

Second St. Anne Tornado – June 5, 2010

Maximum Tornado Intensity:	EF-1
Estimated Maximum Winds:	100 mph
Estimated Maximum Path Width:	50 yards
Tornado Path Length:	0.2 miles
Tornado Began:	10:19 pm CDT
Tornado Lifted:	10:20 pm CDT

Spotters witnessed a brief secondary tornado to the north of the primary St. Anne tornado. This tornado touched down in a farm field near a creek, about 1/4 mile north of County Road 3000 S, and 1/4 mile west of Rte 1. It destroyed a machine shed and flipped over a large grain trailer. The tornado also blew down large tree limbs.
