Flood Watch still in effect until late tonight

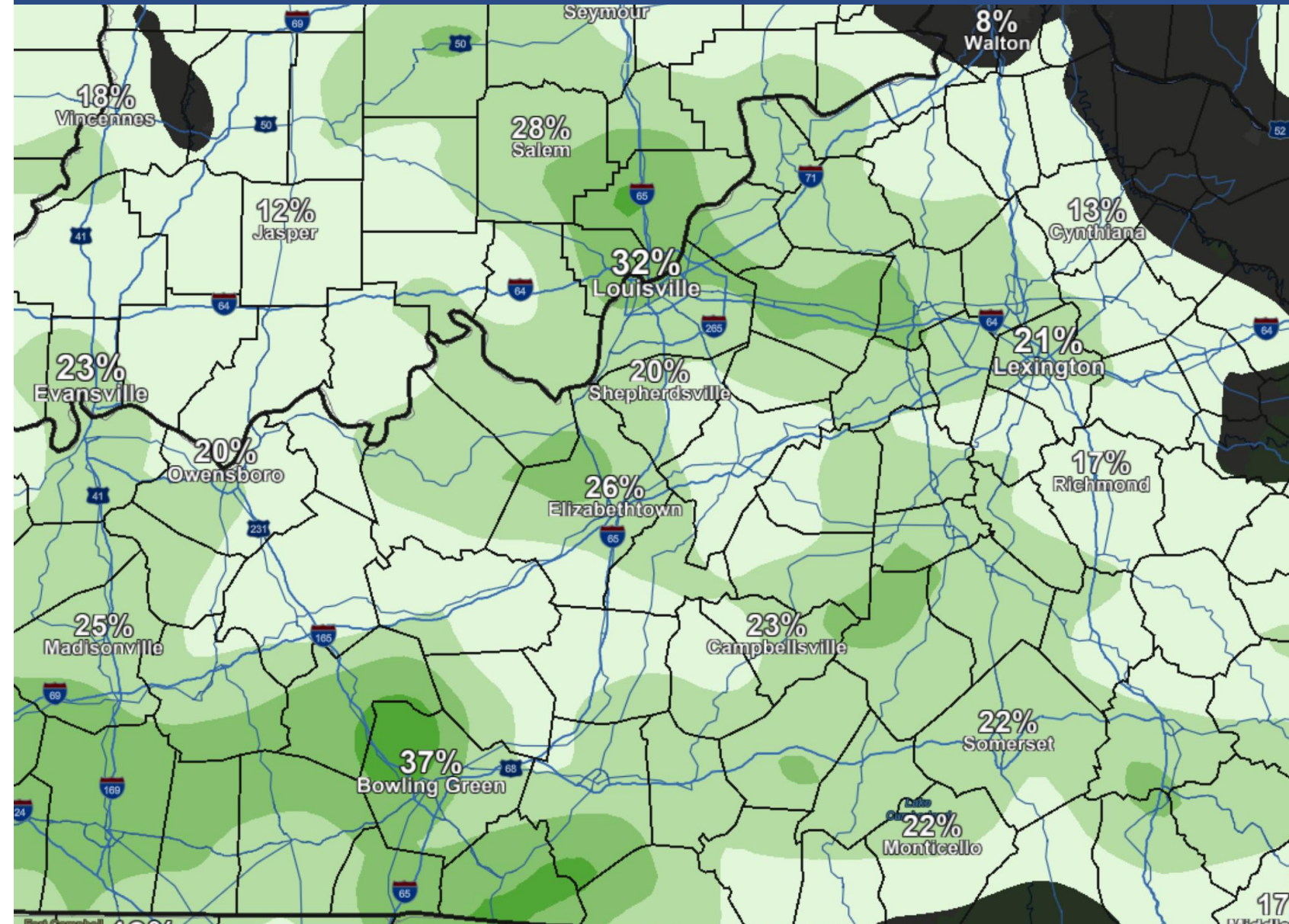
## Summary:

- ◆ Flood Watch continues until late Saturday night
- ◆ Clusters of showers and thunderstorms will redevelop later this afternoon into the evening tonight.
- ◆ An additional 0.5" to 1" is possible across the area with locally higher amounts of 2" to 3"+ with stronger storms.
- ◆ Some thunderstorms could be strong to severe with gusty locally damaging winds.

