Waves of Showers and Storms Expected Thursday Evening through Saturday

## Key Messages

- Marginal Risk for severe storms early Friday morning for western & central KY.
- Main threat is gusty damaging winds and a very small threat for a brief, weak tornado.
- Showers and storms will end west to east by late morning/early afternoon
- Break in activity Friday afternoon/evening
- Next wave is late Friday night/early Saturday morning with even less of a severe threat.
- Confidence in severe weather is low due to limited fuel for storms.






# Expected Rainfall Amounts

## Excessive Rainfall Outlook - Fri




