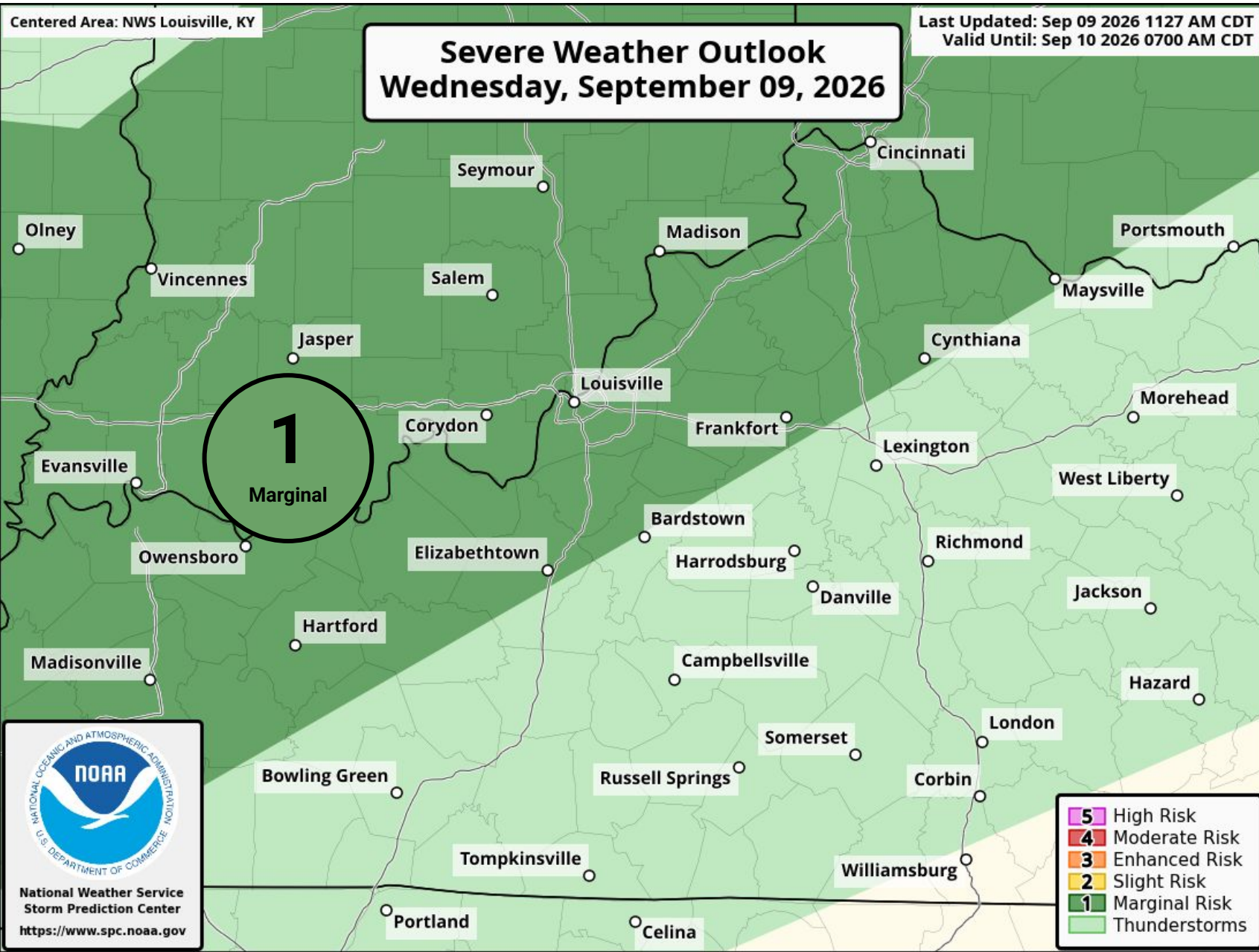

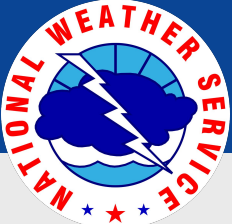
A Few Strong to Severe Storms with Damaging Wind Gusts Possible

Key Messages

- Scattered showers and thunderstorms will approach the Ohio River from the northwest this evening ahead of a slow moving cold front
- **Timing:** Rounds of showers and storms starting late this evening and into Thursday
- Main Severe Hazard: **Localized Damaging Winds and Localized Flooding**
- **Uncertainty:** How fast the cold front drops southeast will determine the strength of storms and showers

