Minor travel impacts possible during the Monday morning commute

Details

- Wintry mix of snow, sleet, and some freezing rain expected generally north of the I-64 corridor on Monday morning, with precipitation changing over to rain by late morning to early afternoon.
- Mainly light rain likely across south-central KY.
- **Greatest uncertainty for precipitation type is the area along and south of the I-64 corridor.**
- Minor slushy snow accumulation is possible across southern IN and north-central KY.
- Confidence is highest in minor travel impacts north of I-64, where temperatures may dip below freezing for a short period of time.



- Winter Weather Advisory in effect from 200 AM to 10 AM EST for areas roughly along and north of I-64.







Wintry Mix Expected Monday Morning

40-70% chance for a glaze of ice
along and north of I-64





Active Weather Pattern Ahead

Next Week Into Mid March

- An active, increasingly wet weather pattern is likely to emerge next week as multiple waves of low pressure move across the Plains and Midwest. **There is a 50-60% chance for above normal precipitation March 9-15 across portions of Indiana, western Kentucky, and central Kentucky.**
- Multiple rounds of thunderstorms are possible with this pattern, and some storms could be strong to severe. Monitor the forecast as we move into next week, and take any early planning measures for flooding or severe weather.