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Another round of showers and storms Saturday afternoon into early Sunday morning

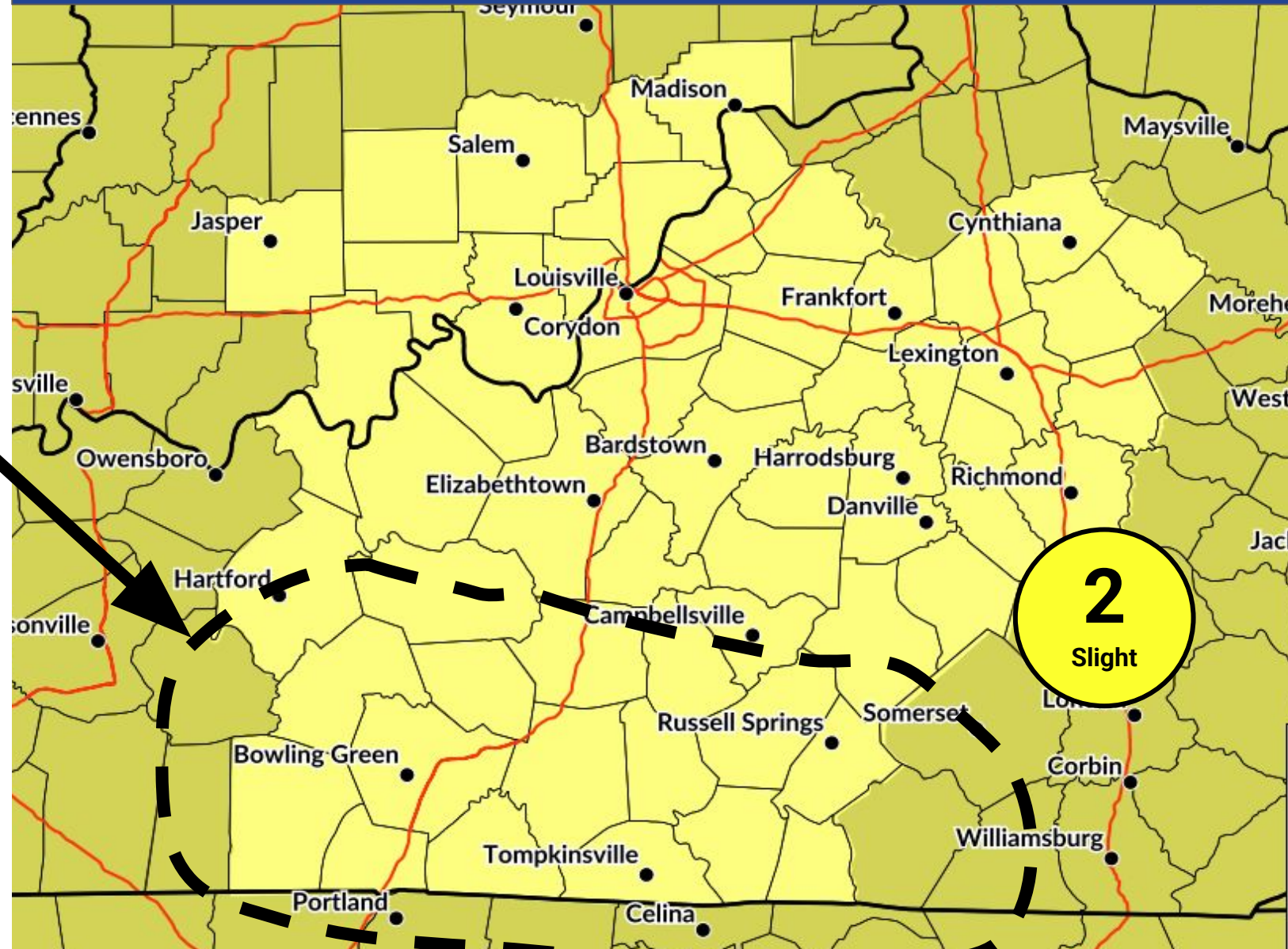
## Key Messages

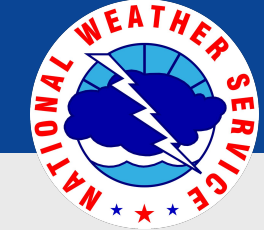
- Another round of showers and storms will be likely (60-80%) move across the area on Saturday and Saturday Night
- **Significant** flash flooding is possible in repeated areas of storms through south central Kentucky, especially in the outlined area
- **Points of Uncertainty:**
  - ◆ Precise location of heaviest rainfall totals
  - ◆ Strength of each passing wave and the amount of rain from each one

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Saturday Evening Into Early Sunday

