

Minor travel impacts possible during the Monday morning commute

Details

- Wintry mix of freezing rain, sleet, and snow possible north of the Western Kentucky and Bluegrass Parkways Monday morning, with precipitation changing over to rain by afternoon.
- Mainly light rain likely across south-central KY.
- **Greatest uncertainty for precipitation type is the area between I-64 and the WK/BG Pkws.**
- Minor slushy accumulation is possible across southern Indiana and north-central Kentucky.
- Confidence is a little higher in minor travel impacts north of I-64, where temperatures may dip below freezing for a short period of time.




6-10 Day Precipitation Outlook




Risk of Heavy Precipitation

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- An active, increasingly wet weather pattern is likely to emerge next week as multiple waves of low pressure move across the Plains and Midwest. There is a 60-70% chance for above normal precipitation March 6-10 across portions of Indiana, western Kentucky, and central Kentucky (image **A**).
- A moderate risk (40-60%) of heavy precipitation is indicated for southern IN and central KY March 8-10, 2026 (Image **B**). Flooding is possible in the Ohio Valley during this time. A high risk (>60%) for heavy precipitation includes western KY March 8-9, 2026.
- Multiple rounds of thunderstorms are possible with this pattern, and some storms could be strong to severe. Monitor the forecast as we move into next week, and take any early planning measures for flooding or severe weather.
