Damaging Winds, Isolated Tornadoes Likely Late Tonight/Early Wednesday Morning

Key Messages

- Isolated strong to severe storms beginning later this evening, with large hail as the main hazard.
- Line of storms overnight/early Wed morning could produce damaging winds and spin-up tornadoes. Strong tornadoes will be possible.

Impacts

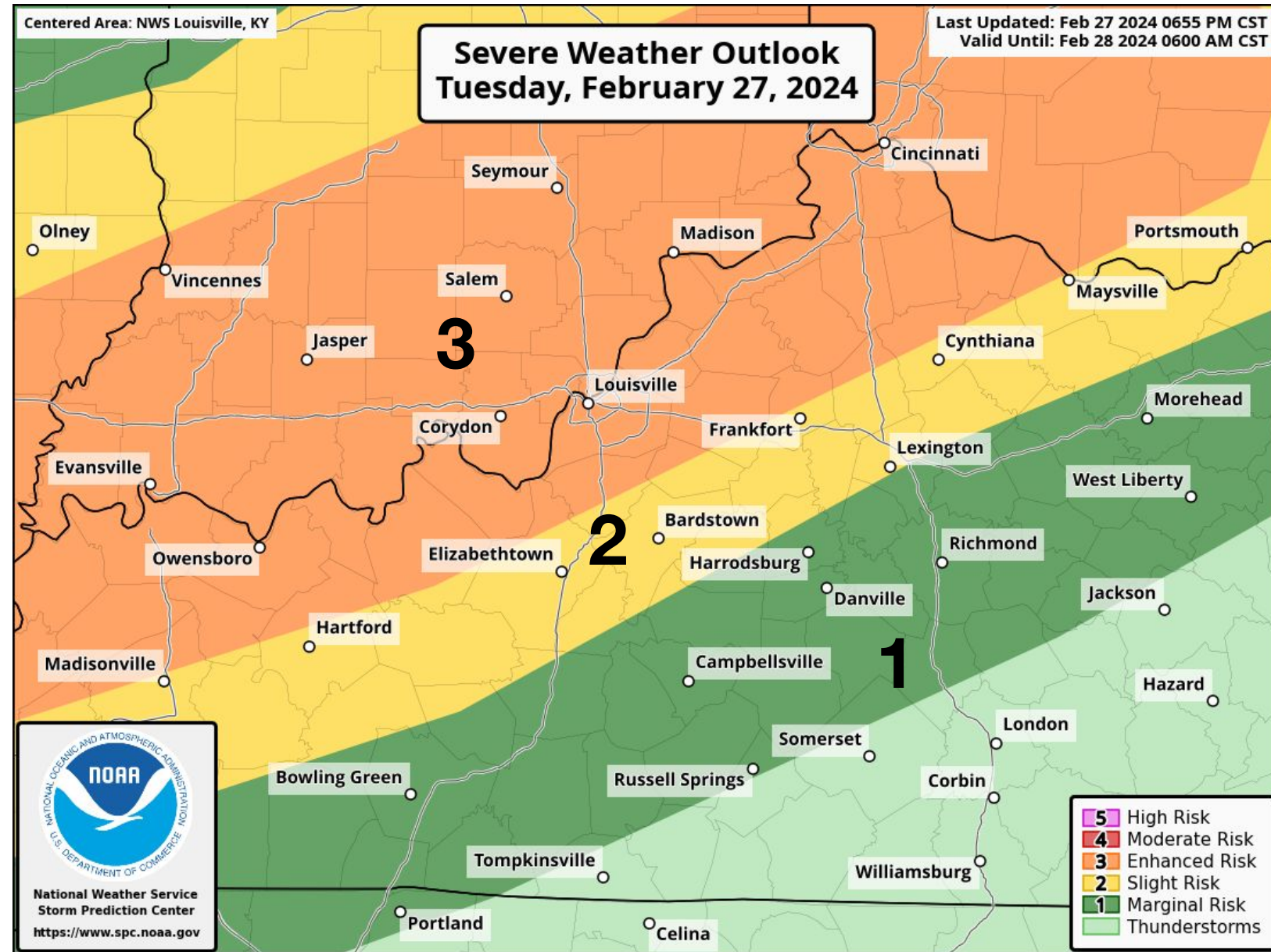
- Strong wind gusts of 30-40+ mph likely outside of storms tonight into Wednesday.
- Scattered reports of damaging (70+ mph) winds & tornadoes likely within the yellow and orange shaded areas (Slight and Enhanced Risk).
- Heavy rain could cause ponding and impact the Wednesday morning commute.