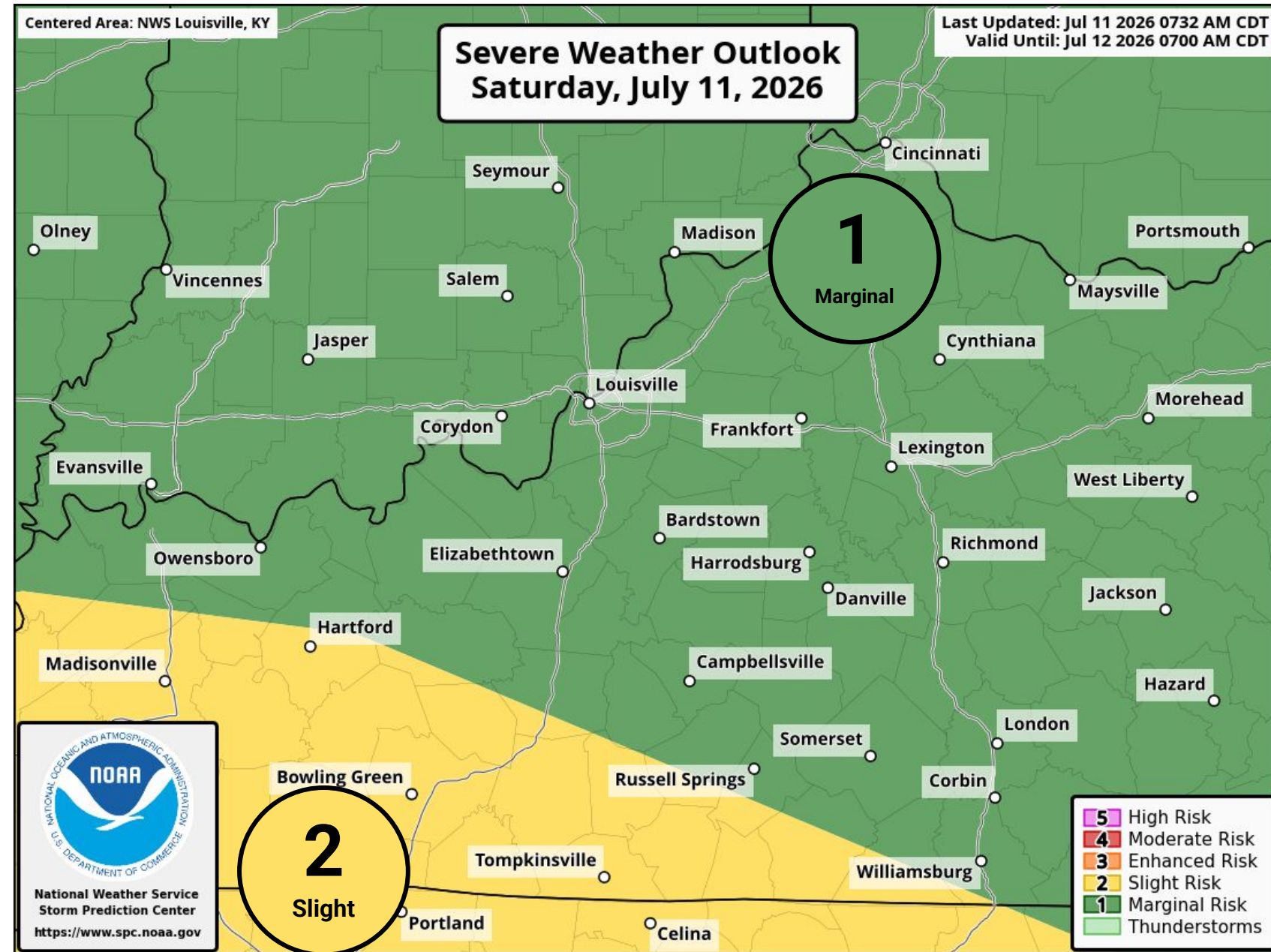
## → Hazards

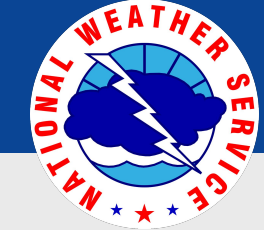
- ◆ Locally damaging winds
- ◆ Frequent lightning and torrential rainfall
- ◆ A brief tornado

## → Timing

- ◆ Thunderstorms are expected to redevelop later this afternoon and continue into this evening.
