The supercell thunderstorm that produced a brief EF-0 tornado near Cornell maintained persistent rotation as it tracked across Grundy County, with numerous photos of a very low wall cloud, and reports of possible brief funnel clouds at times near Kinsman and Mazon.

A line of strong to severe storms producing torrential rainfall moved in behind the supercell thunderstorms, producing sporadic wind damage in portions of northern Illinois and also flash flooding in portions of Rockford. Two additional EF-0 tornadoes associated with rotation embedded within the line of storms were confirmed: the first from extreme southeast Naperville to far eastern Woodridge, and the second a brief path through Downers Grove.

The 2.87" of rain that fell at Rockford Airport on August 18th set a new record for the date, breaking the previous record set in 2005.