Timing

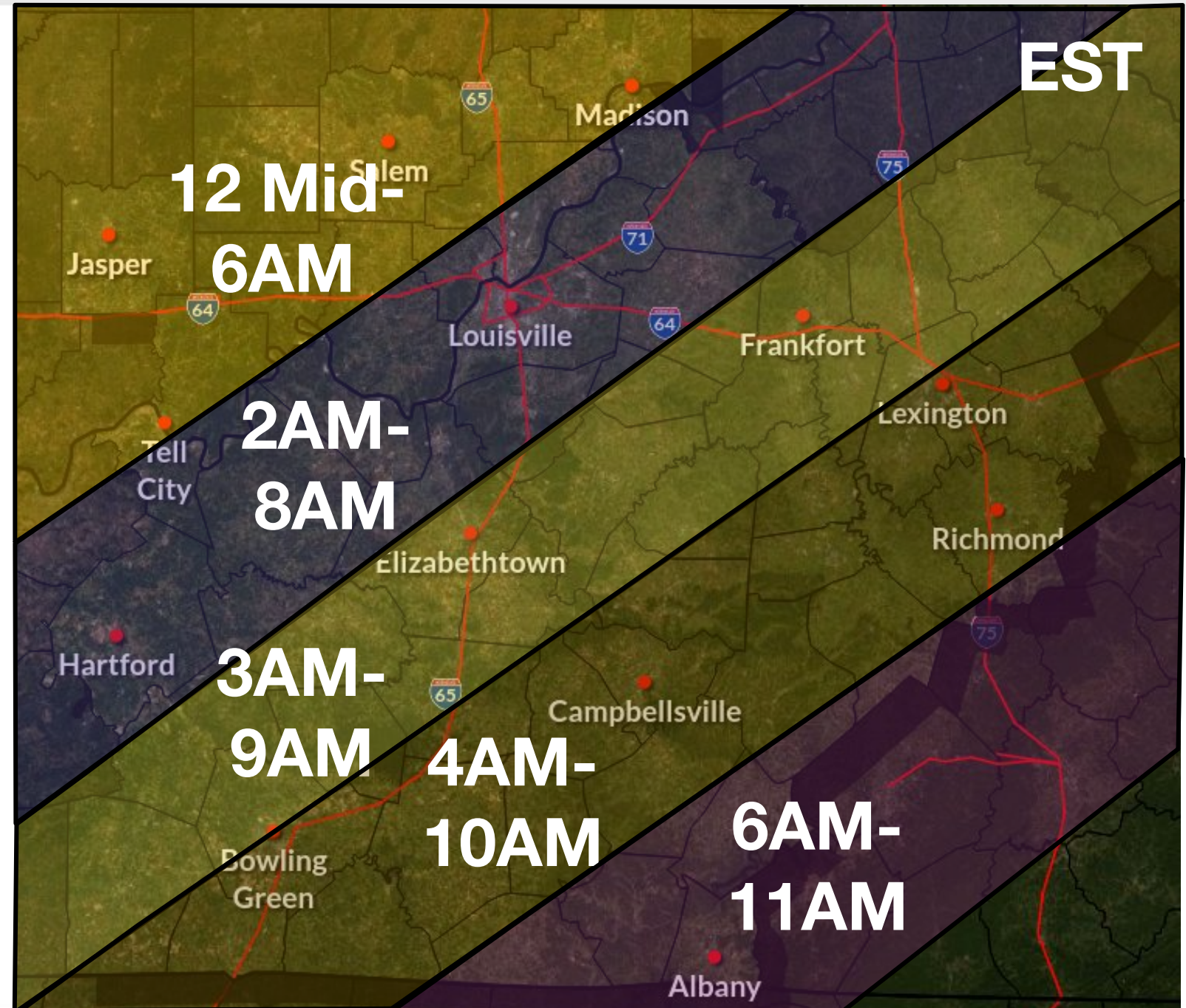
- 2 waves of storms will move through the region:
 - ◆ First wave will lead to individual storms over north central Kentucky and southern Indiana. *(Mainly hail, also gusty winds)*
 - ◆ Second wave will be a line of storms oriented SW-NE and moving SE. *(Damaging wind and spin-up tornadoes)*
- Severe weather threat diminishing after 6 AM in southern Indiana and exiting the region completely by 11AM. Gusty showers could still linger.