- ◆ Best chance for severe is Saturday evening and night.

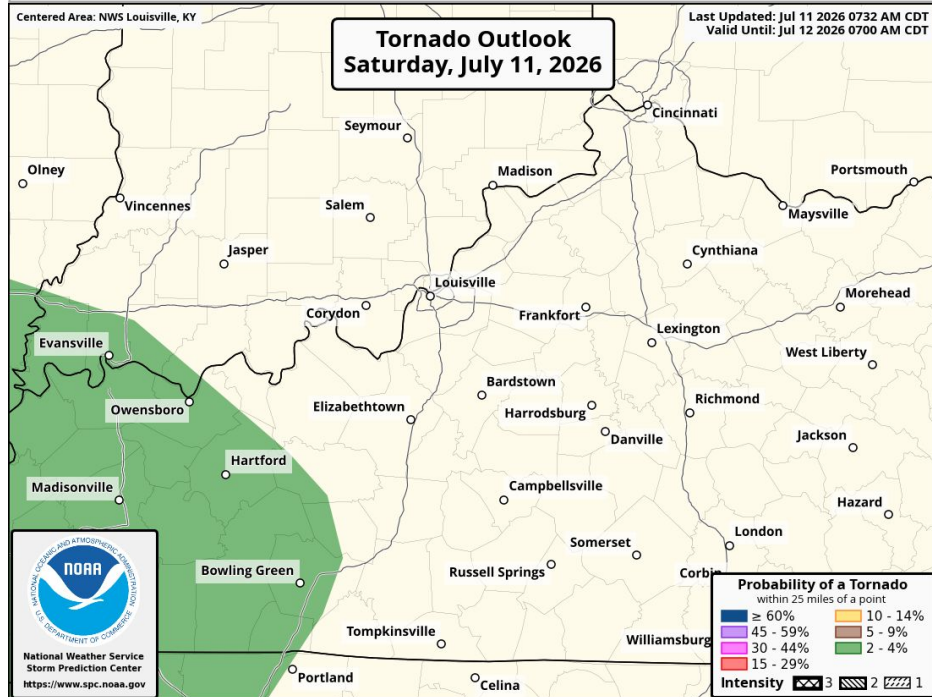


# Saturday/Early Sunday Severe Hazards

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## Gusty Winds Remains the Primary Severe Weather Threat

