE

A few days out

If the forecast calls for severe weather in a few days, start preparing now.



Make sure that you have emergency supplies




Know your safe places



Have a family communication plan

The day before

The day before, forecast accuracy continues to improve.

Make sure your phone can receive WEAs



Ensure your shelter is clean and accessible

Remain vigilant and aware of any active Watches. A Warning may be issued at a moment's notice!



Remind your family of the communication plan




Know how to evacuate and/or get to safety from wherever you are



When a Warning is issued, you may only have seconds to take action!

Be Prepared for Nighttime Tornadoes



NOAA Weather Radio

Test regularly and make sure it's tuned to your local station

Safe Place

Have a safe place prepared if you know storms are coming

Cell phone

Turned on, charged and Wireless Emergency Alerts enabled

Flashlight & Shoes

Keep flashlight and sturdy shoes handy