Localized Flooding Possible

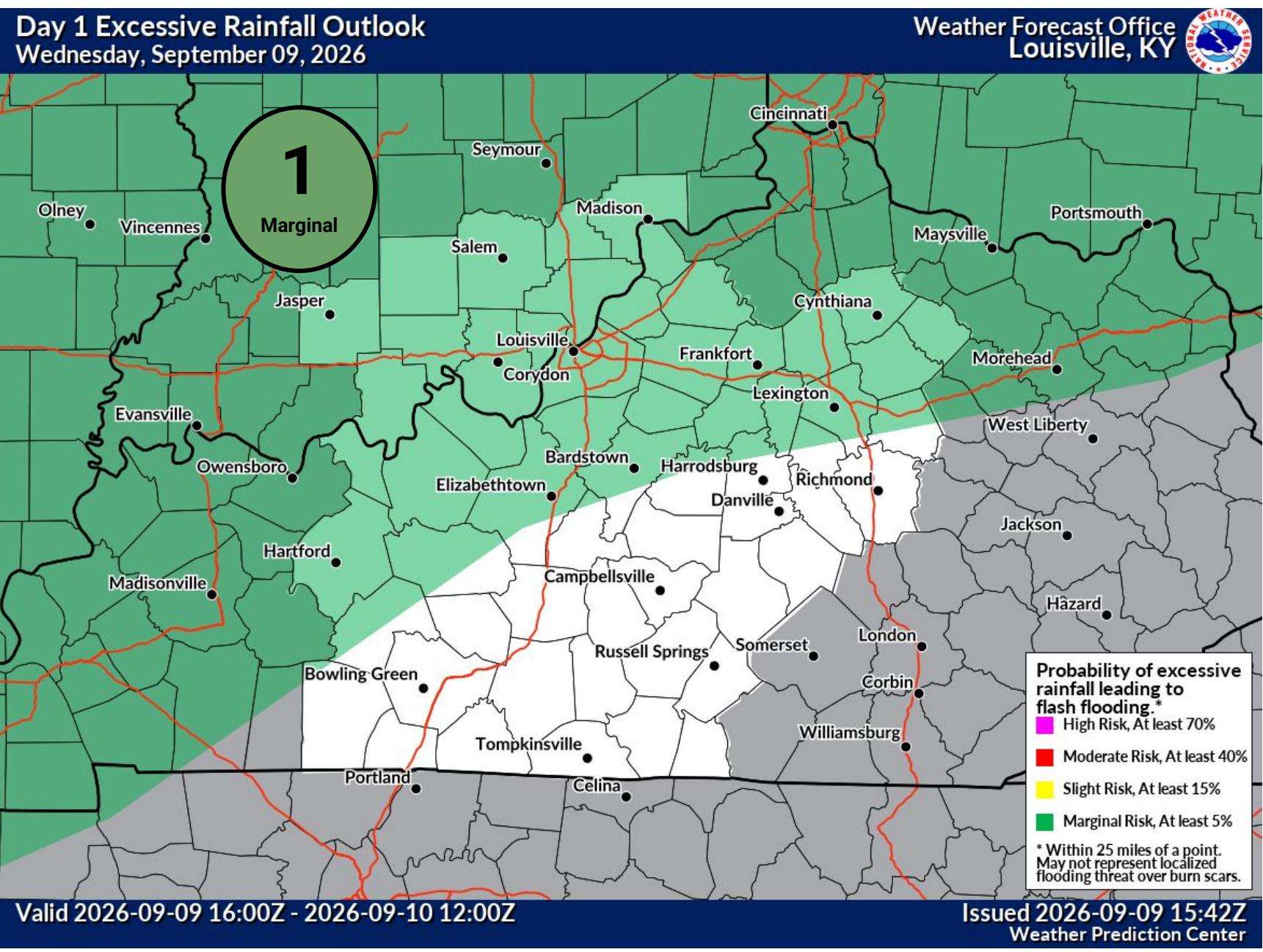
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Tonight through Thursday Evening

Key Messages

- Heavy rainfall may lead to **swaths of 2-3+ inches** of rainfall over southern Indiana and northern Kentucky.
- Most areas will see lesser rainfall amounts, with 0.25-0.75" on average in southern KY and around 1" in southern IN and northern KY
- **Timing:** Tonight through Thursday Evening
- **Uncertainty:** Location of initiation and longevity of showers/storms

Confidence in Flooding Occuring



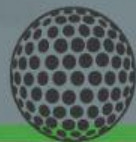