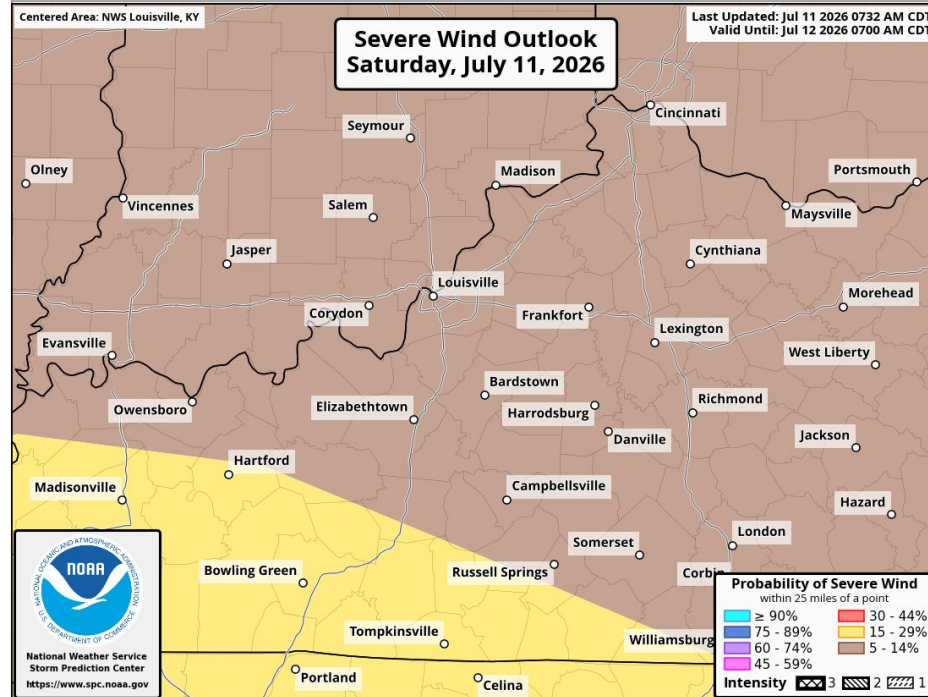
### Tornado Probability



**Hazard: Low Tornado Risk**

**Potential Impacts:** Property and tree damage.

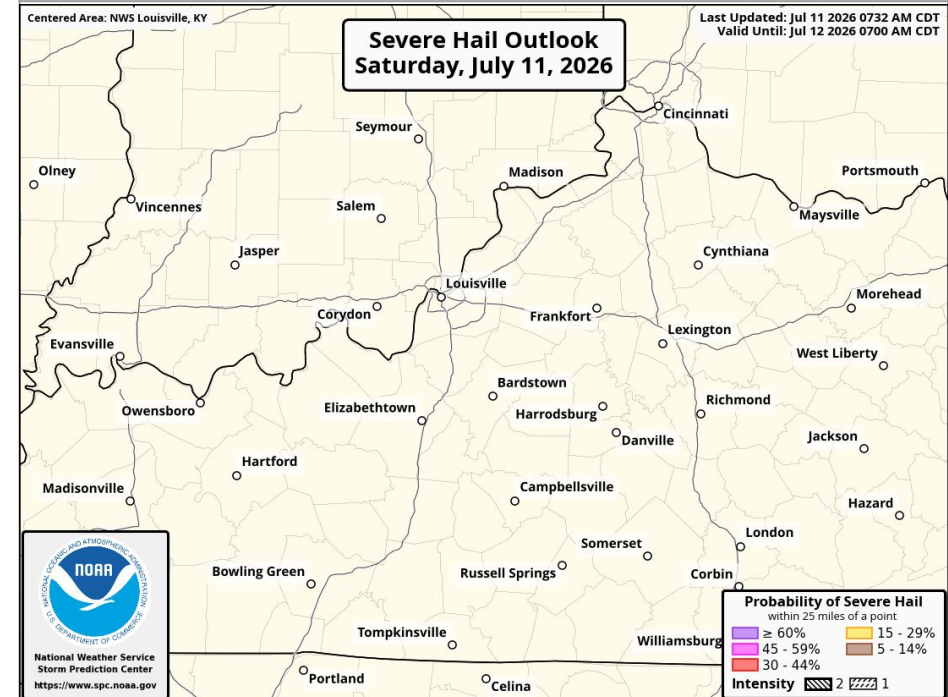
### Wind Probability



**Hazard: Up to 60 MPH Winds**

**Potential Impacts:** Tree damage, power line damage, minor shingle damage, outdoor furniture and loose objects blown around, crop damage.

