Gusty Winds, Hail, Heavy Downpours, and Frequent Lightning Possible

Key Messages


- → Most of Thursday will be warm and dry
 - Likely the warmest day of the year to date so far
- → Will watch for storm development upstream, moving into our area
 - If storms develop, they likely will push into southern Indiana late evening, and potentially into central Kentucky overnight
- Main threats: large hail, locally damaging winds, heavy rain, and frequent lightning

Another Wave of Severe Storms Friday

Multiple Hazards Possible with these storms

Key Messages

- Timing/exact location will depend on how late Thursday activity develops
 - Weaker or non-existent first wave likely will allow for stronger storms
 Friday late afternoon and evening
- Main threats: damaging winds, heavy rain, tornadoes, and frequent lightning
 - Still early in the forecast, so keep updated as we close out the work week!