### Hail Probability



**Hazard: Low Hail Risk**

**Potential Impacts:** Little to no impact expected.



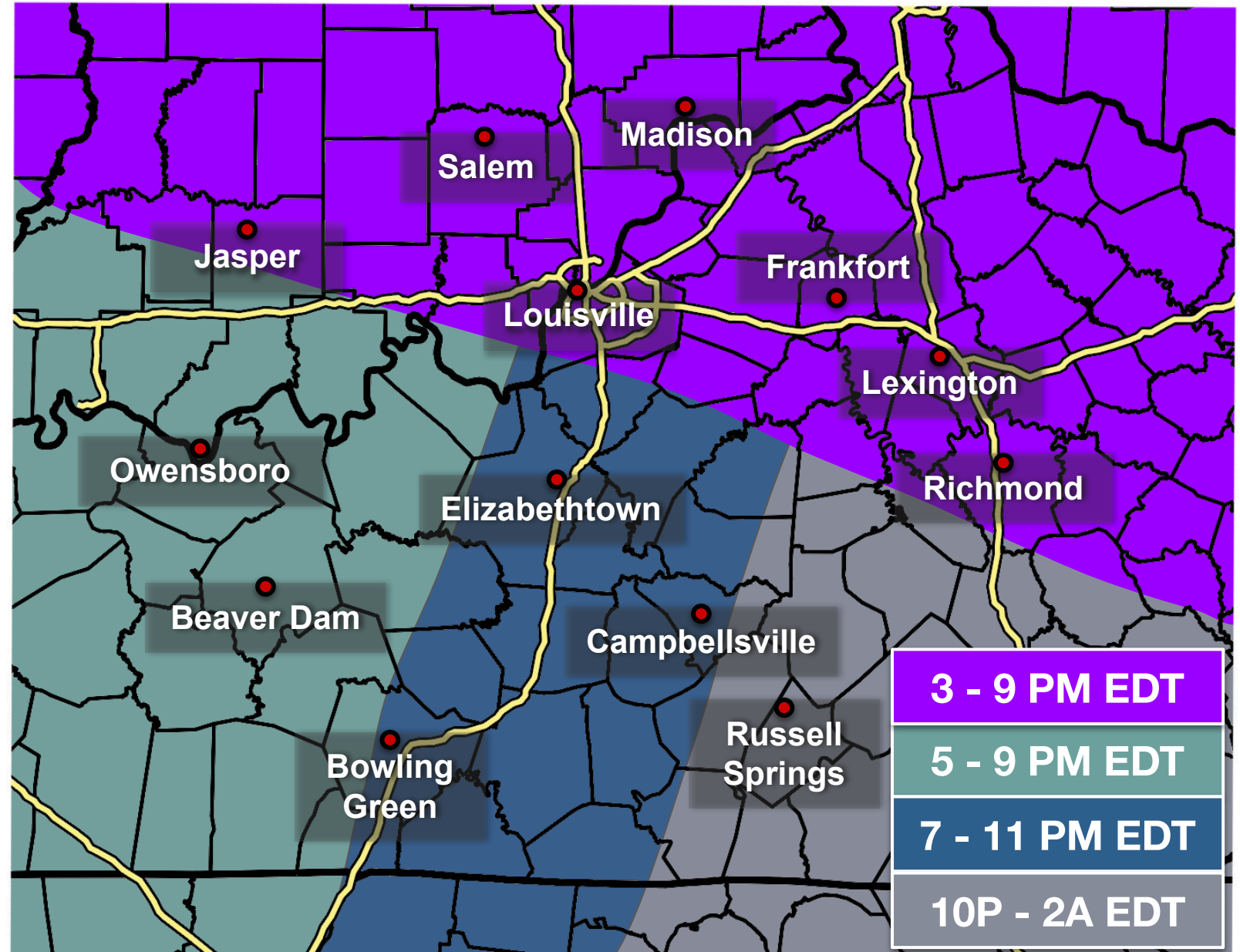


# Storm Timing Saturday Afternoon/Evening

## Thunderstorms re-develop Saturday afternoon across southern Indiana

- Boundary across southern IN/northern KY will help to develop scattered storms this afternoon in the purple area that will move slowly south.
- A separate area of storms is also expected to move from northwest to southeast, mainly across KY, this evening.
- Gusty, locally damaging straight line winds are the main threat.
- *Note: There is a chance storms develop ahead of this boundary and across the KY/TN border.*
